Privacy Act Notice

Purpose: The Department of Homeland Security (DHS) will use the biographical information to conduct a security threat assessment (STA) and will forward any fingerprint information to the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) to conduct a criminal history records check (CHRC) of individuals who are applying for, or who hold, an airport issued identification media or who are applying to become a Trusted Agent of the airport operator. DHS will also transmit the fingerprints for enrollment into the US-VISIT's Automated Biometrics Identification System (IDENT). If you provide your Social Security Number (SSN), DHS may provide your name and SSN to the Social Security Administration (SSA) to compare that information against SSA's records to ensure the validity of your name and SSN.

Routine Uses: This information may be shared with third parties during the course of a security threat assessment, employment investigation, or adjudication of a waiver or appeal request to the extent necessary to obtain information pertinent to the assessment, investigation or adjudication of your application or in accordance with the routine uses identified in the Transportation Security Threat Assessment System (T-STAS), DHS/TSA 002.

Disclosure: Furnishing the information (including your SSN) is voluntary; however, if you do not provide your SSN or any other information requested, DHS may be unable to complete your application for identification media.

Certifications: The Airport Operator must have applicants and current media holders read and sign the following certification when collecting information not already in the airport operator's records.

"The information I have provided is true, complete, and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief and is provided in good faith. I understand that a knowing and willful false statement can be punished by fine or imprisonment or both (see section 1001 of Title 18 of the United States Code)".

The Airport Operator must make the following certification available to applicants and current media holders for purposes of SSN verification.

"I authorize the Social Security Administration to release my Social Security Number and full name to the Transportation Security Administration, Office of Transportation Threat Assessment and Credentialing (TTAC), Attention: Aviation Programs (TSA-10)/ Aviation Worker Program, 601 South 12th Street, Arlington, VA 20598.

The Baton Rouge Metropolitan Airport and the Baton Rouge Metropolitan Airport Police\ARFF Department in conjunction with the Department of Homeland Security provides this Privacy Act Notice.

I am the individual to whom the information applies and want this information released to verify that my SSN is correct. I know that if I make any representation that I know is false to obtain information from Social Security records, I could be punished by a fine or imprisonment or both.

Procedures and Responsibilities Agreement

Read each carefully		Initial
1.	While inside the Security Identification Display Area (SIDA) the ID holder shall wear the ID on the outer most clothing above the belt and below the shoulders. The ID holder shall challenge any individual who is not displaying an airport ID. Place the person under escort or summon the Airport Police immediately by calling (225) 355-2068.	
2.	Individuals outside the SIDA yet within other restricted area(s) where safety and security is a consideration, the ID card must be on your person and shown when challenged.	
3.	The Airport ID is not transferable between employees. The Airport ID is not to be shared or loaned to any other person(s)	
4.	The Baton Rouge Metro Airport reserves the right to revoke, not issue, or ban the ID badge from any person if such actions are determined to be in the best interest of the security of the airport and the traveling public.	
5.	The Airport ID holder must immediately notify the Airport Police of the loss or theft of the ID badge. Replacement charges will be assessed for the ID replacement.	
6.	All non-refundable fees or a completed billing request is required prior to the issuance of an Airport ID badge.	
7.	All Airport ID Badges remain the property of the Baton Rouge Metropolitan Airport and must be surrendered upon demand by the Baton Rouge Metro Airport. The Airport ID badge must be returned to the Airport Police upon demand or immediately upon termination or suspension of employment or within 12 hours of a conviction of a disqualifying crime listed above (1542.209(d)).	
8.	Prior to receiving driving privileges, I understand I must pass the applicable driving test prior to driving any vehicle inside the Airport perimeter fence. I also understand I must notify the Airport ID Office if my driver's license is suspended, revoked, or remain expired over 10 consecutive days.	
9.	I will ensure proper closing and locking of any AOA door or gate used. I will not leave any gate or door in bypass unattended.	
10.	I will not allow anyone to follow me or my vehicle through any AOA door or gate (piggybacking) I use unless I have the proper endorsement on my ID badge that allows me to escort privileges.	
11.	If I am granted escort privileges, I understand I cannot leave the individual(s) I am escorting until we leave the security area. I also understand the individual(s) under my escort must remain in my sight and control.	
I, the undersigned, have carefully read, understand, and will comply with the above ID badge holder Procedures and Responsibilities governing the Airport ID badges, and all security related rules and regulation governing Airport and Aircraft security. Failure to comply may result in the loss of ALL airport access privileges.
