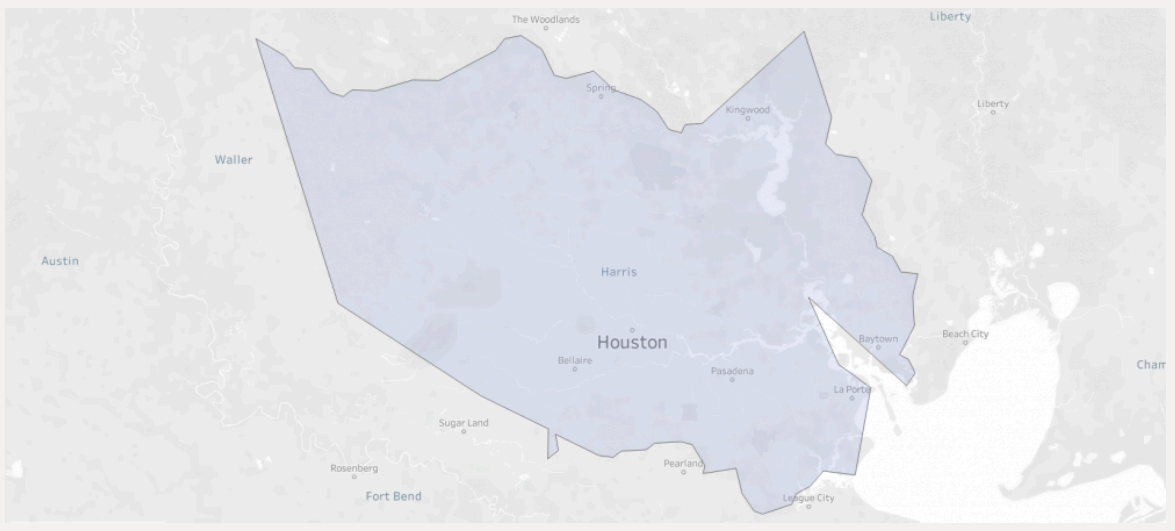


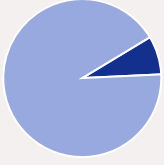

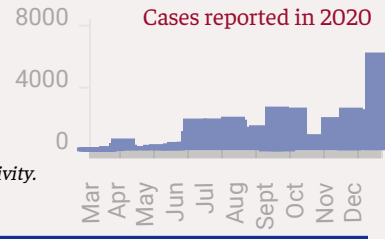

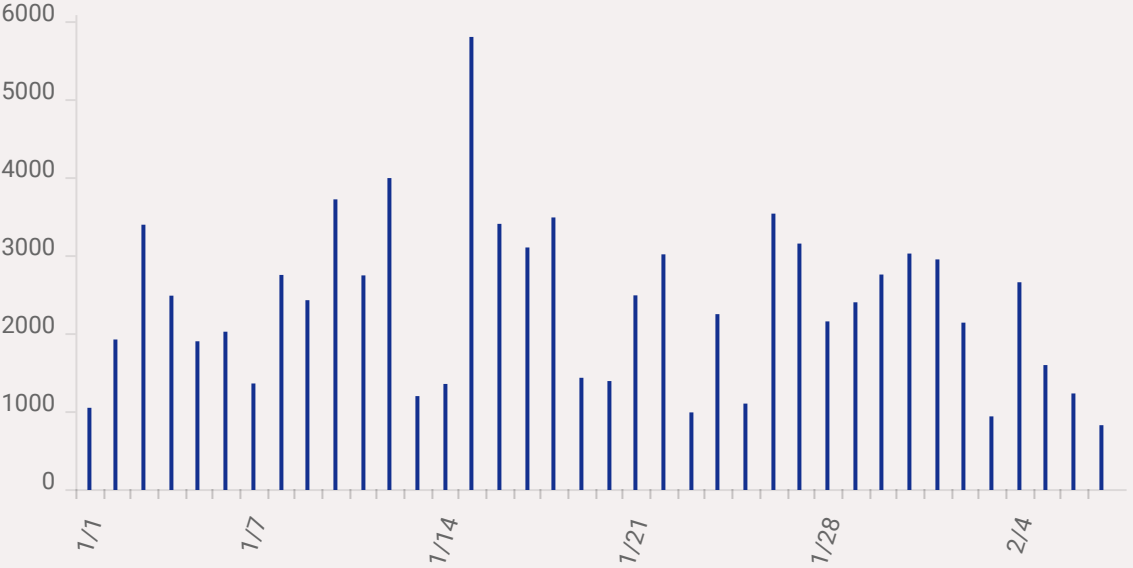
