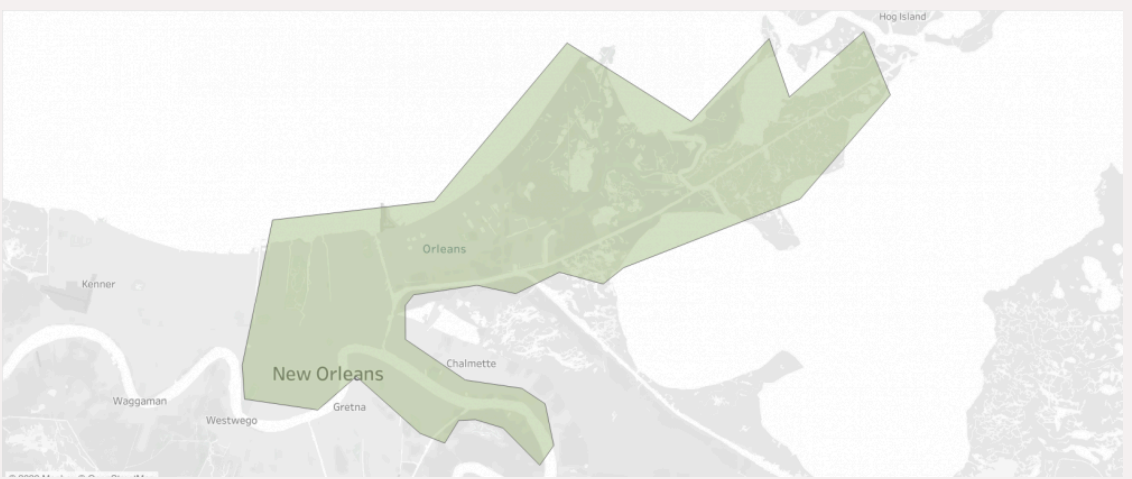

Orleans Parish ranks # 1 in deaths and #3 in cases statewide

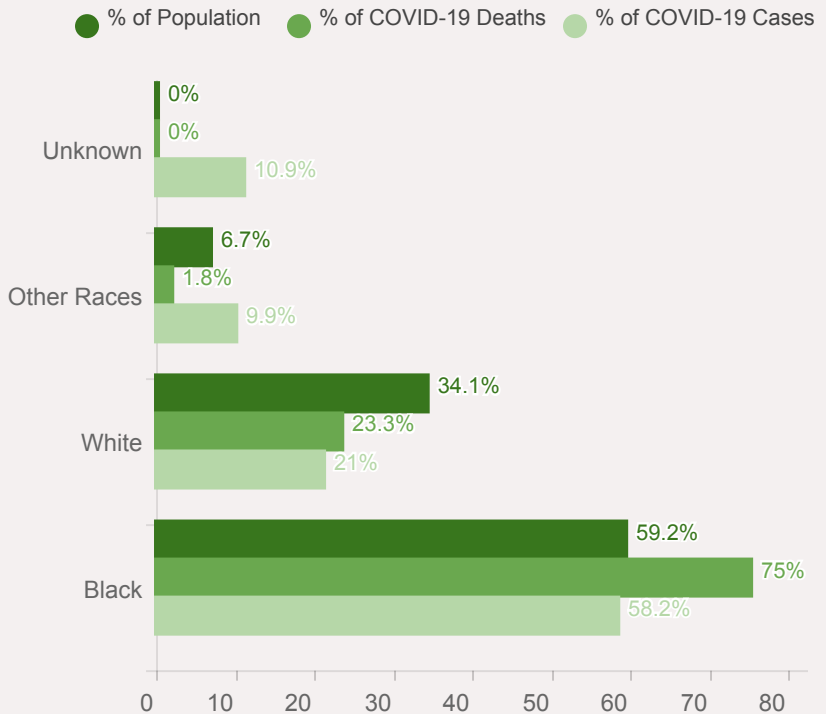


## COVID-19 risk is not equal for all people in New Orleans

14 neighborhood areas (census tracts) have more than 150 cases  
 5 are in New Orleans East



A Black person in  
 New Orleans is

 more likely to test positive  
 for COVID-19 than a  
 White person and  
**1.9 TIMES**  
 more likely to die from  
 COVID-19 than a White  
 person
