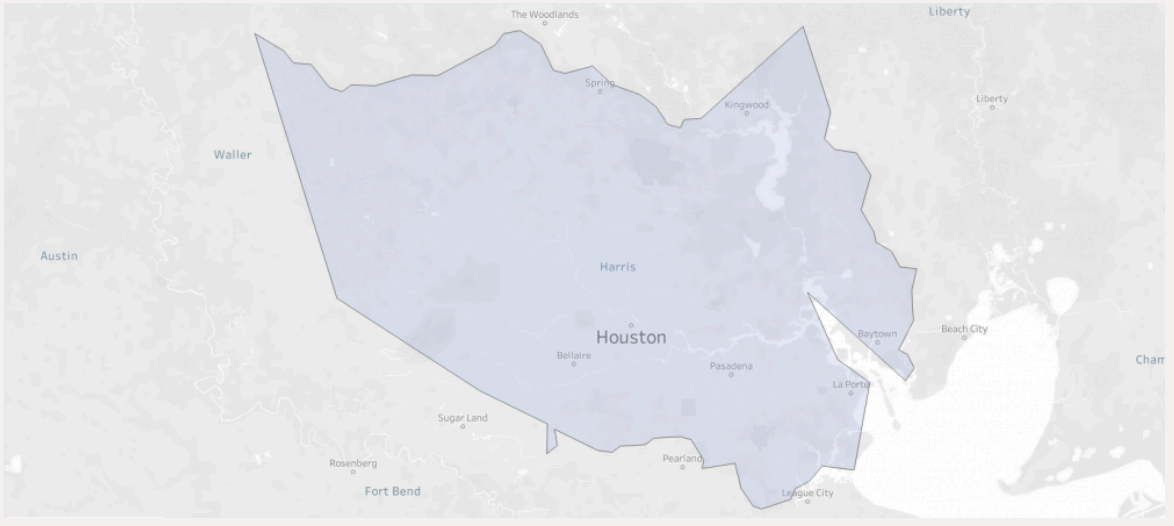


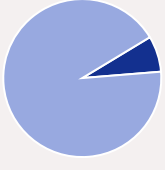

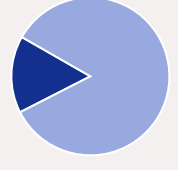

Harris County ranks #1 in deaths and #1 in cases statewide



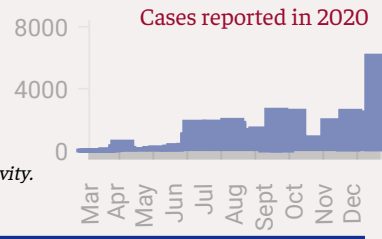

