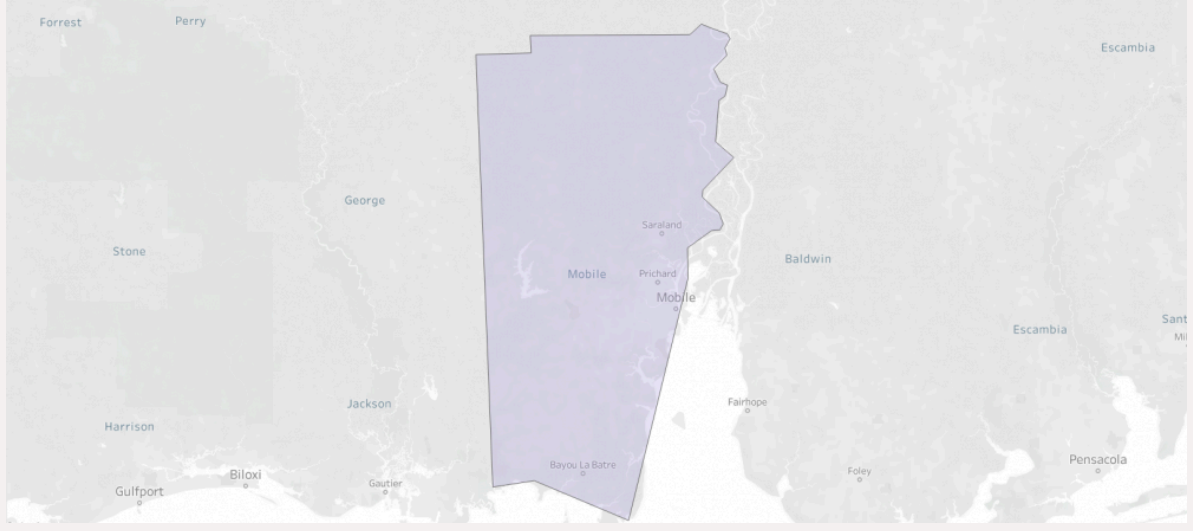

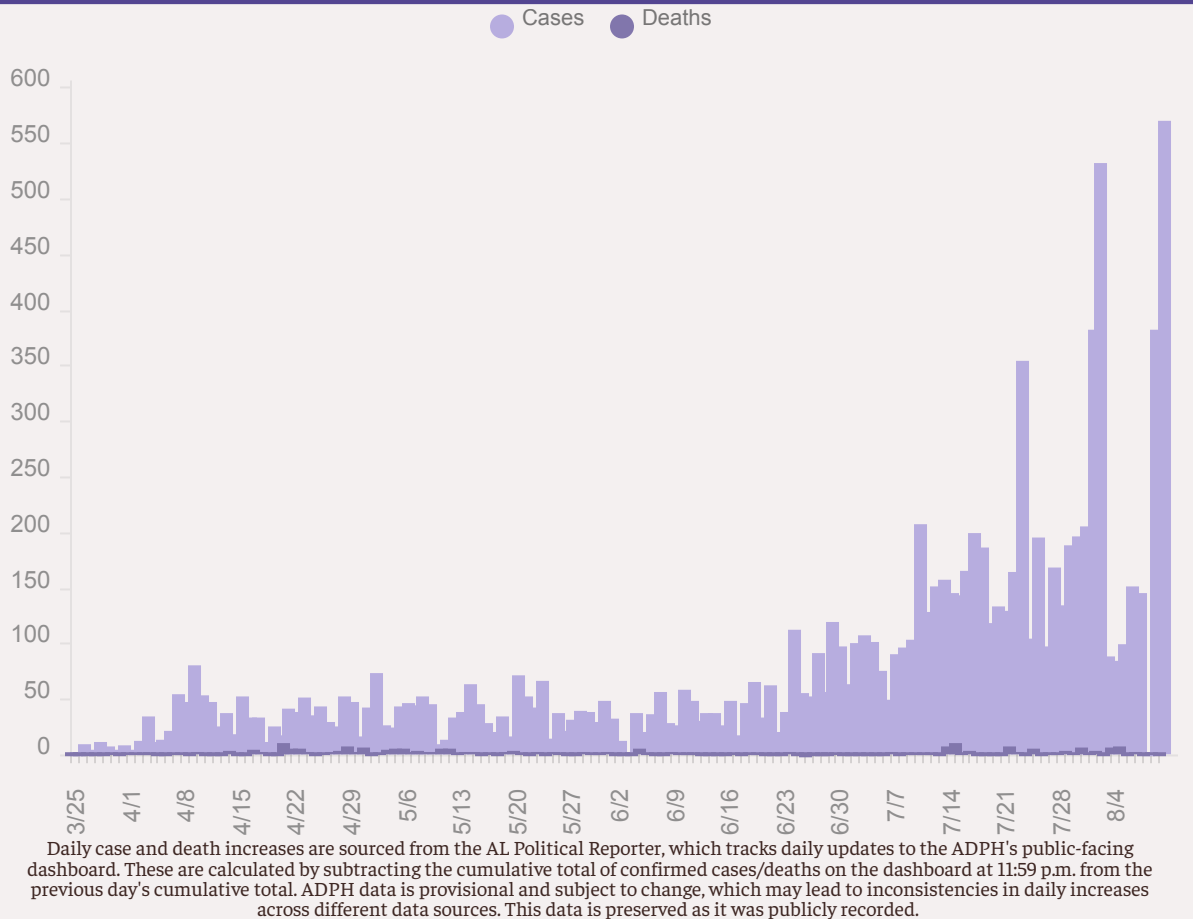
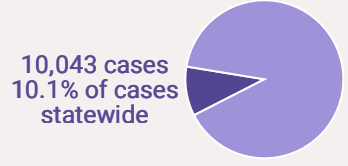

