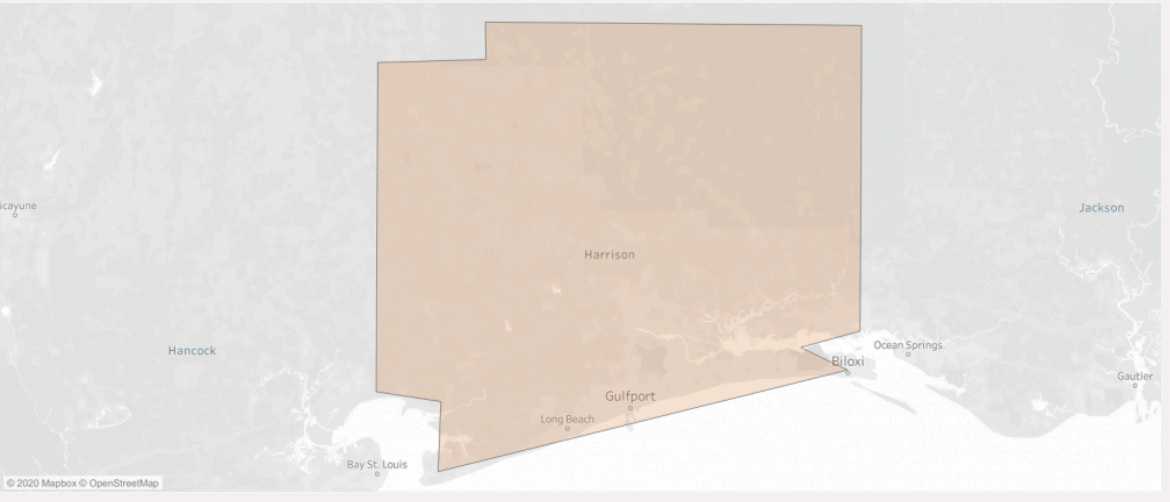

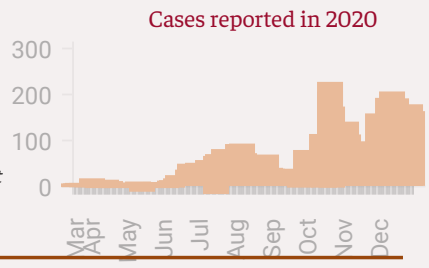

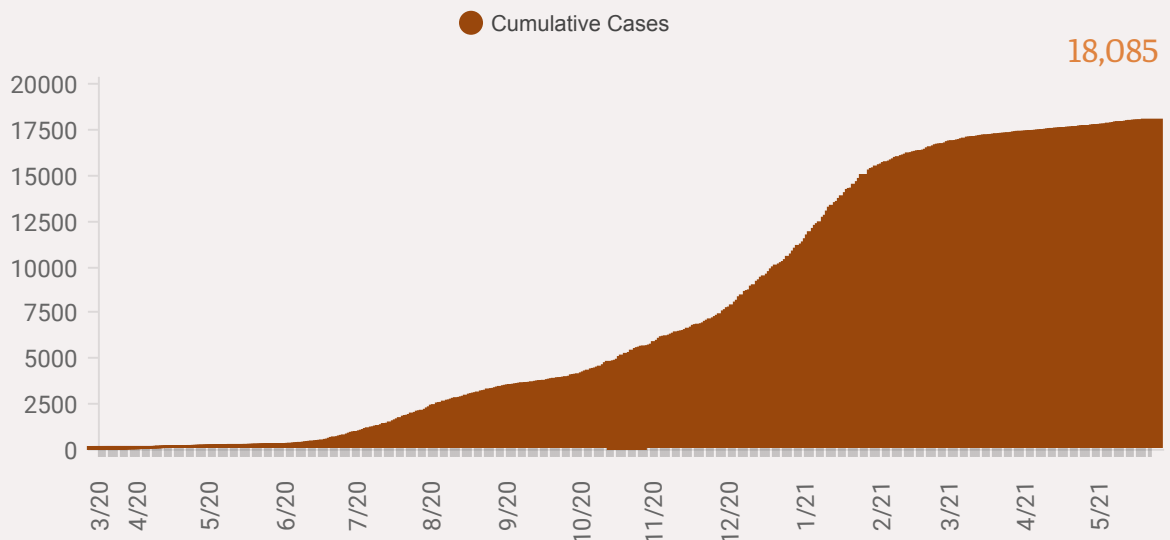
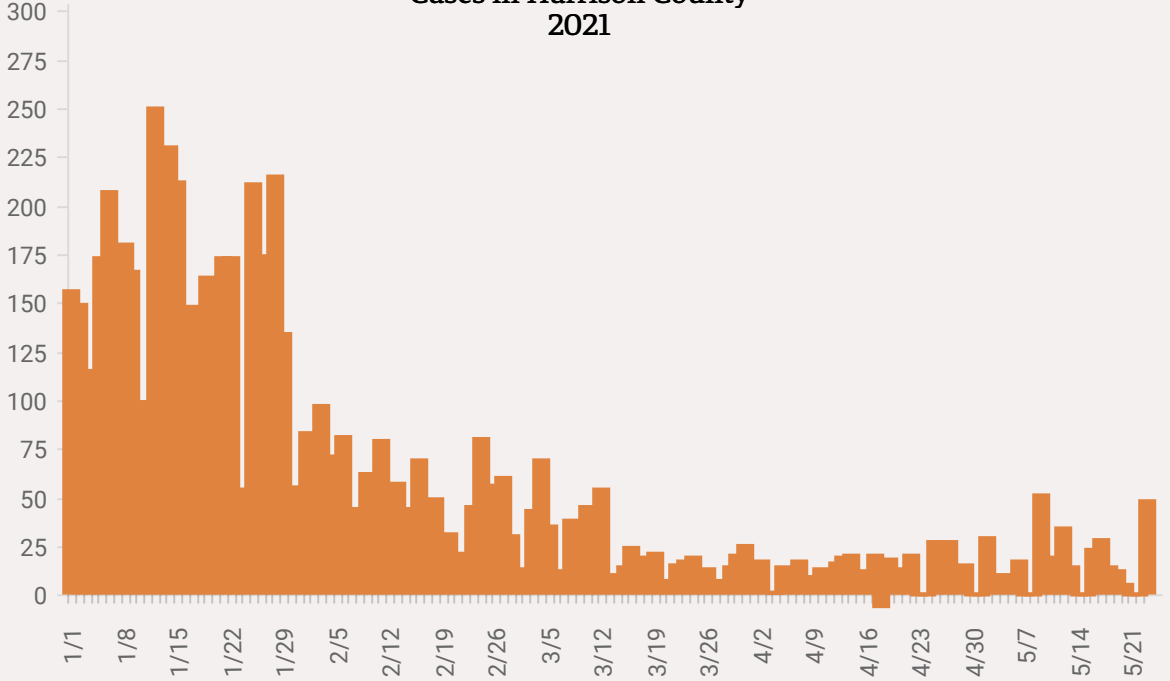

