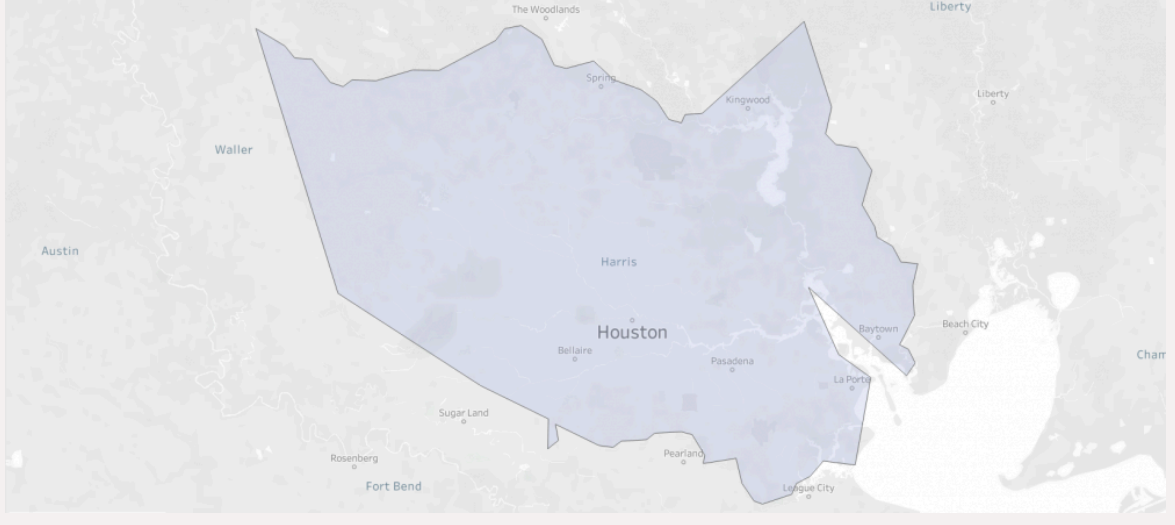


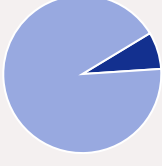

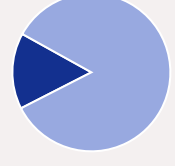

Harris County ranks #1 in deaths and #1 in cases statewide



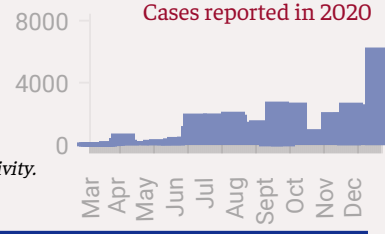

