Dear ASE Families,

Under the U.S. Department of Agriculture guidelines, your student may be eligible for free or reduced meals and other ASE programs. Nearly half of the Albuquerque School of Excellence families qualify for free or reduced-price school meals through the Free/Reduced Lunch Program (FRLP).

Qualifying for Free Meals

If any of the following conditions apply to your student, they will most likely qualify for free meals:

- If the student is a foster child (regardless of household income)
- If the student lives in a household that is any of the following;
 - within the income limits for free meals (see application)
 - enrolled in the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
 - enrolled in Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations (FDPIR)

A new application must be filled out every school year. Only one application needs to be filled out for each family.

All information on your application is confidential.
