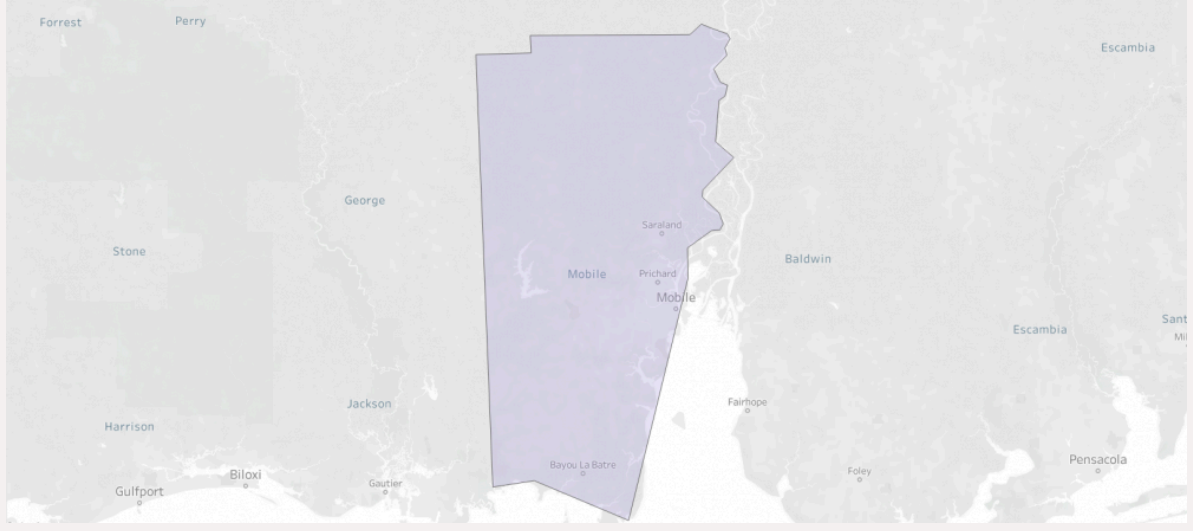

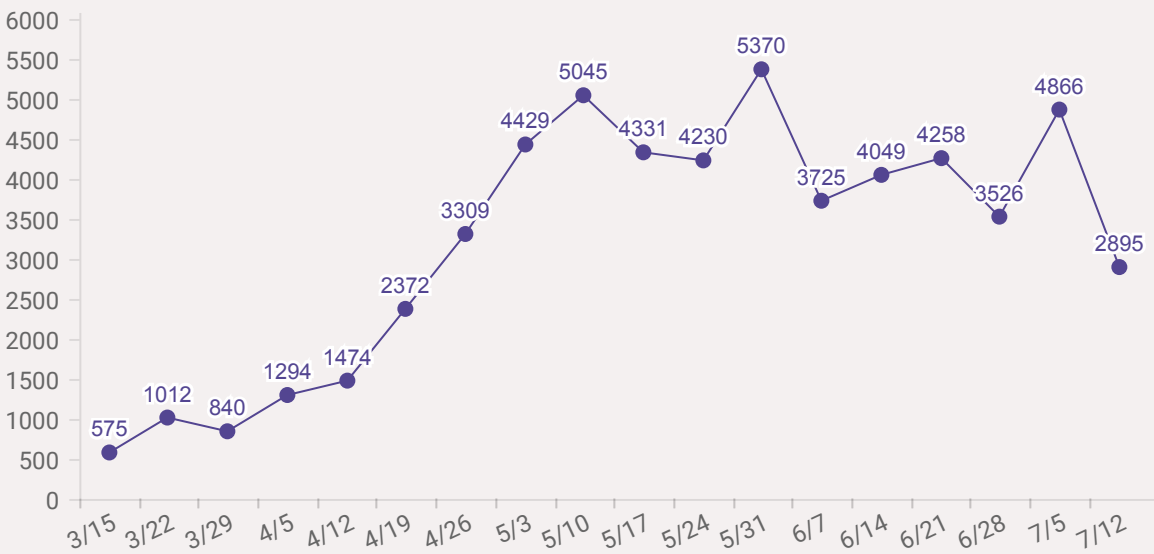

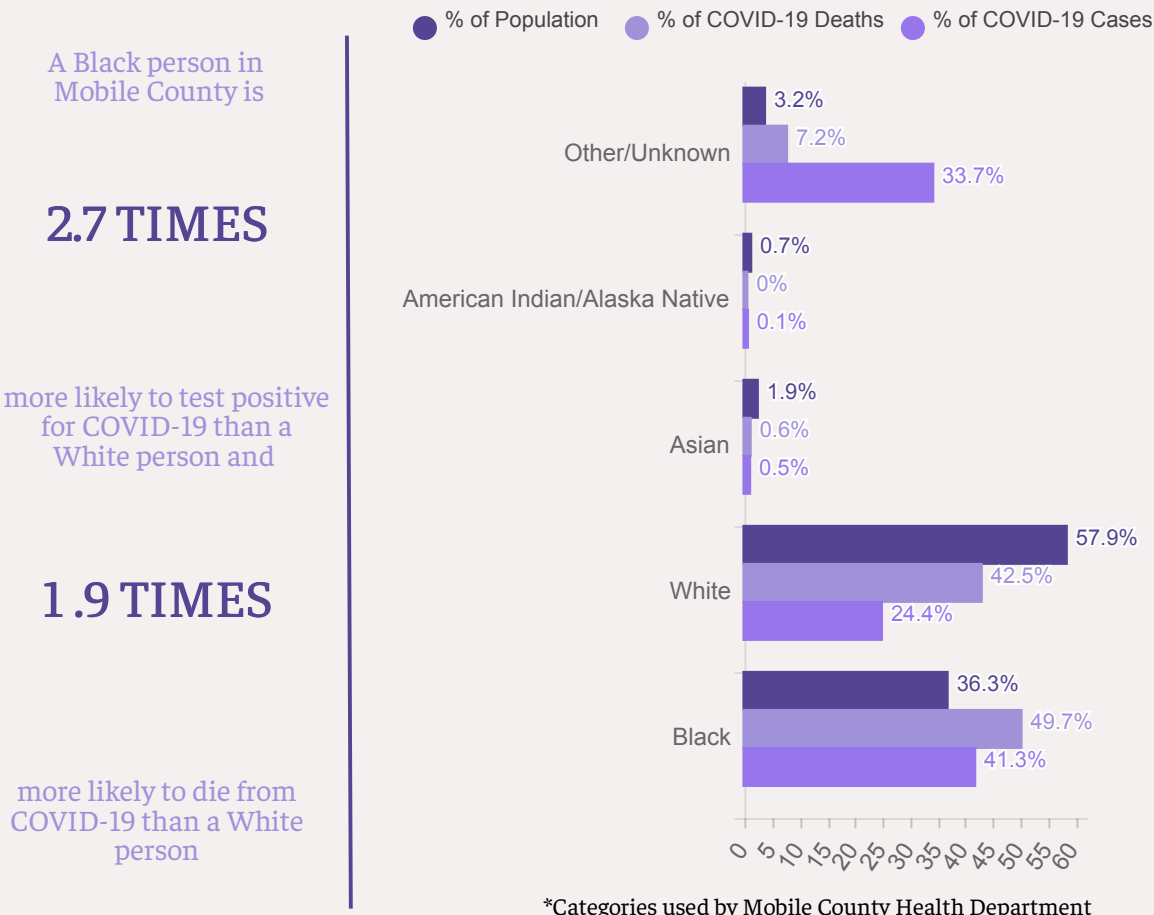
Mobile County ranks # 2 in deaths and #2 in cases statewide

### COVID-19 risk is not equal for all people in Mobile County



A Black person in Mobile County is

**2.7 TIMES**

more likely to test positive for COVID-19 than a White person and

**1.9 TIMES**

more likely to die from COVID-19 than a White person

Mobile County is home to

**11** facilities that release

**15.7** million pounds of toxic pollution each year

Exposure to air pollution is linked to increased risk of death from COVID-19
