Louisiana Community Health Centers Drive Innovation in Response to COVID-19

As Louisiana continues its battle against the COVID-19 pandemic,

Community Health Centers are on the frontlines and serve a leading role in our state's emergency response. Understanding the importance of caring for Louisiana's most vulnerable communities, health centers are increasingly relying on telehealth technology to provide services.

Telehealth is a patient service delivery method

using electronic information and telecommunications technologies to support and promote long-distance clinical health care, patient and professional health-related education, and public health and health administration.

Health centers are adapting to this new virtual environment to ensure all patients have access to the care they need.

Health centers across the country using telehealth/telephonic technology before in 2018.

Only 38% of health centers used this technology in 2016 and mostly in rural parts of the country.


During Q2 2019, Louisiana health centers conducted 100 telehealth visits. Q2 2020 saw over 73,000.
