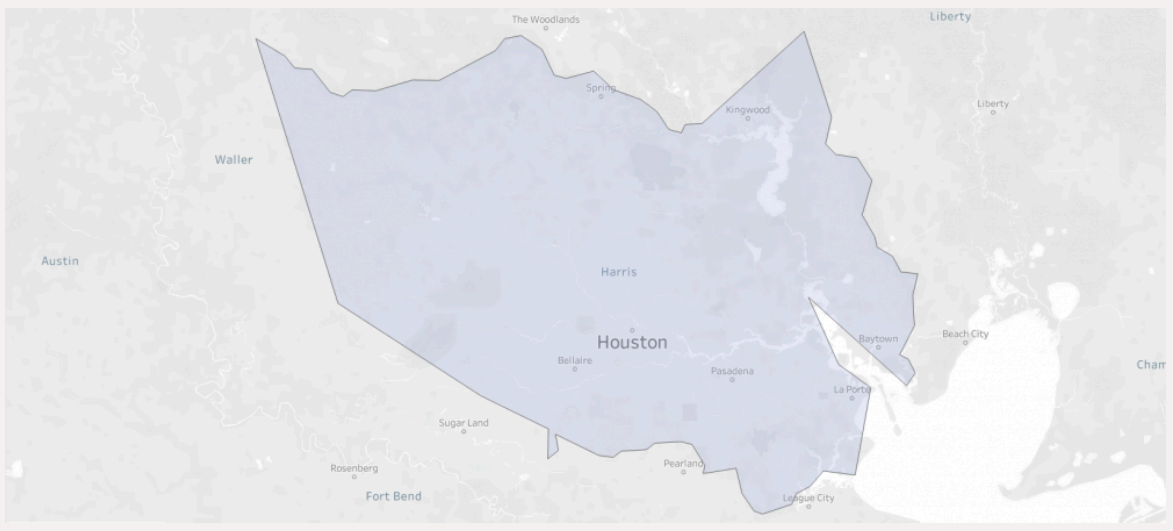

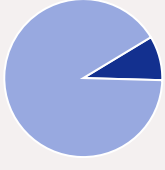

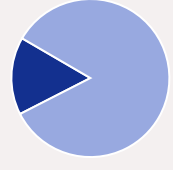

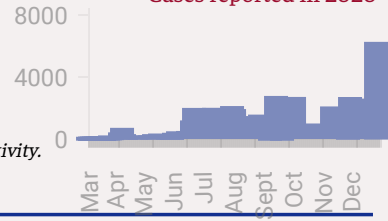

