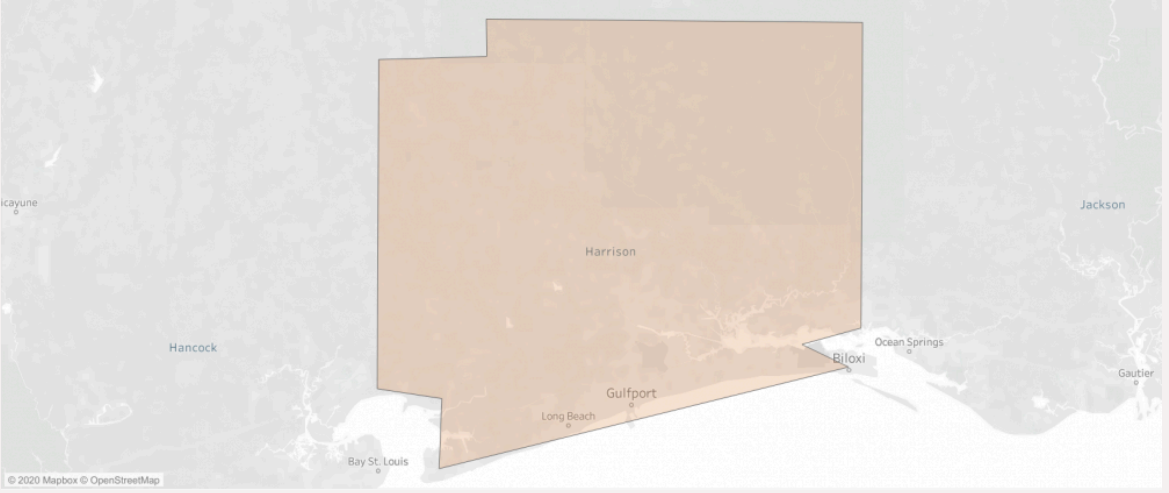

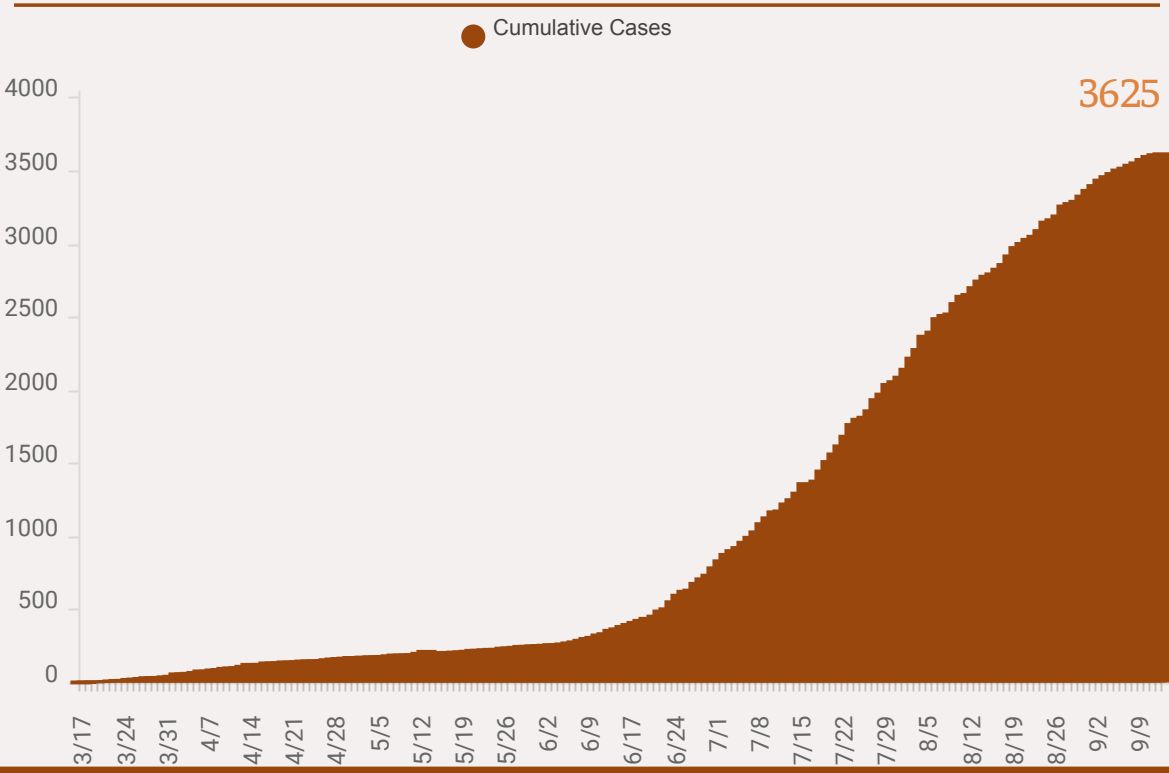
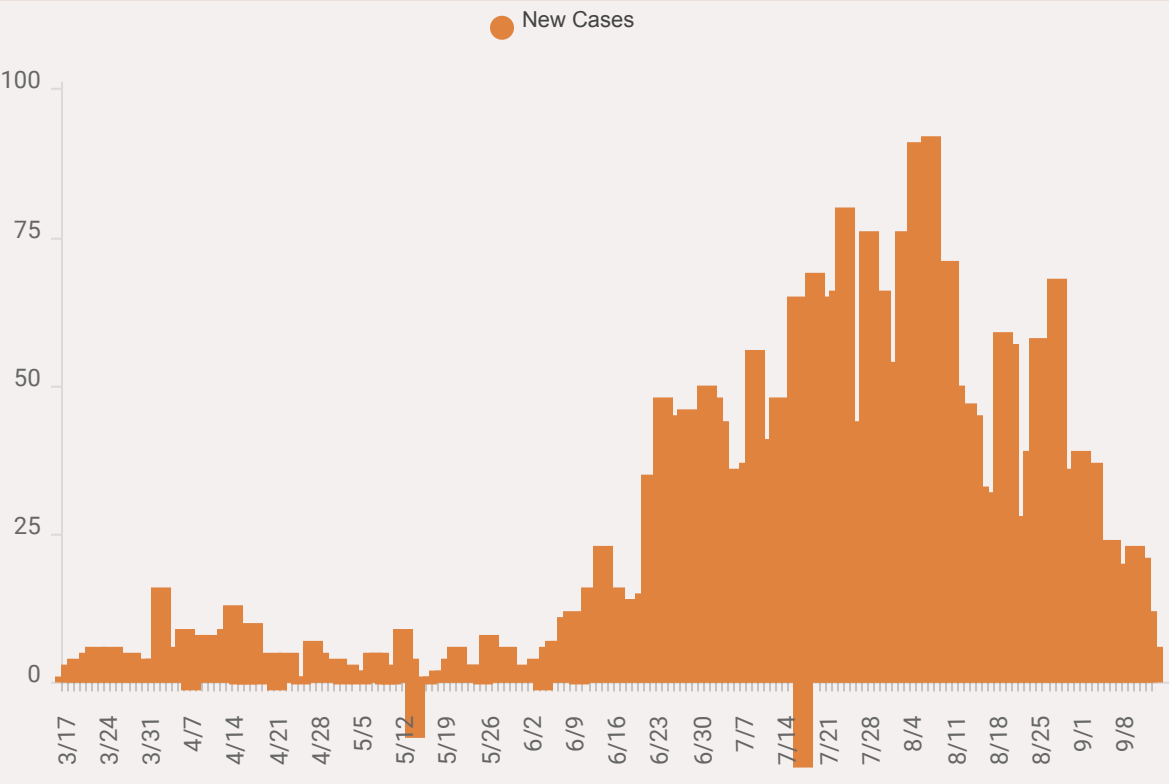