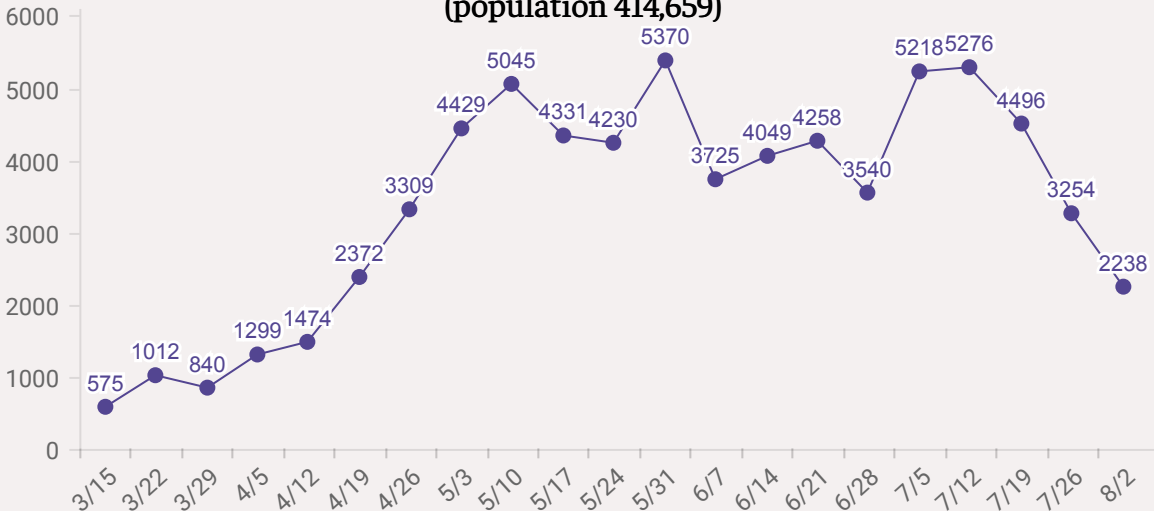

COVID-19 risk is not equal for all people in Mobile County

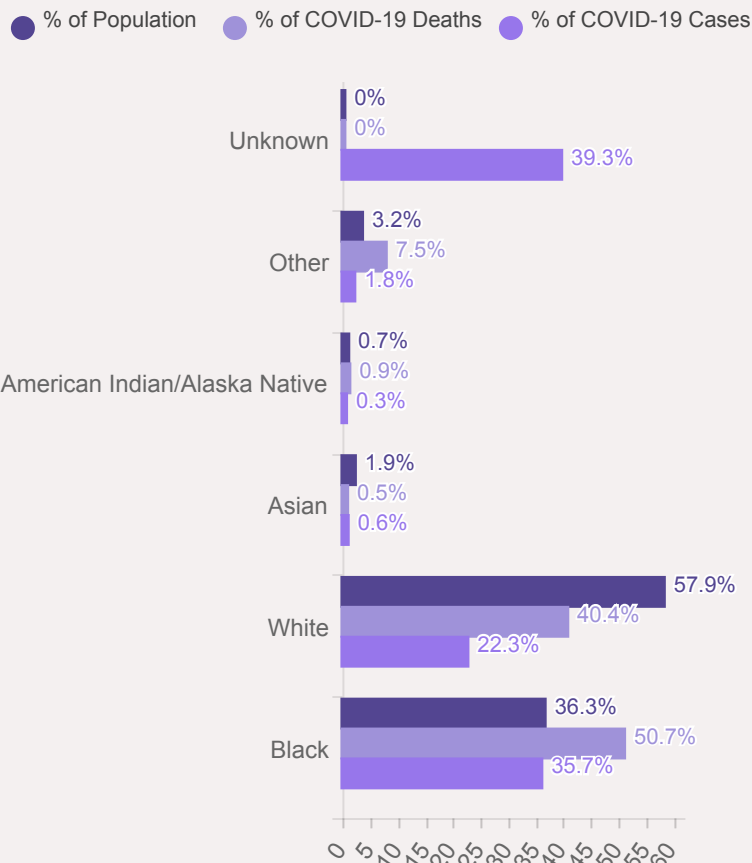
A Black person in Mobile County is