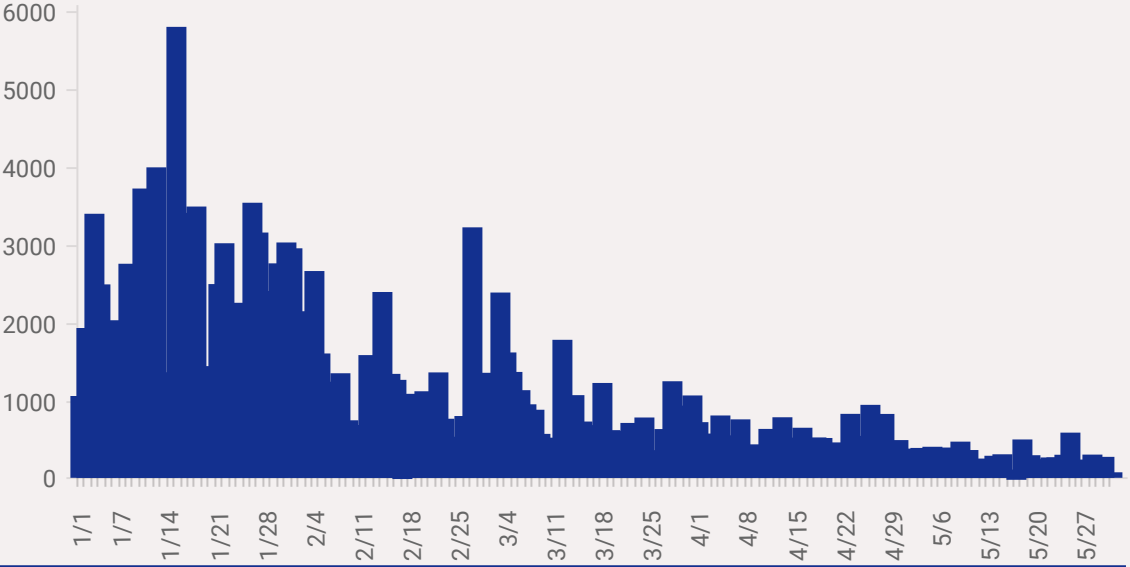

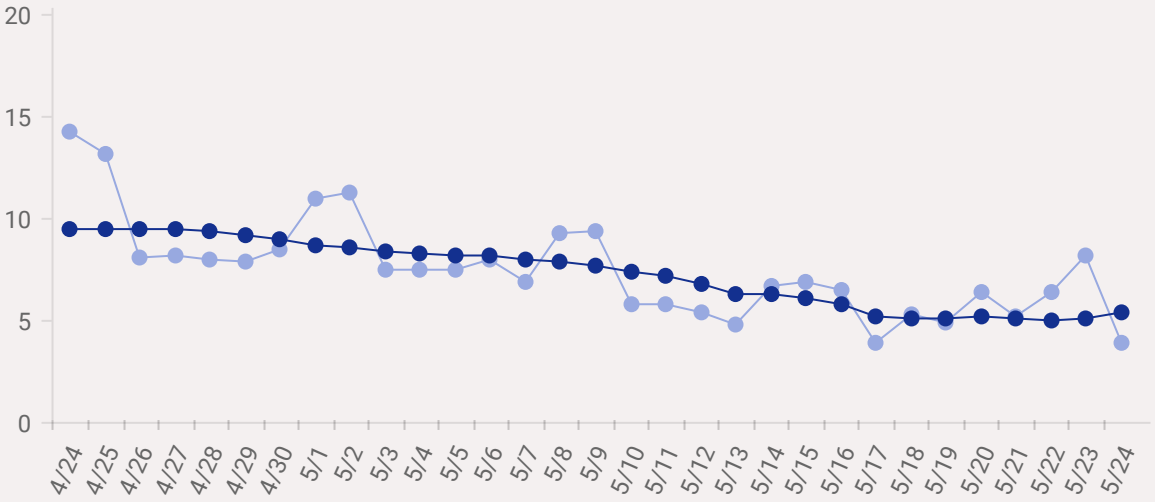

Cases in Harris County 2021



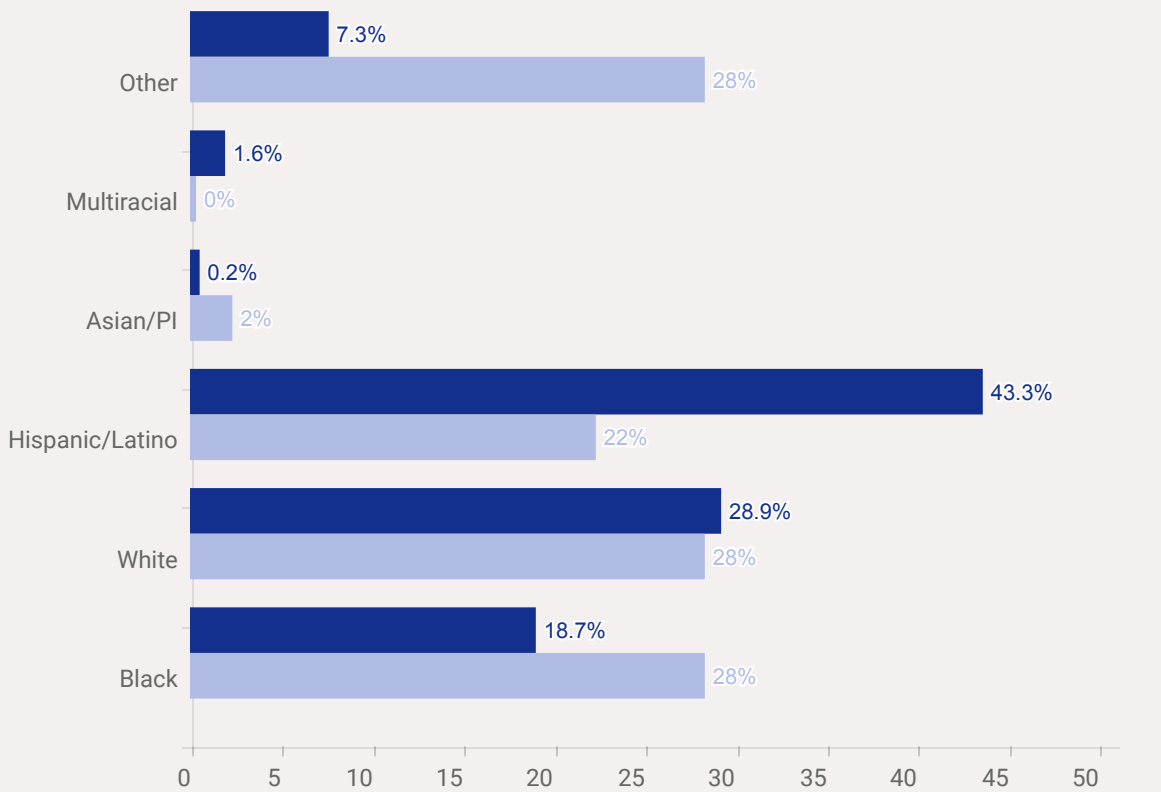
Test Positivity in Harris County, 4/24/21-5/24/21
