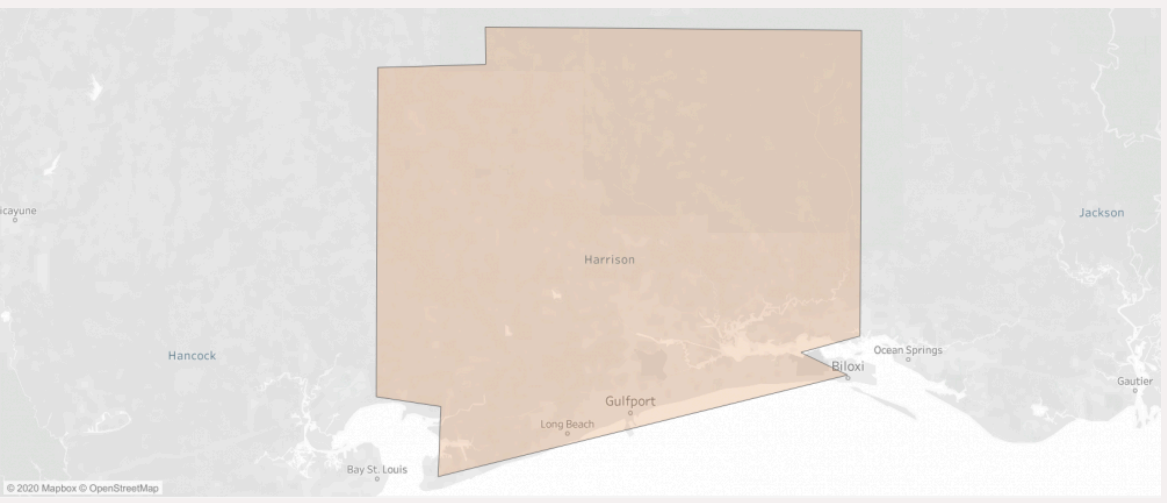

Harrison County ranks #3 in deaths and #2 in cases statewide

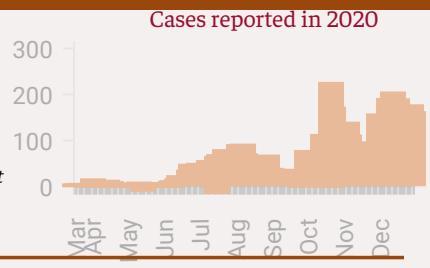

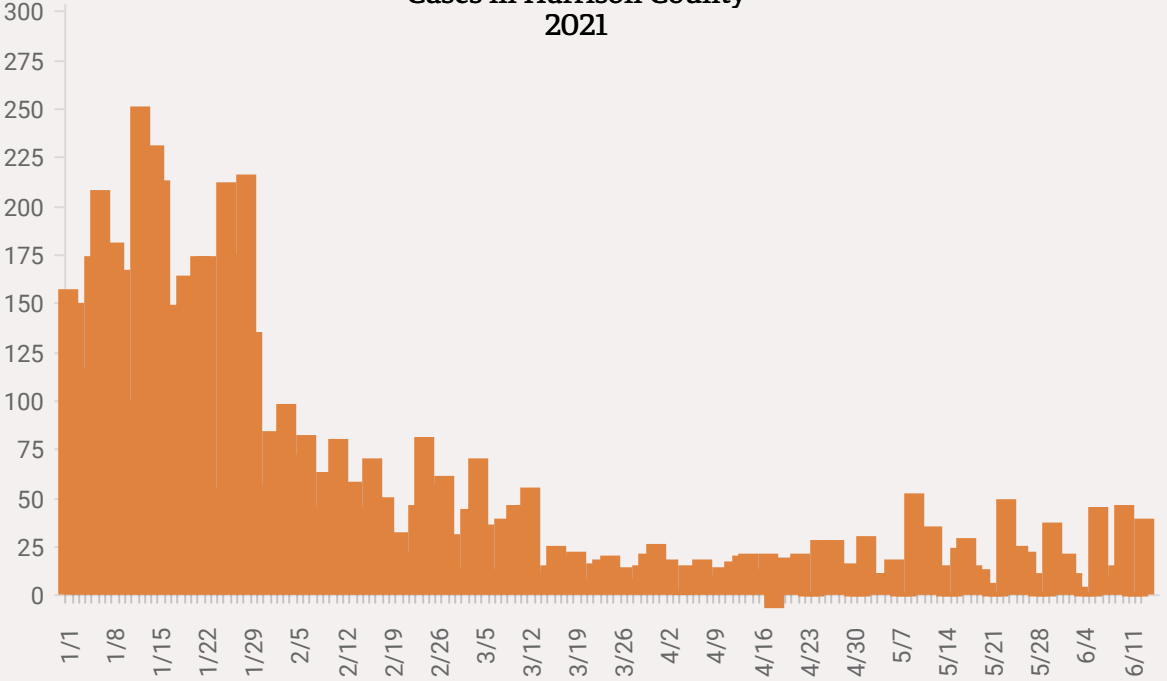
