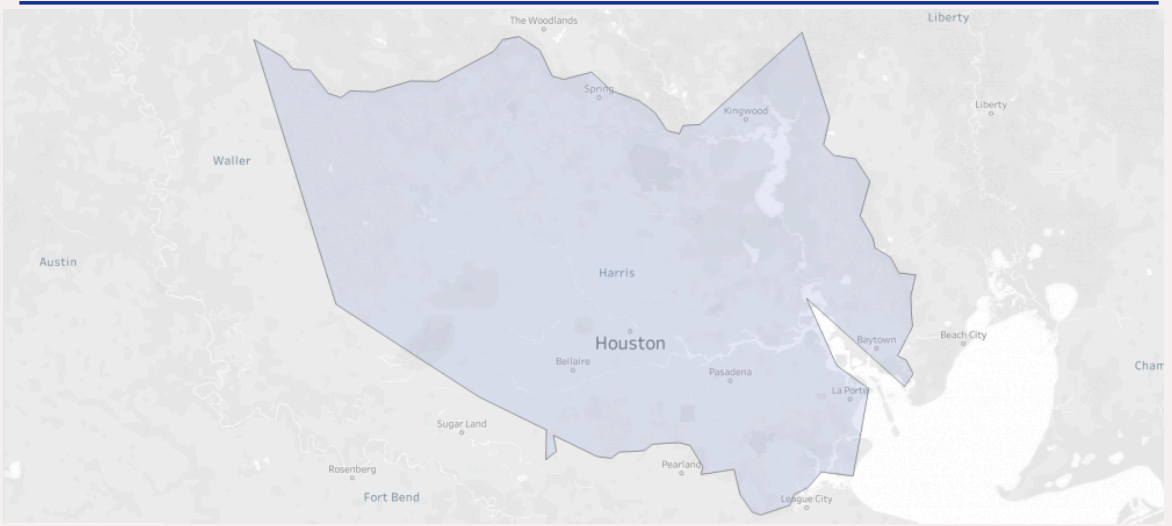

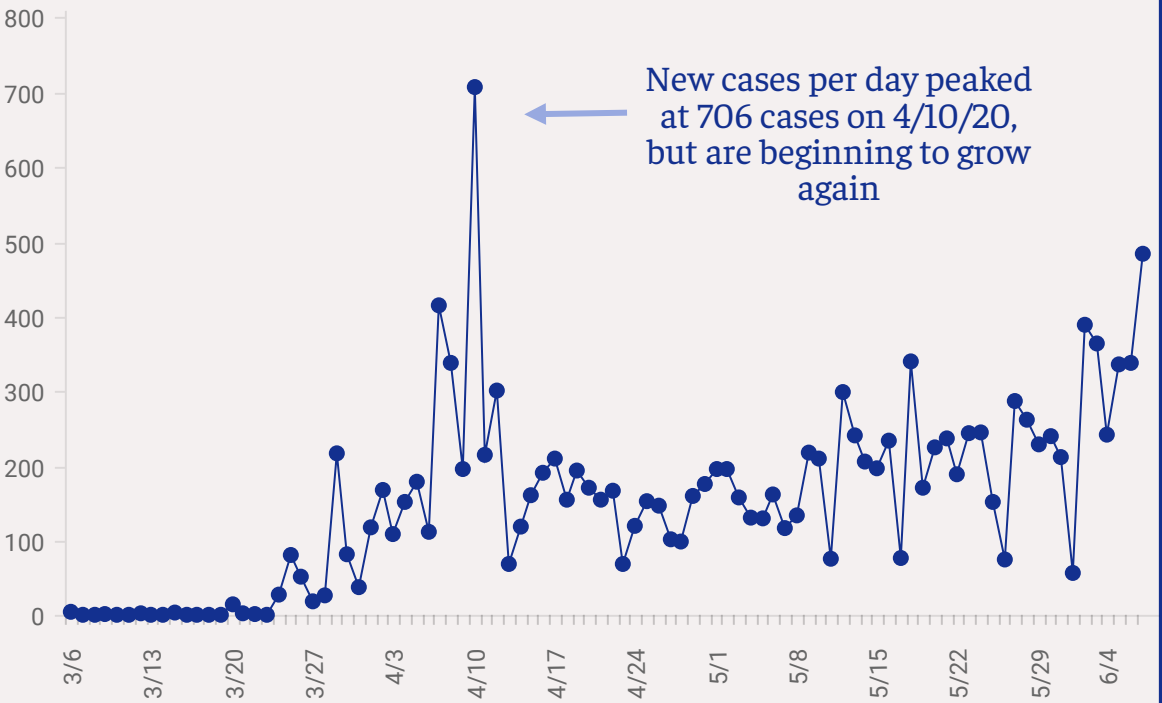
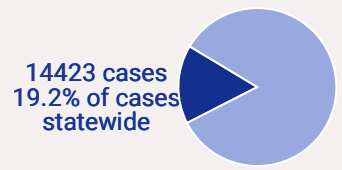
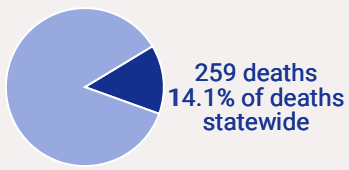

