Immunizations:

As we begin preparing for the upcoming school year, this is a friendly reminder that all student immunization records must be current and on file before the first day of school. State-required vaccinations help keep our students, staff, and school community healthy and safe.

Updated immunization records may be submitted to the school office at any time before the start of the new school year.

STUDENTS ENTERING 6TH GRADE:

Students that have turned 11 and are entering 6th grade will need Tdap and Meningococcal boosters prior to the start of school in August.

Sports Physicals

Any student that participates in any sport at MBS is required to have an up to date LHSAA physical on file with the nurse. Physicals are good for one year and one month after the date that the physician signs and dates the form.
