In accordance with Executive Proclamations JBE 2020-30 and 2020-33, issued by Governor John Bel Edwards on March 16, 2020 and March 22, 2020, respectively, this notice shall serve as a certification of the Greater Baton Rouge Airport Board of Commissioner's potential inability to otherwise operate in accordance with the Louisiana Open Meetings Law due to a lack of a quorum as a result of the COVID-19 public health emergency. Pursuant to Section 4 of JBE 2020-30, the Greater Baton Rouge Airport Board of Commissioner will provide for attendance at its next meeting, which will only contain business deemed essential government business, on Tuesday, September 1, 2020, via video conference. A gathering of the entire membership of the Greater Baton Rouge Airport Board of Commissioners, necessary staff, and the public may violate Phase Two of Governor Edwards' limiting public gatherings to 50% of normal capacity. 



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