Harrison County Risk Level

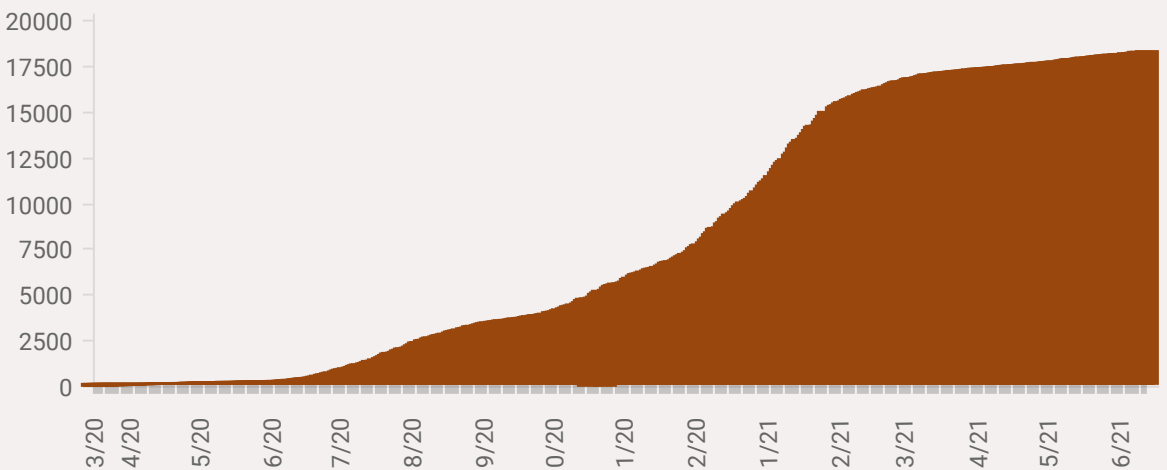


Cases in Harrison County 2021



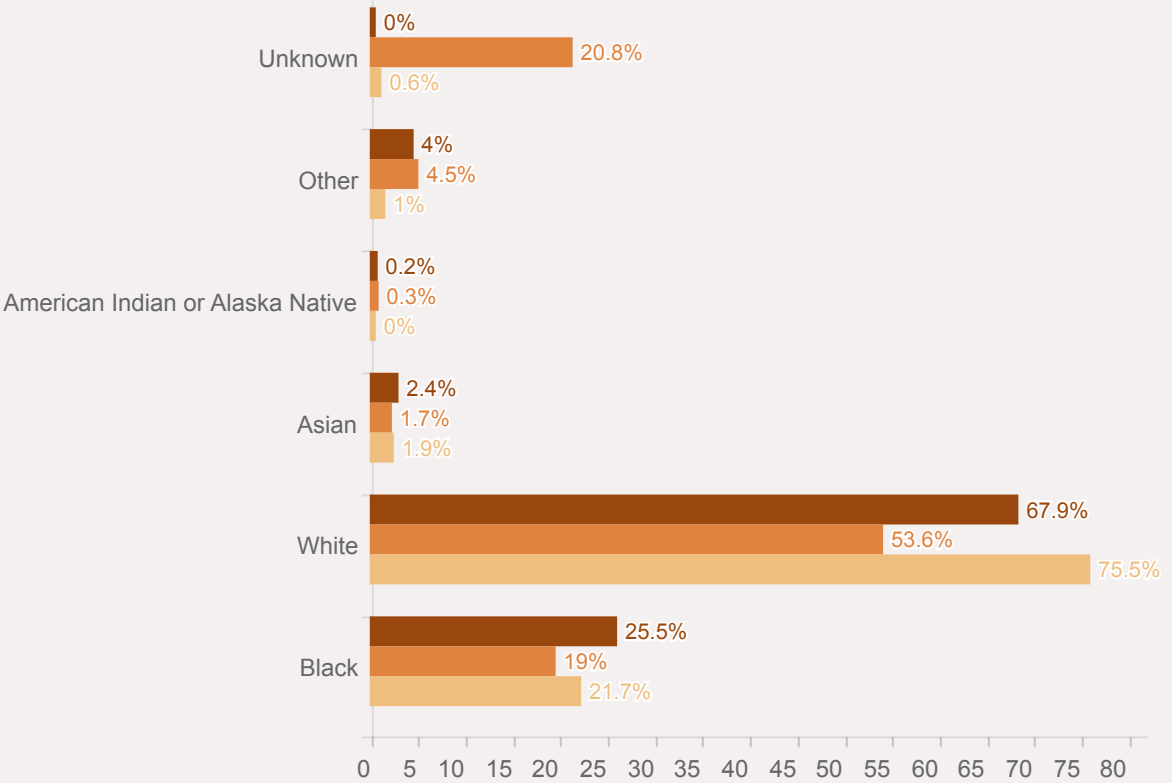
● Cumulative Cases
