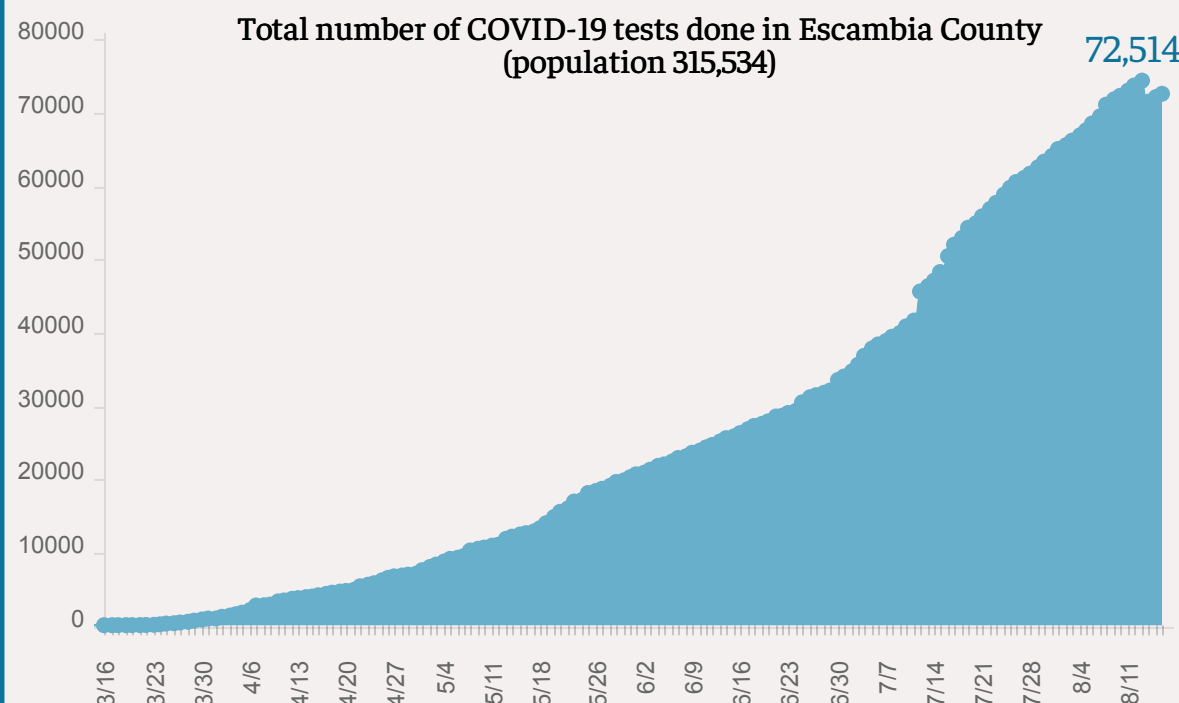
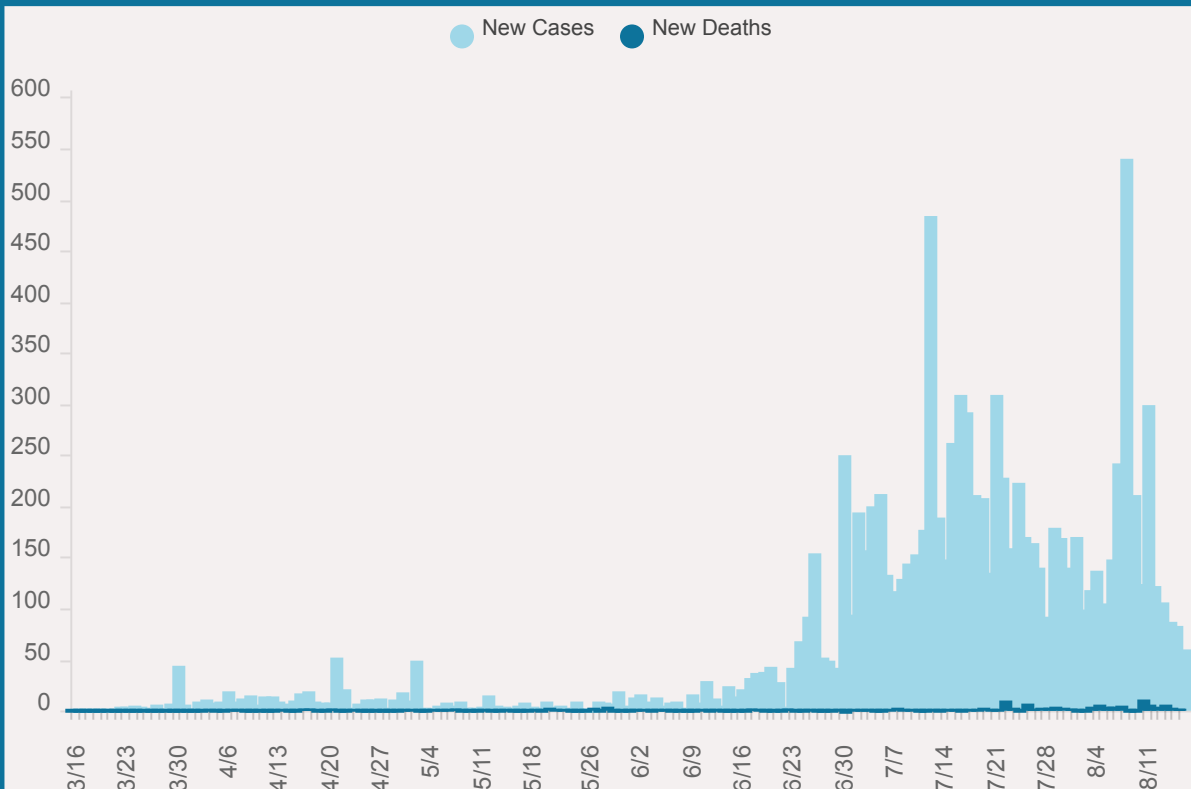

COVID-19 risk is