**Station Name: "PC-6"**

**Monument Location:** The station is located in Morganza, LA, 9.4 miles West-Northwest of New Roads, LA, 8.6 miles Southeast of Batchelor, LA and 11.4 miles Southeast of Innis, LA. To reach the station from the Post Office in Morganza, travel North on LA HWY 1 for 0.2 miles to the intersection of LA HWY 1 and School-Sub Rd., turn left on School-Sub Rd., cross the railroad tracks to LA HWY 3050, turn right on LA HWY 3050 and go North for 240 feet to the station on the right.

**Monument Description:** The monument is a 9/16 inch stainless steel rod found in good condition and encased by a 6 inch PVC pipe with an aluminum access cover stamped "PC-6". The station is 9.0 feet East of the East edge of LA HWY 3050, 15.5 feet West of the most Westerly rail of the railroad tracks, 39.7 feet East of a chain link fence surrounding the old Morganza High School, and 1.0 foot East of an orange carsonite witness post.