## Harris County Risk Level

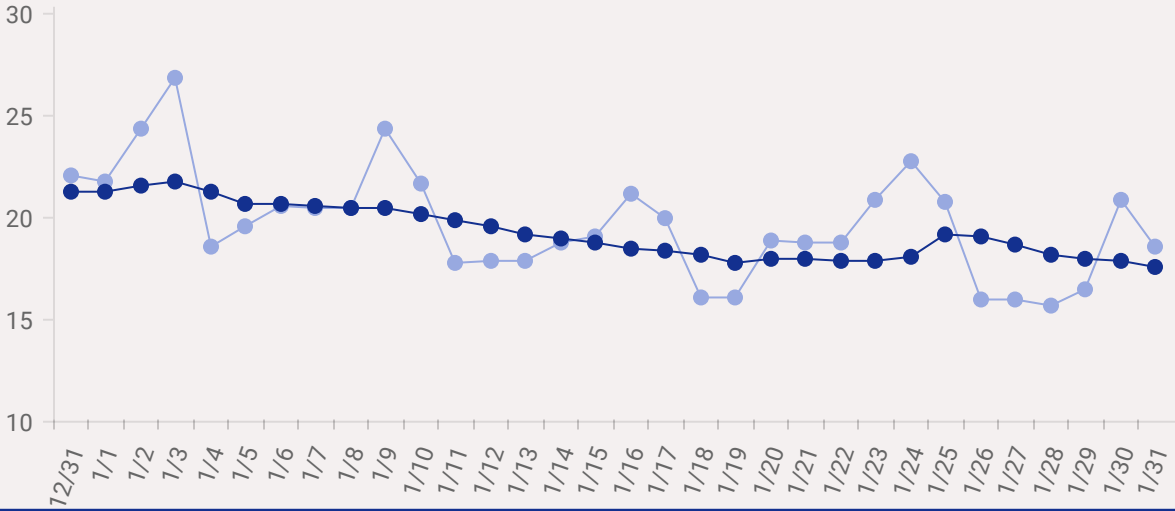


## Cases in Harris County 2021

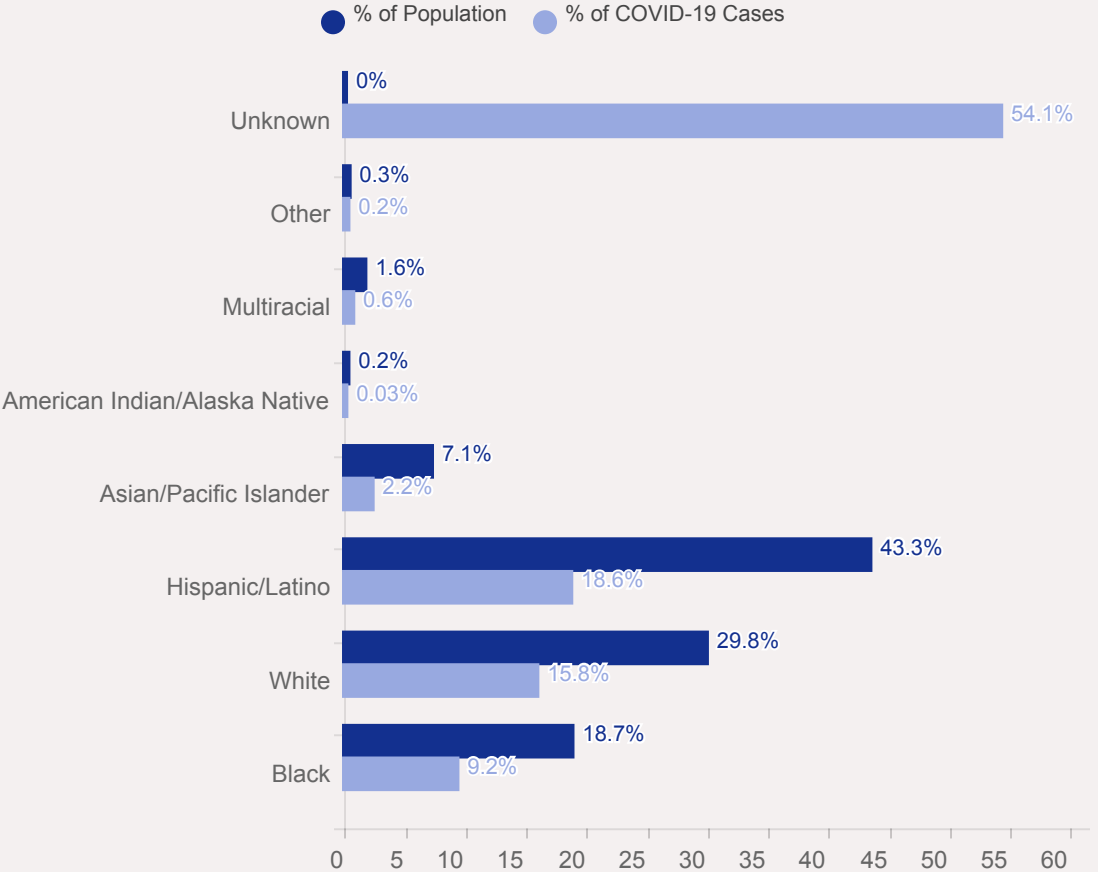


## Test Positivity in Harris County, 12/31/20-1/31/21
