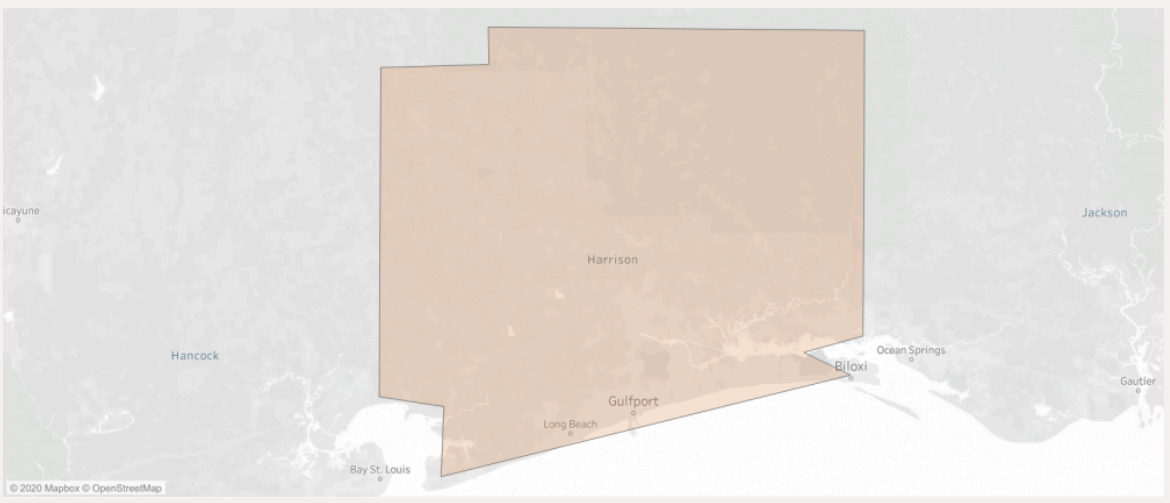

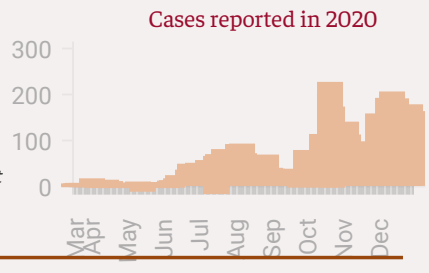

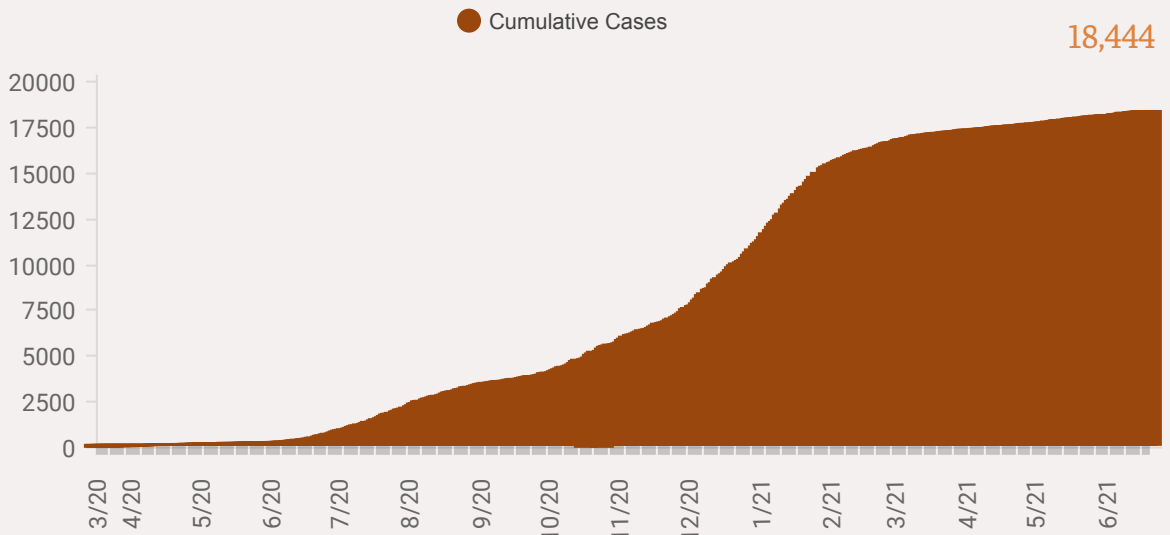
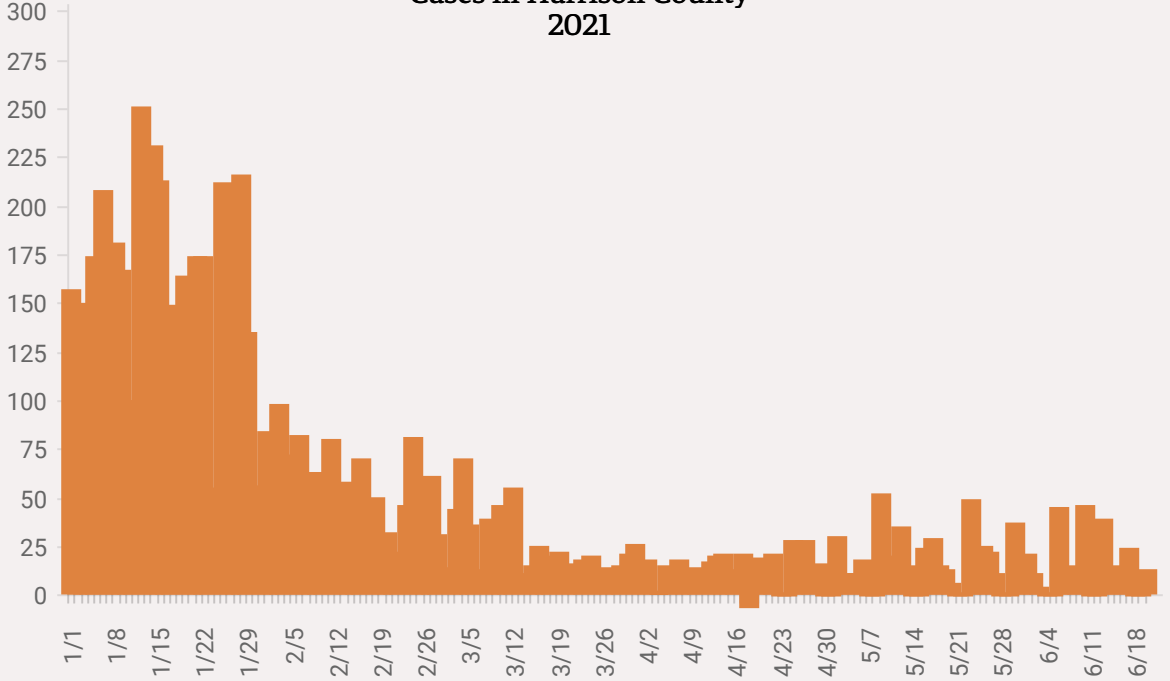
Harrison County Risk Level