## COVID-19 risk is not equal for all people in Harrison County

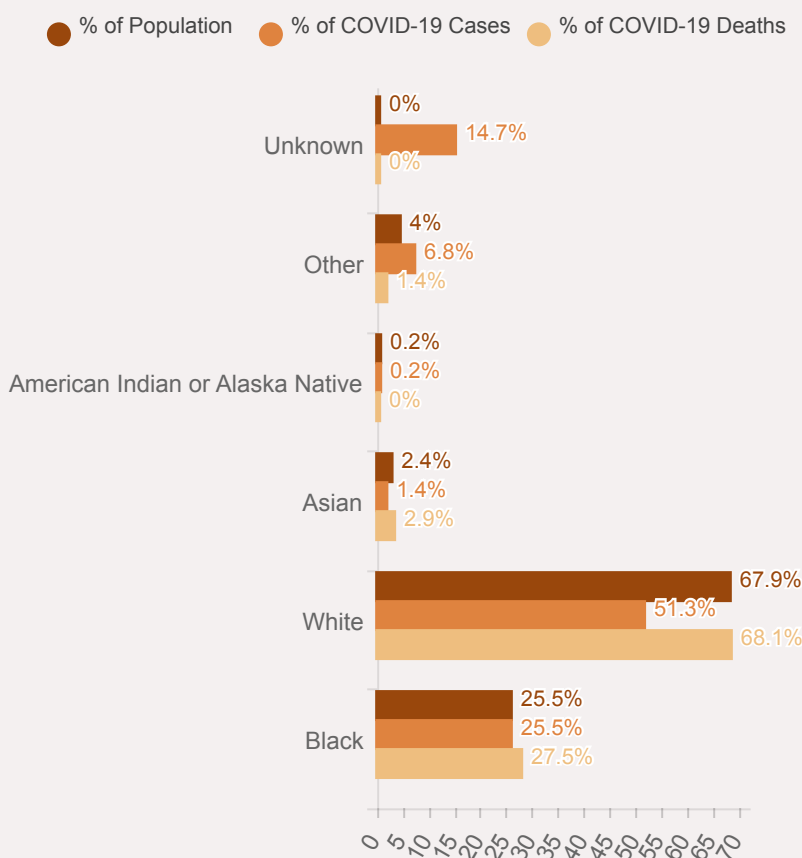
A Black person in Harrison County is
