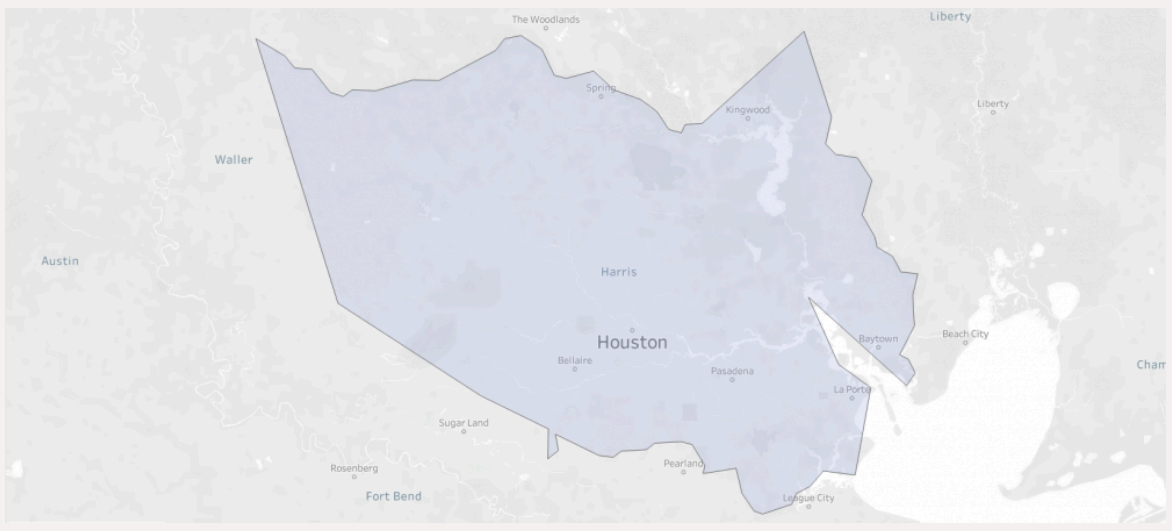

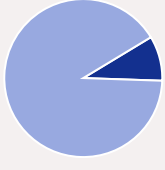

# COVID-19 Harris County, TX

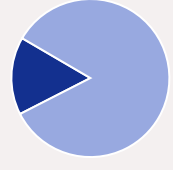

Harris County ranks #1 in deaths and #1 in cases statewide



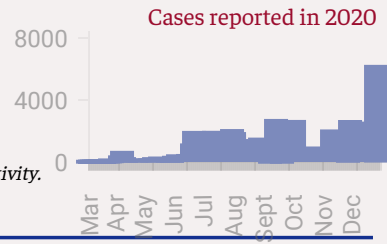

