Attendance

ASE uses Safe Arrival. If your student is ill please keep them home and enter the absence on Safe Arrival. Information on how to use Safe Arrival will be given at Open House.


If you student is late, they will need to enter through the main entrance and obtain a tardy pass to class.



You will receive a map of the traffic plan map at Open House. Students will wait with their teachers at designated locations.

Monday-Thursday:

- K-2 will dismiss at 2:35 p.m.- 2:55 p.m.
- 3rd-5th will dismiss at 2:40 p.m.- 3:00 p.m.
- After 3 late pick ups, parents will be asked to provide proof of registration for an afterschool program.



Younger siblings who need to wait for Mid/High dismissal:

K-2nd will report to the elementary Library

3rd-5th will report to the Mid-High Cafeteria

Mid/High Siblings will pick up 3rd-5th grade students from the Cafeteria and the younger siblings will be escorted to the front of the elementary building for Mid/High siblings to pick up. A Student Agreement will be sent home the first day of school with parents and students to sign.

School of Excellence Dress Code and Spirit Days

Students are required to be in dress code to attend ASE.

Monday-Thursday students are to have a red polo shirt with a patch or an ASE uniform polo shirt purchased from the office. Students may wear khaki or navy blue pants or shorts. No cargo pants or cargo shorts are allowed.

Fridays are spirit days. Students may wear jeans or uniform pants and a school spirit shirt only or wear their School Uniform. Spirit shirts can be purchased in the front office. Supplies are limited at this time.



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DeansList

DeansList is the program we use to record positive(PRS) and negative behaviors(DPS). You will receive an email weekly to keep you informed of your students behaviors from DeansList. This email will also include grades. You may also download the DeansList app. on your phone. Information for your students account will be given out on the first day of school.



DPS points are given for infractions.

Accrual of 15 points results in after school detention. Failure to report results in Saturday detention.

Accrual of 30 points results in Saturday detention.

Accrual of 45 points results in 1 day in-school suspension.

Accrual of 60 points results in 1 day of out of school suspension.


After 75 points the student will be suspended pending the outcome of expulsion procedures.
