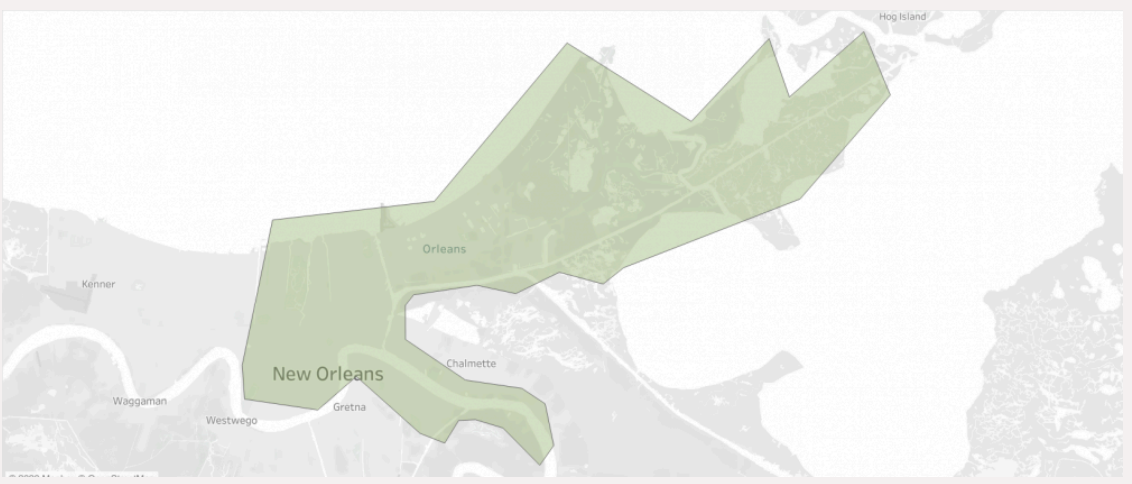

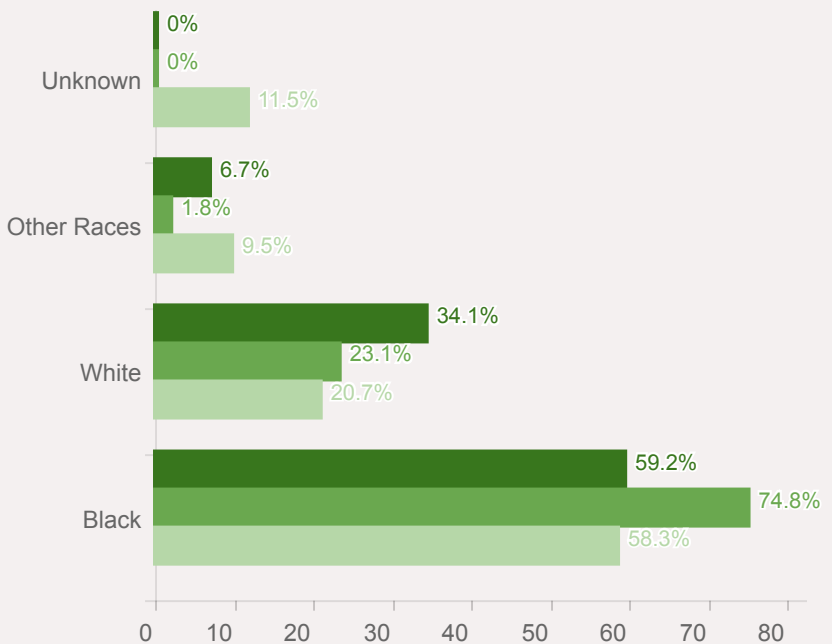
A Black person in New Orleans is