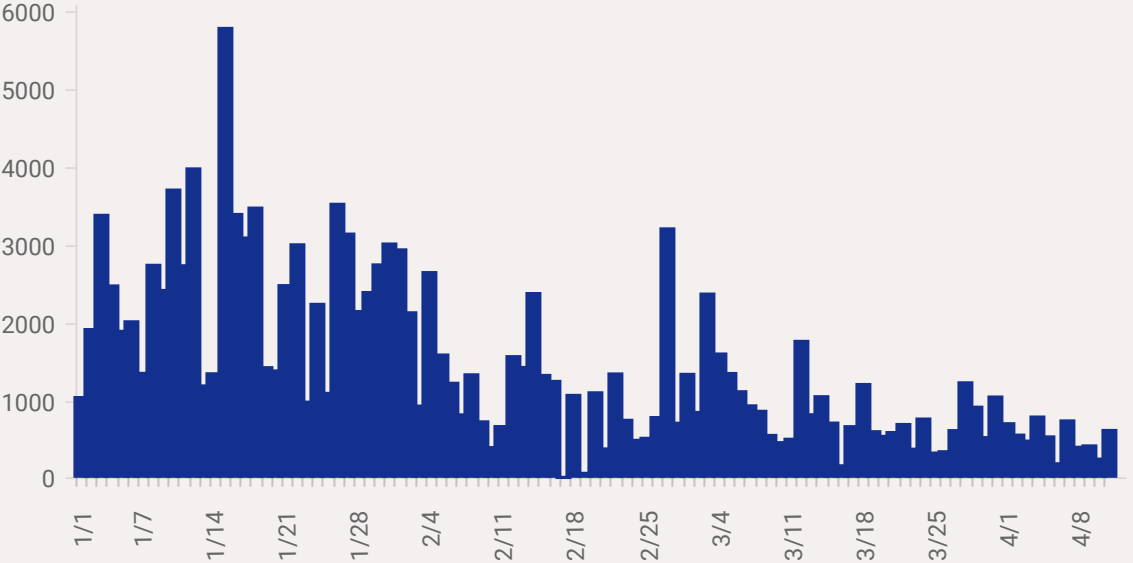
## Harris County Risk Level

**Very High**



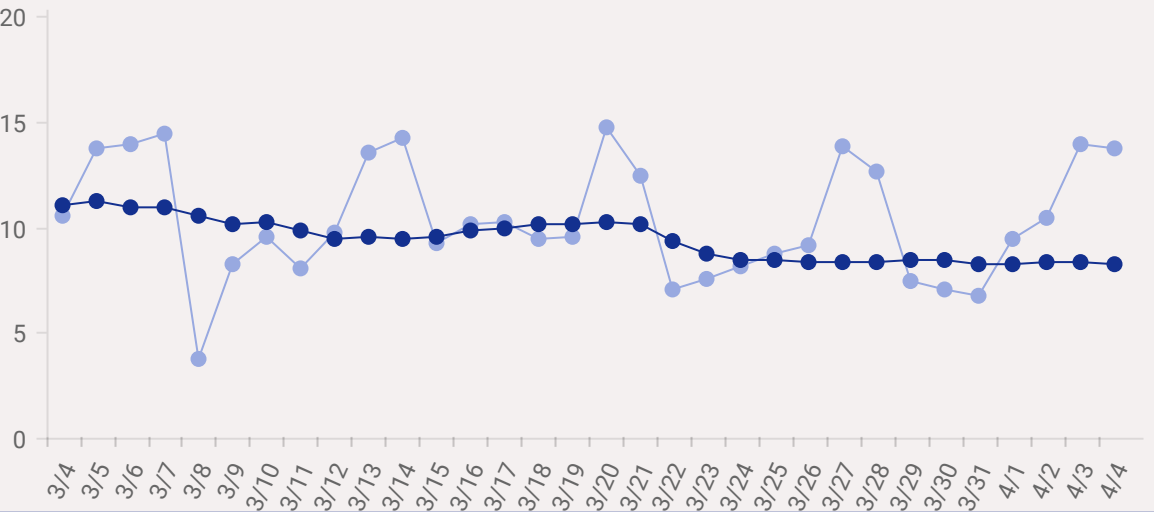

## Cases in Harris County 2021



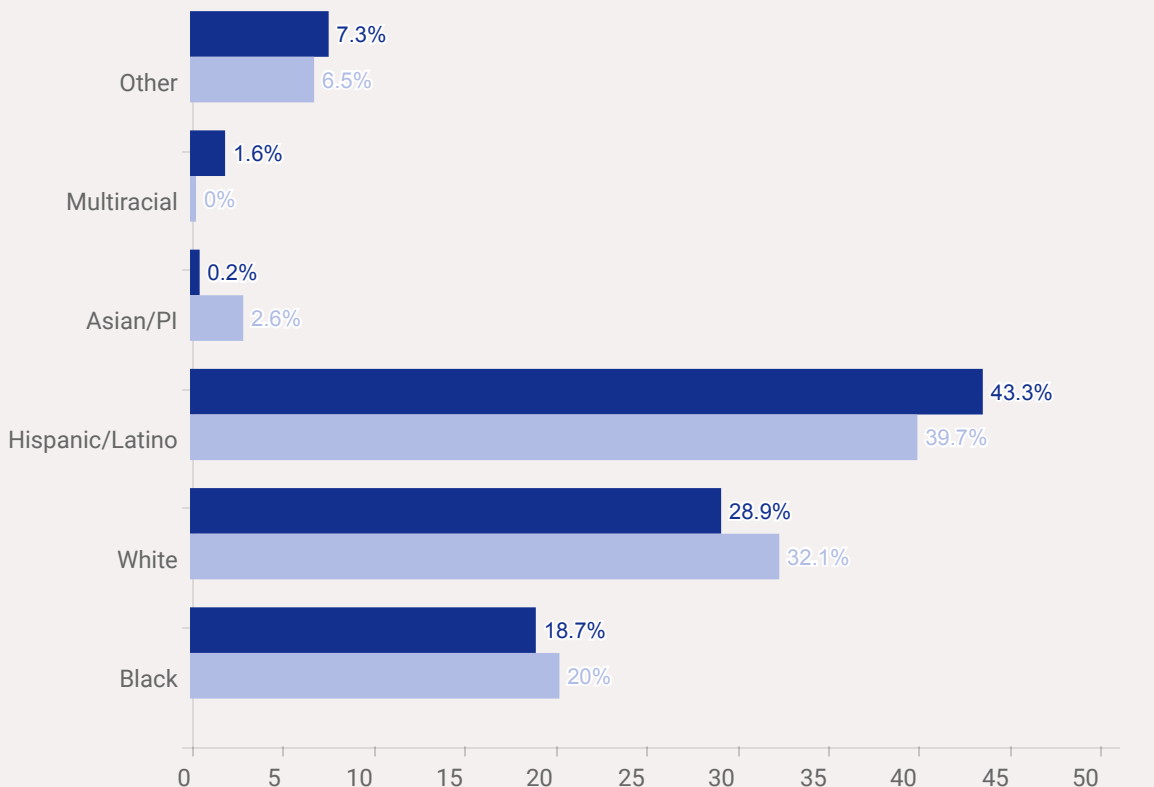
## Test Positivity in Harris County, 3/4/21-4/4/21
