Orleans Parish ranks # 1 in deaths and #3 in cases statewide

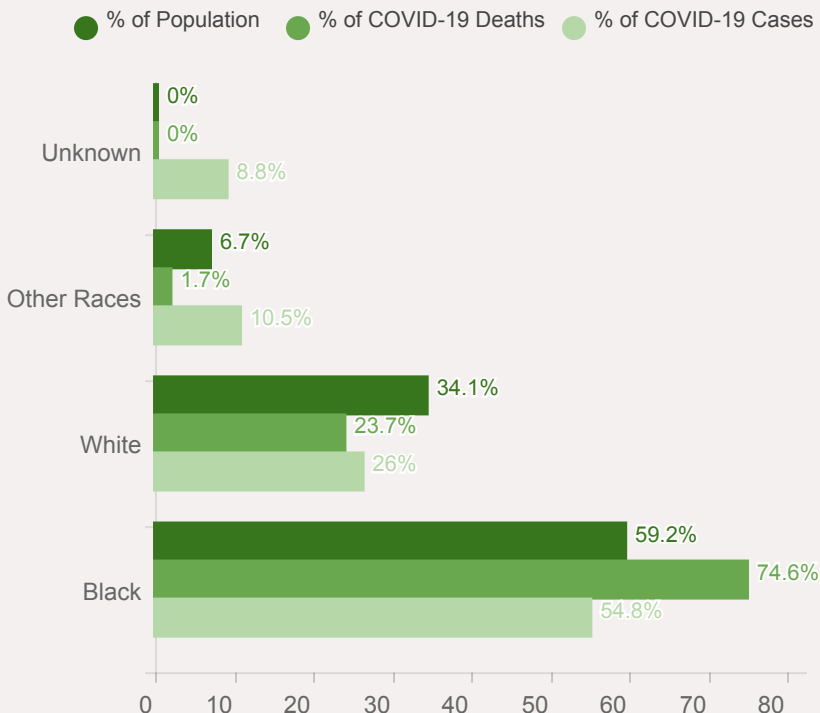


## COVID-19 risk is not equal for all people in New Orleans