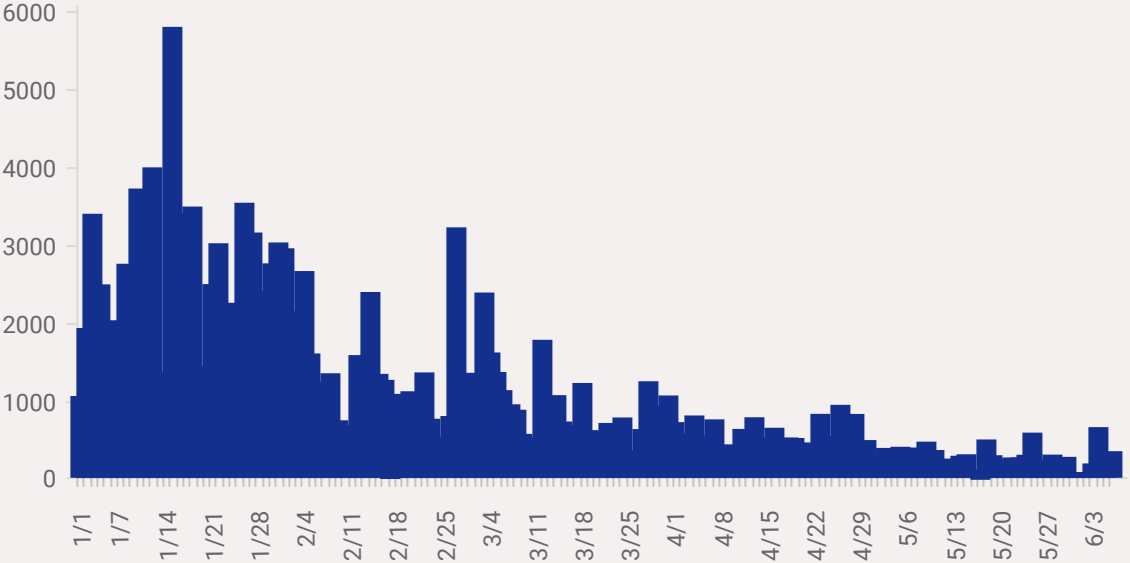
## Harris County Risk Level

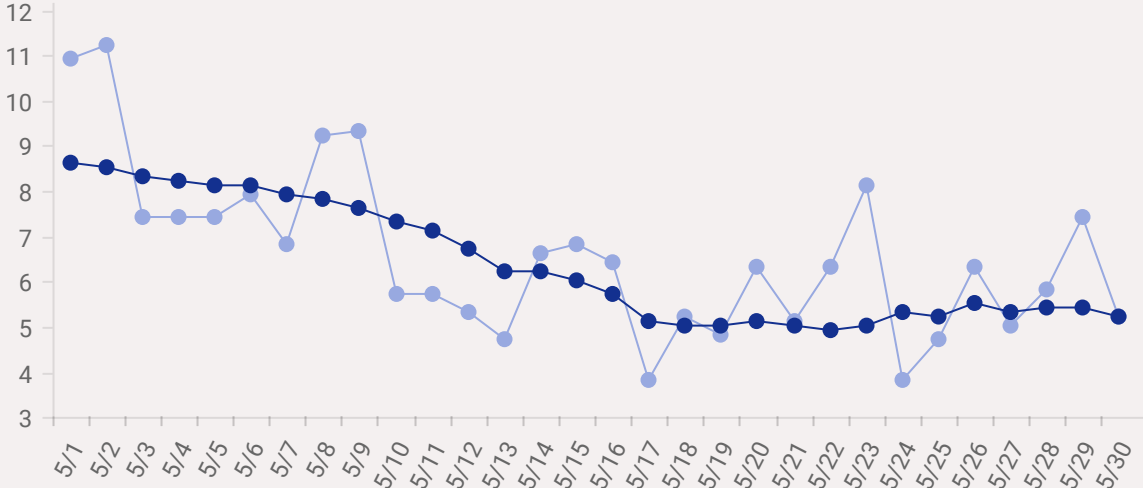

## Cases in Harris County 2021



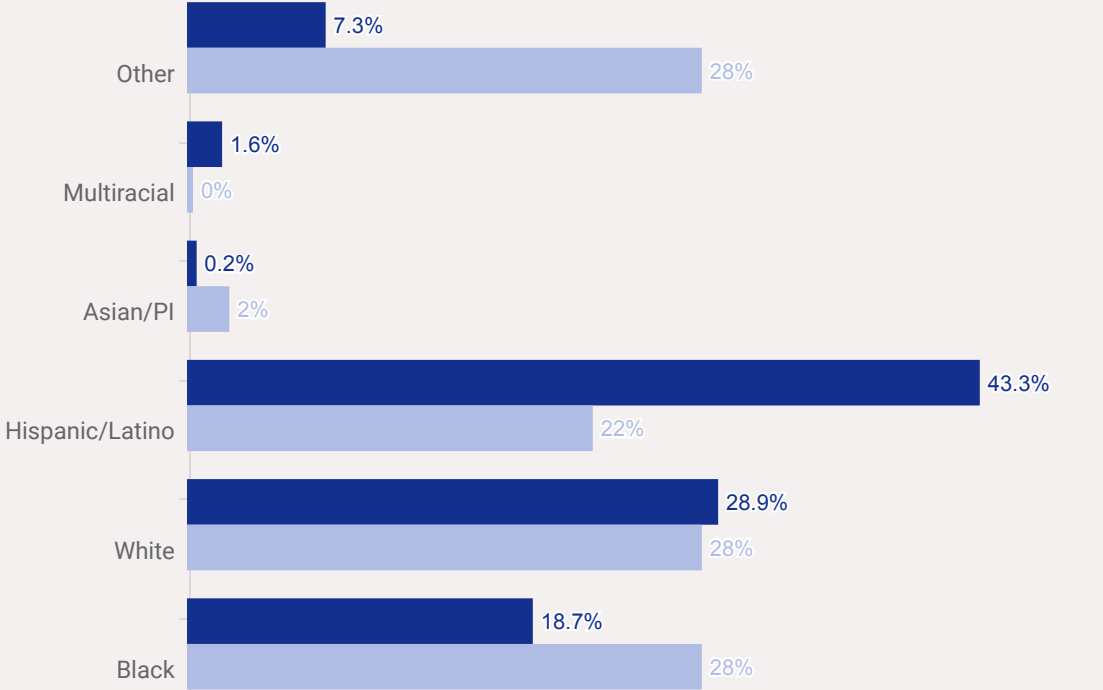
## Test Positivity in Harris County, 4/24/21-5/24/21
