# Call For Candidates

## Retirees



### Qualifying deadline: April 30

The term of office for one of the Board of Trustees members who represents TRSL retirees will expire December 31, 2026. An election will be held this year to fill a new four-year term, which begins January 2027.




If you are interested in representing your fellow TRSL retirees, you must first meet eligibility requirements and submit a letter of intent to qualify as a candidate.

### Eligibility requirements for the Retirees' trustee position:

- You must be a retired member of TRSL (includes members who have returned to work in a position eligible for TRSL membership).
- You must be retired no later than April 30, 2026.

### Who would I represent?

All retired members of TRSL's defined benefit plan. That's nearly 85,000 members.

### How to qualify:

To qualify, you must send your letter of intent to TRSL by U.S. Certified Mail, U.S. Registered Mail, U.S. Express Mail, or other mail carrier that requires proof of delivery. No other method of delivery will be accepted. **The letter must be in TRSL's office by 4:30 p.m., Thursday, April 30.**

### Letter of intent should include:

- Name as you would like it to appear on the ballot
  - High resolution, color headshot photo
  - Daytime telephone number
  - Email address
  - Last four digits of your Social Security number (to verify TRSL membership)
  - Place of employment
  - Job classification/title
  - Biographical statement/curriculum vitae (250 word limit)
  - Personal statement (75-word limit)
- \*To get an accurate word count, we recommend using the word count feature in MS Word.*