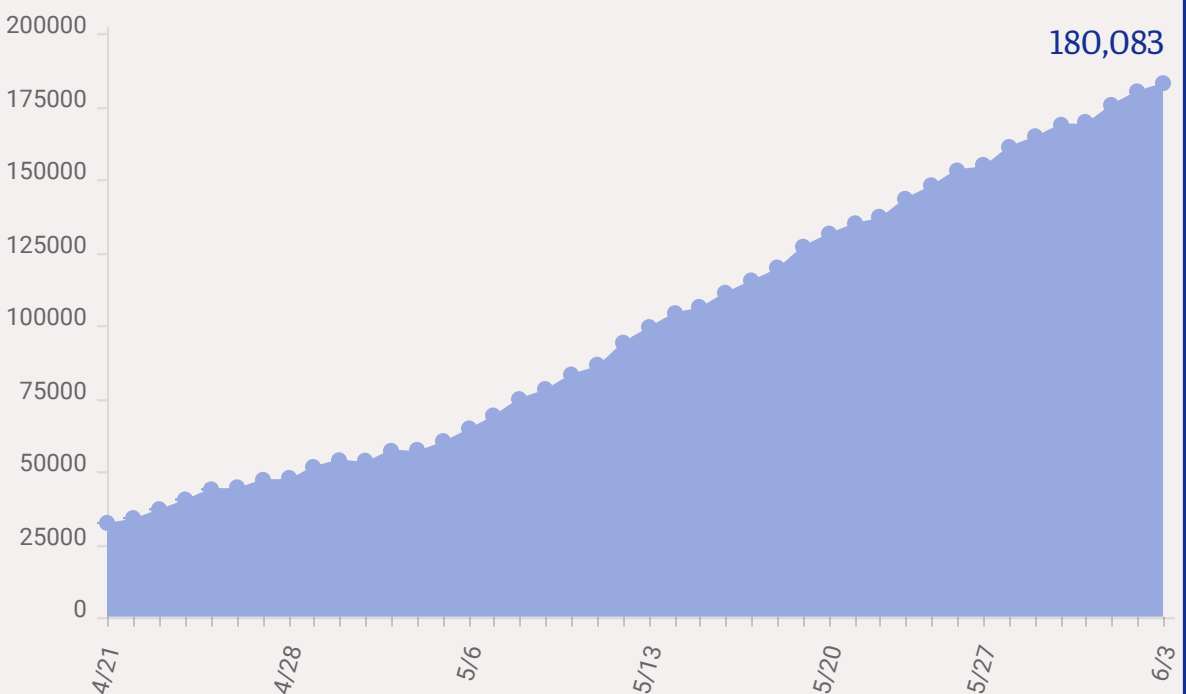

Total Number of COVID-19 tests done in Harris County (population 4,698,619)

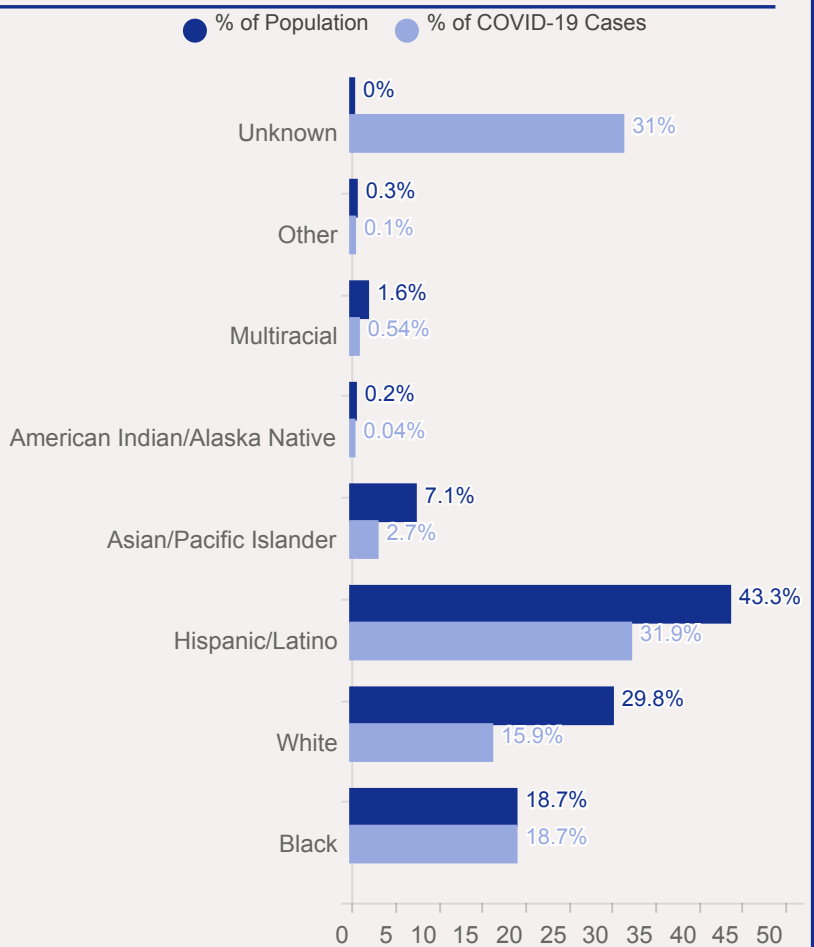


COVID-19 risk is not equal for all people in Harris County
