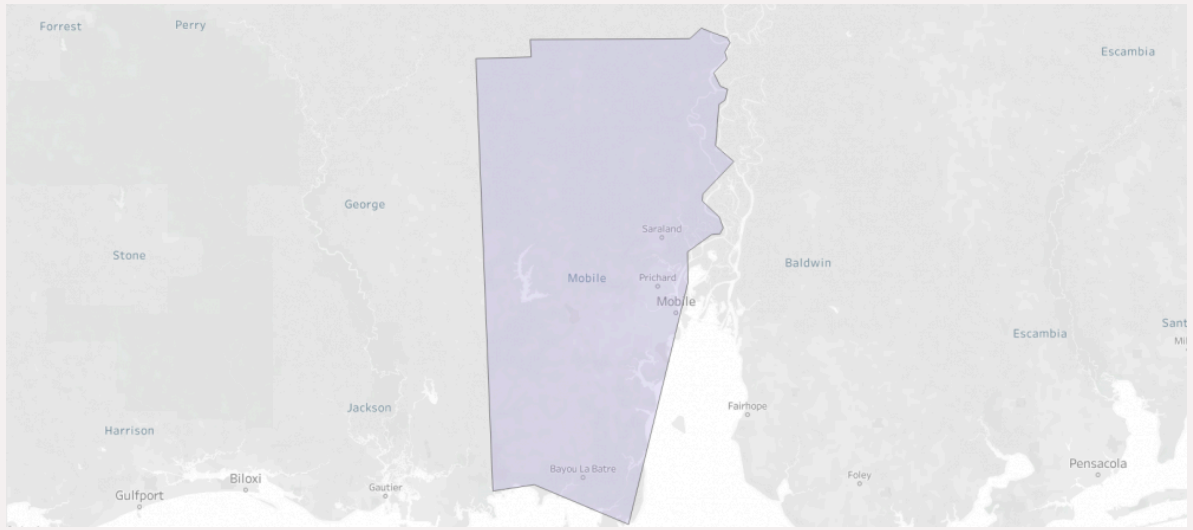

ADPH data is provisional and subject to change, which may lead to inconsistencies in daily increases across different data sources. This data is preserved as it was publicly recorded.

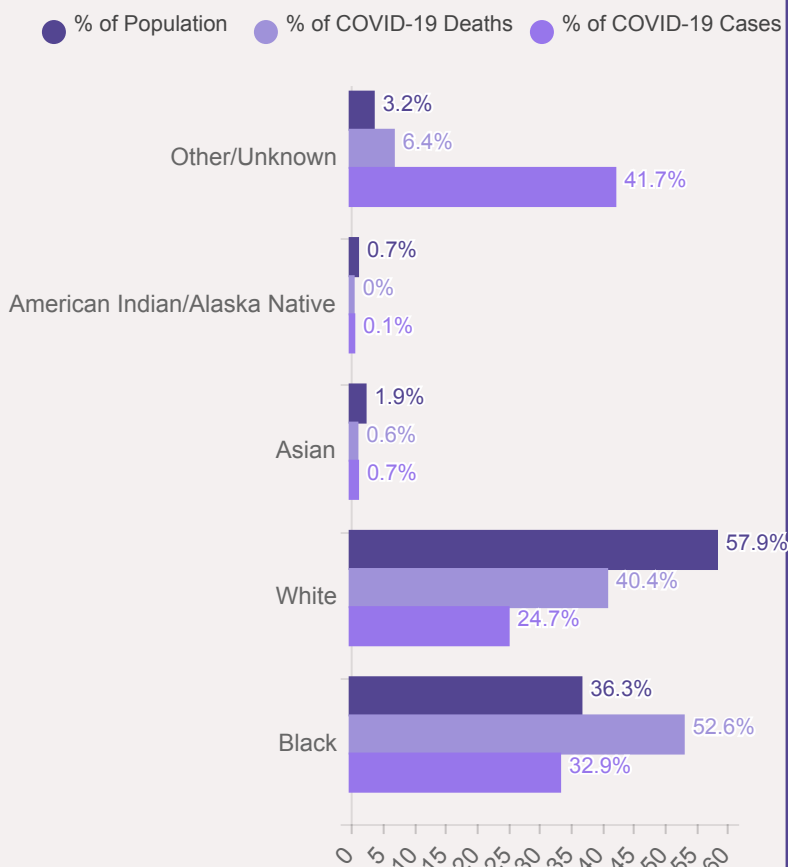