not equal for all people in Escambia County

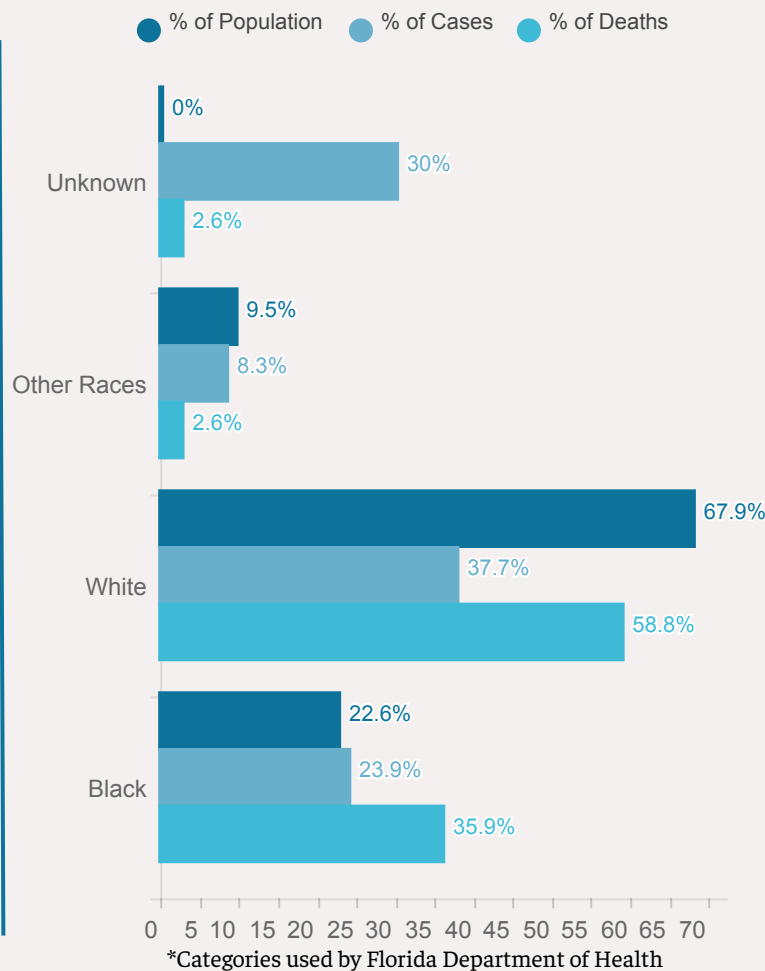
A Black person in