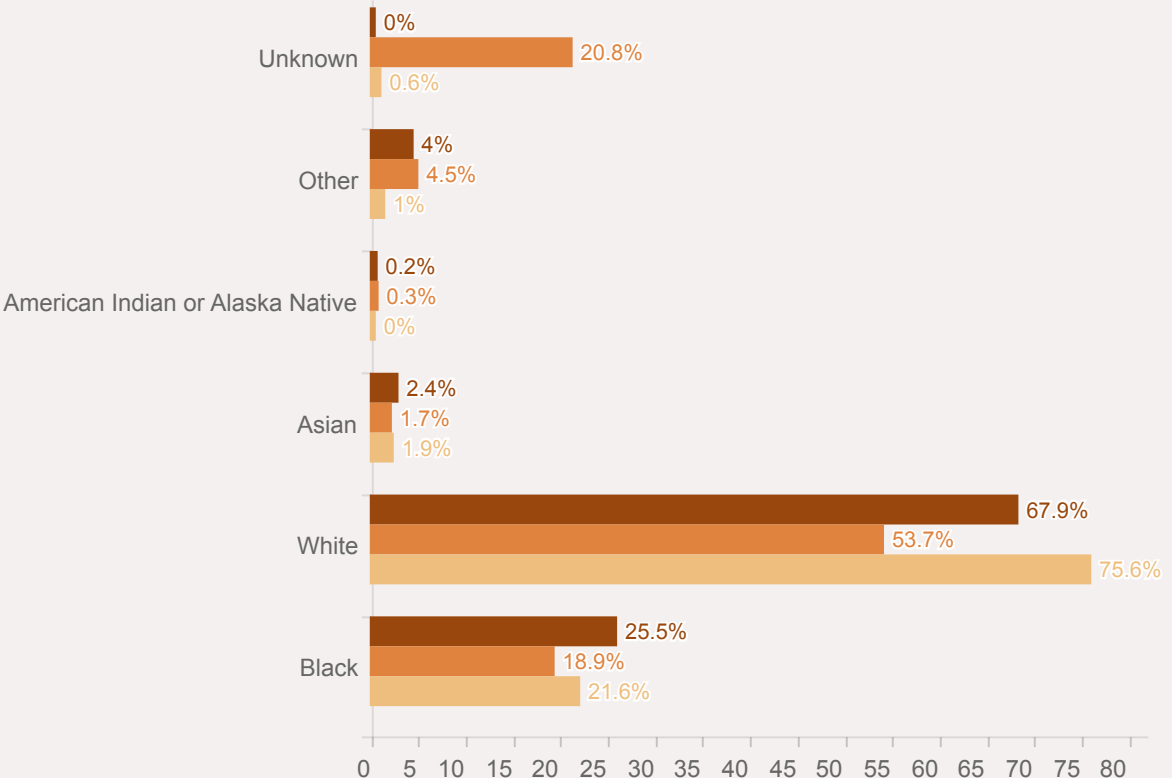


Cases in Harrison County 2021
