

Primary Care Physician

Responsibilities:

Provide the full scope of primary care services which fall under his/her field of training, including but not limited to diagnosis, treatment, coordination of care, preventive care and health maintenance to patients sixteen(16) years of age and above. In addition, a Primary Care Physician is a member of the CCL team. In that capacity s/he is expected to be familiar with the philosophy, goals and objectives of the Center and to work collaboratively to achieve them. The PCP must be cognizant of, and comply with, all Center policies and procedures, as well as pertinent state and federal regulations.

Minimum Requirements:

- Current Louisiana State Medical License
- Current D.E.A. Certificate
- Board Eligible or Board Certified in Internal Medicine OR Family Practice. If Board Eligible at the time of hire, must be Board Certified within 3 years of hire date.
- Insurability (malpractice)
- Current Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation Certificate (CPR)

BLS (Basic Life Support) within 12 months of employment, if appropriate

- Experience, or willingness to be trained, in providing primary care for HIV/AIDS patients under the auspices of a clinic-affiliated Infectious Disease sub-specialist
