



The Office of Community Development of the City of Baton Rouge, Parish of East Baton Rouge and The East Baton Rouge Redevelopment Authority will hold two public meetings to consult with the citizens of East Baton Rouge Parish on the forthcoming 2018 HUD Action Plan development.

The Action Plan determines how the City-Parish will prioritize essential priority housing and non-housing community development needs. The meetings will include discussion of the federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Invest Partnerships (HOME), Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG), and Housing for People with AIDS (HOPWA) grant programs.