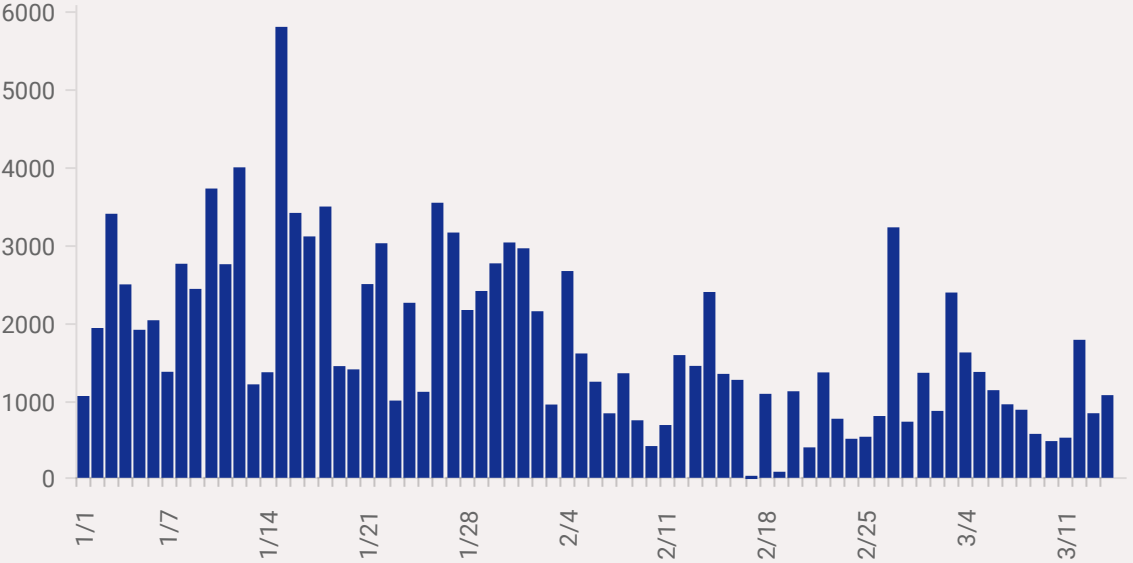
Harris County Risk Level

Extremely High



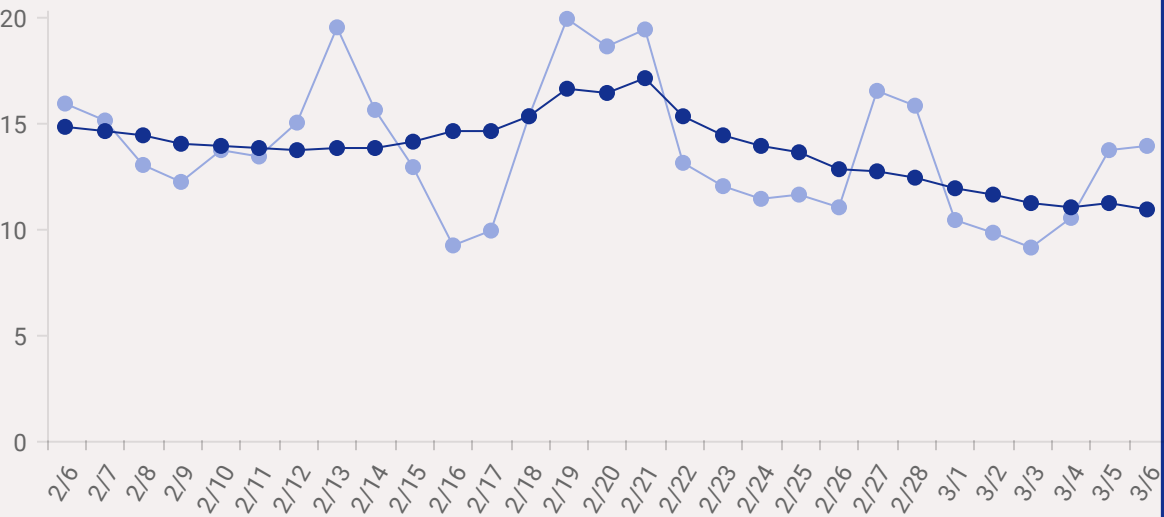

Cases in Harris County 2021



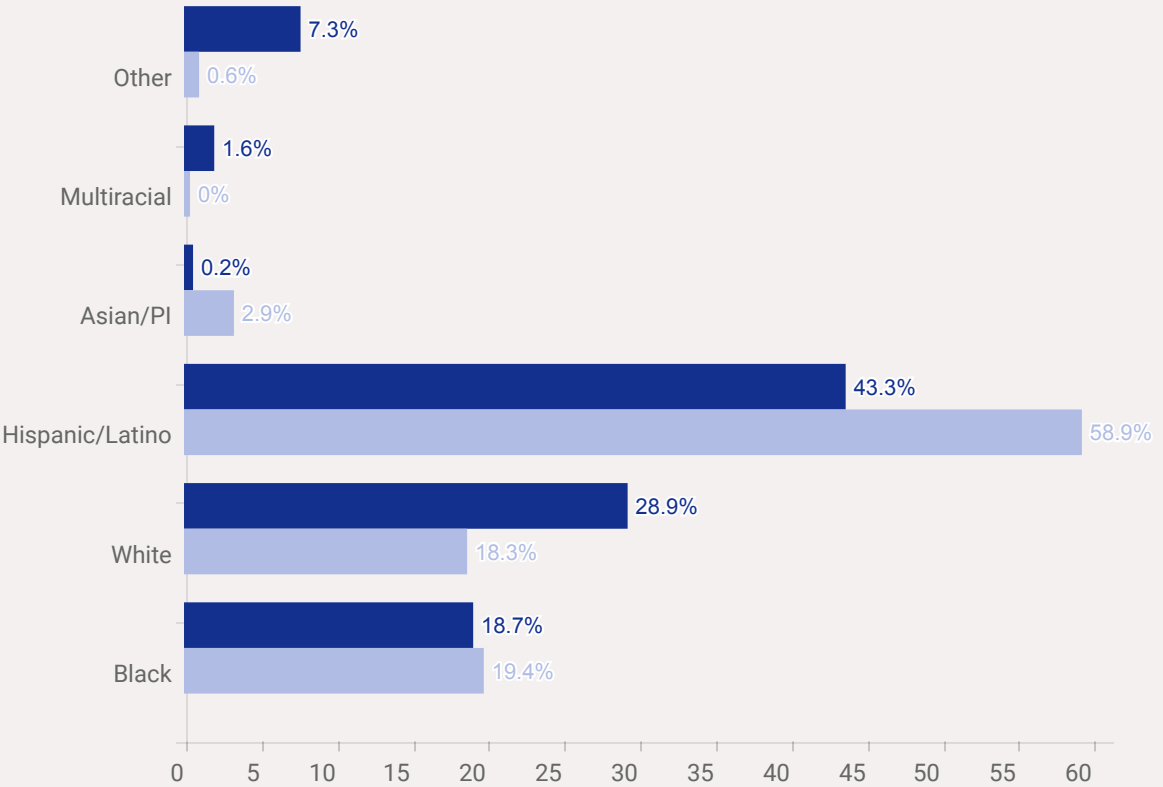
Test Positivity in Harris County, 2/6/21-3/6/21