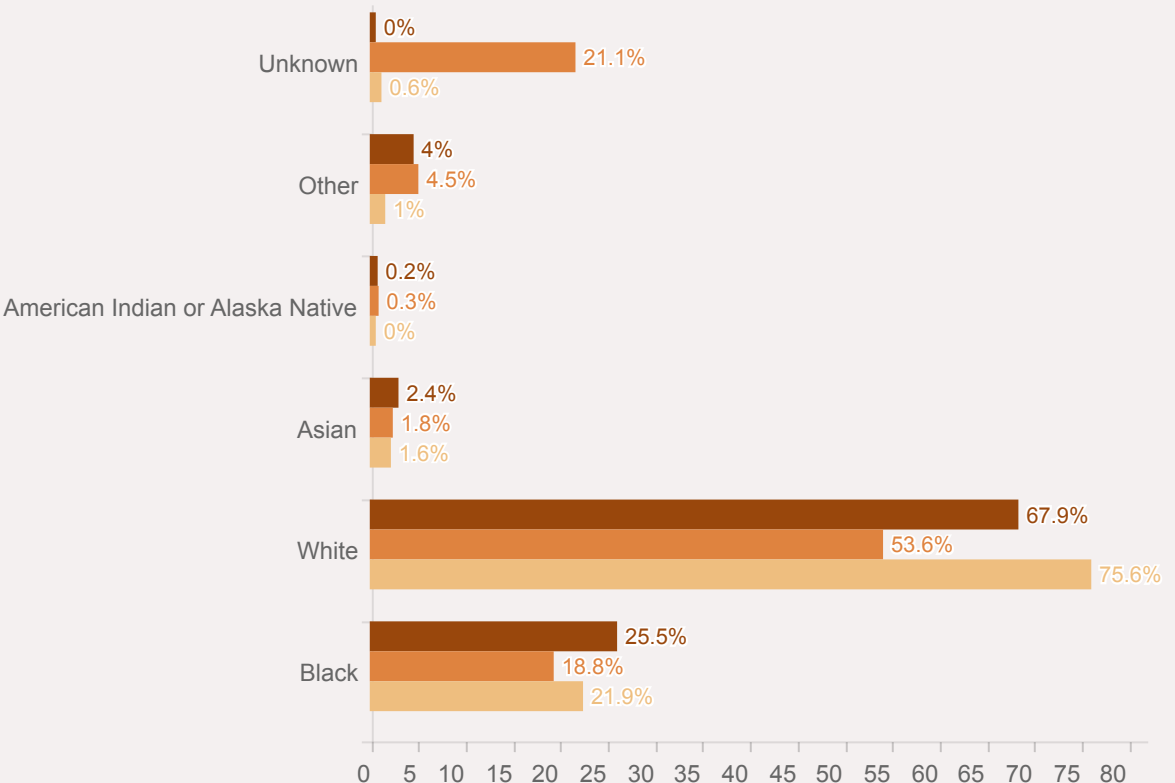


Cases in Harrison County 2021
