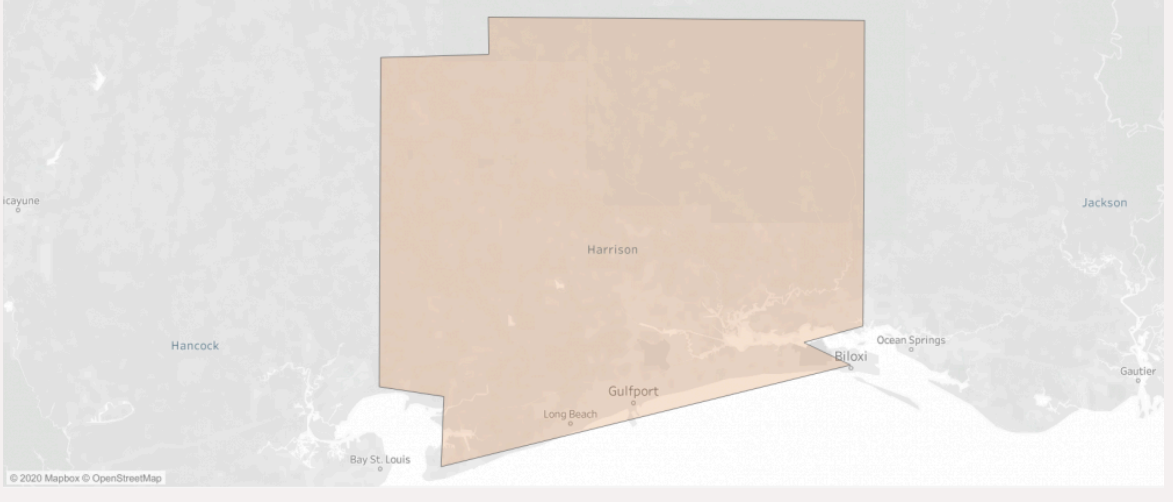

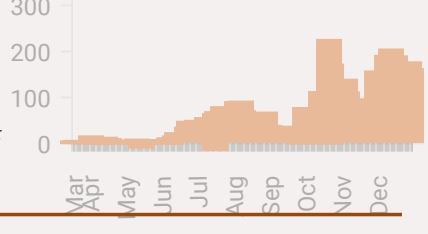

## Harrison County Risk Level

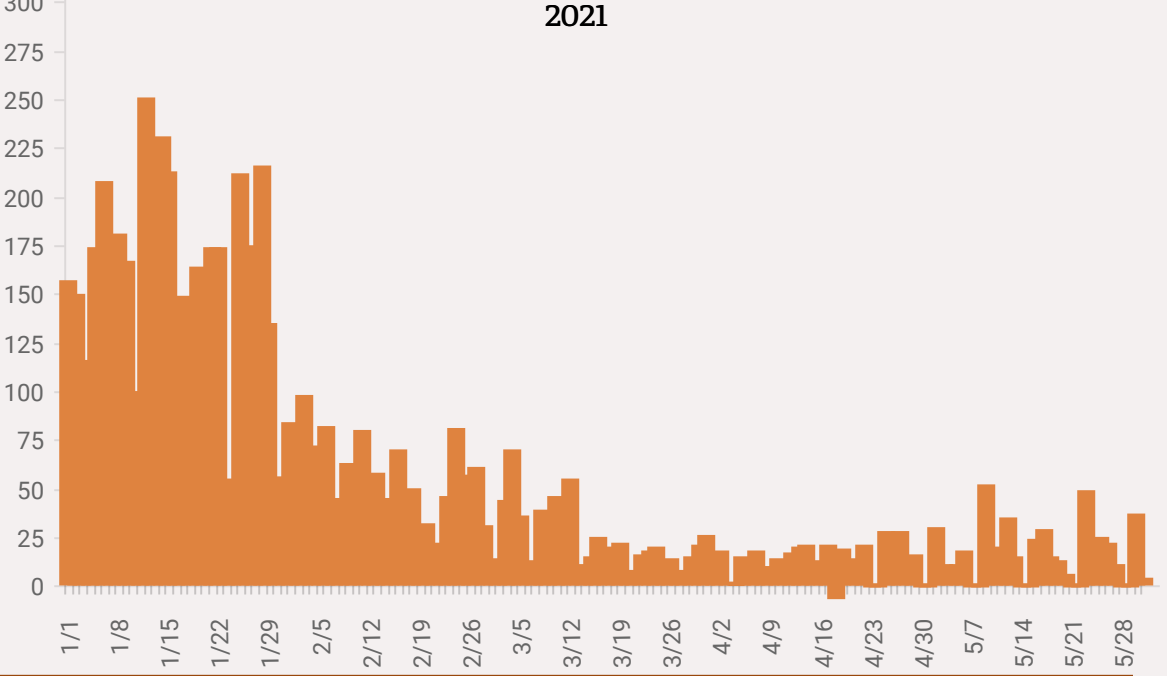

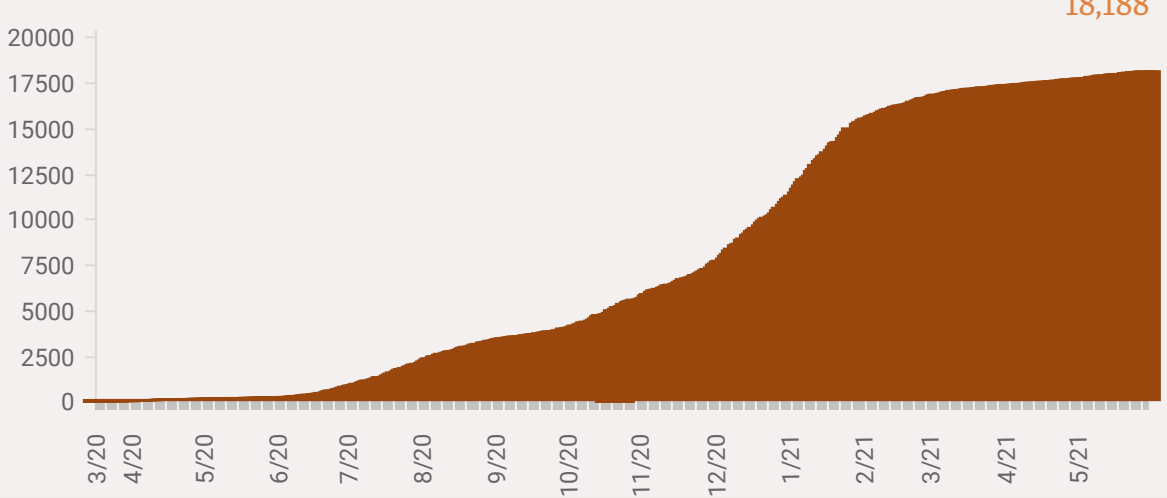
Cases reported in 2020



## Cases in Harrison County 2021

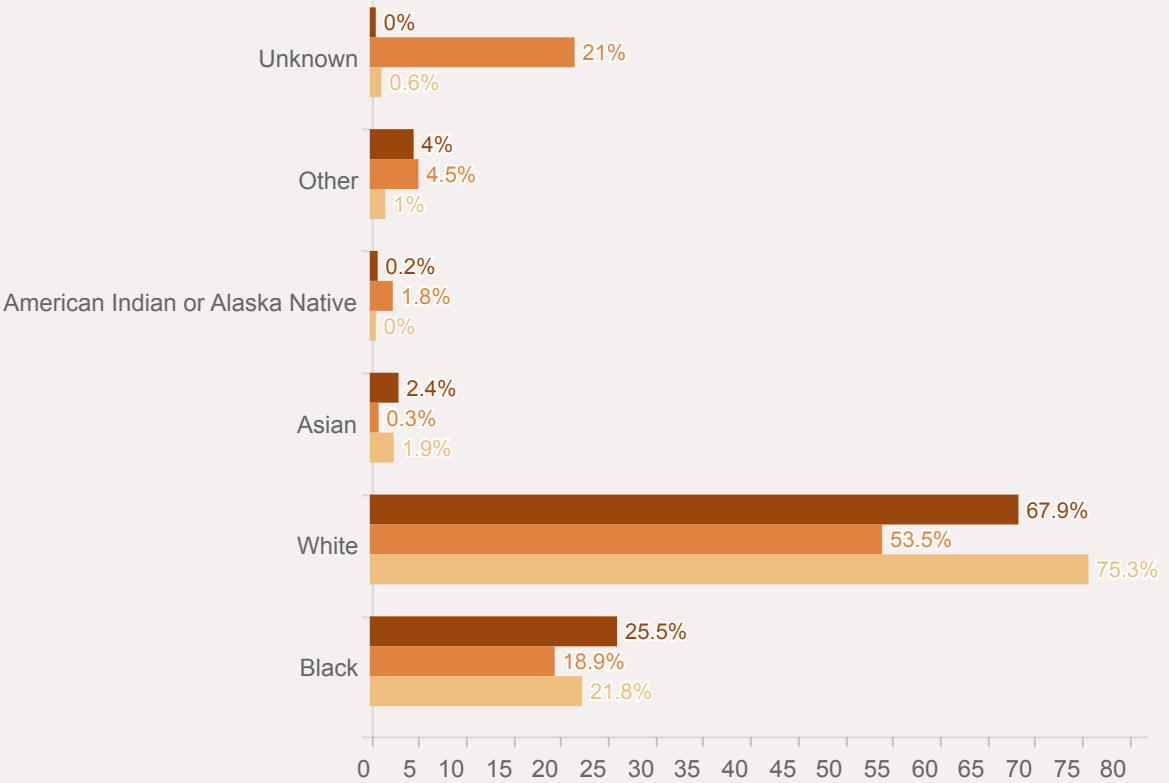


● Cumulative Cases
