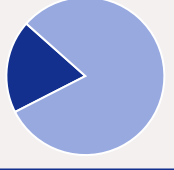

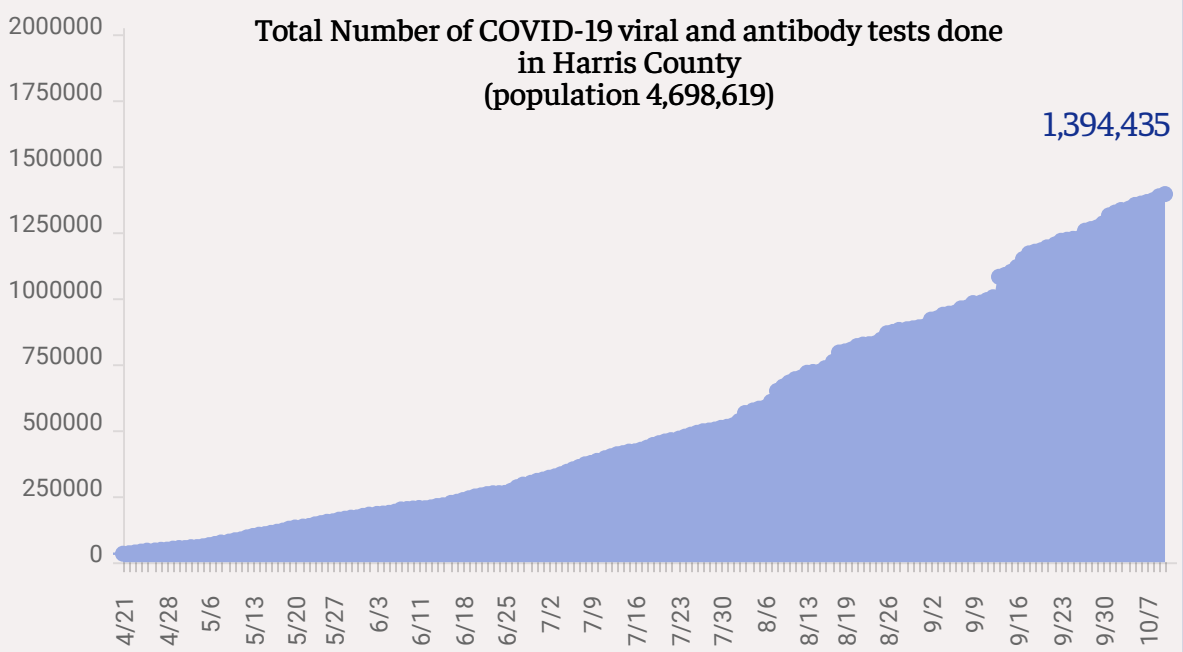
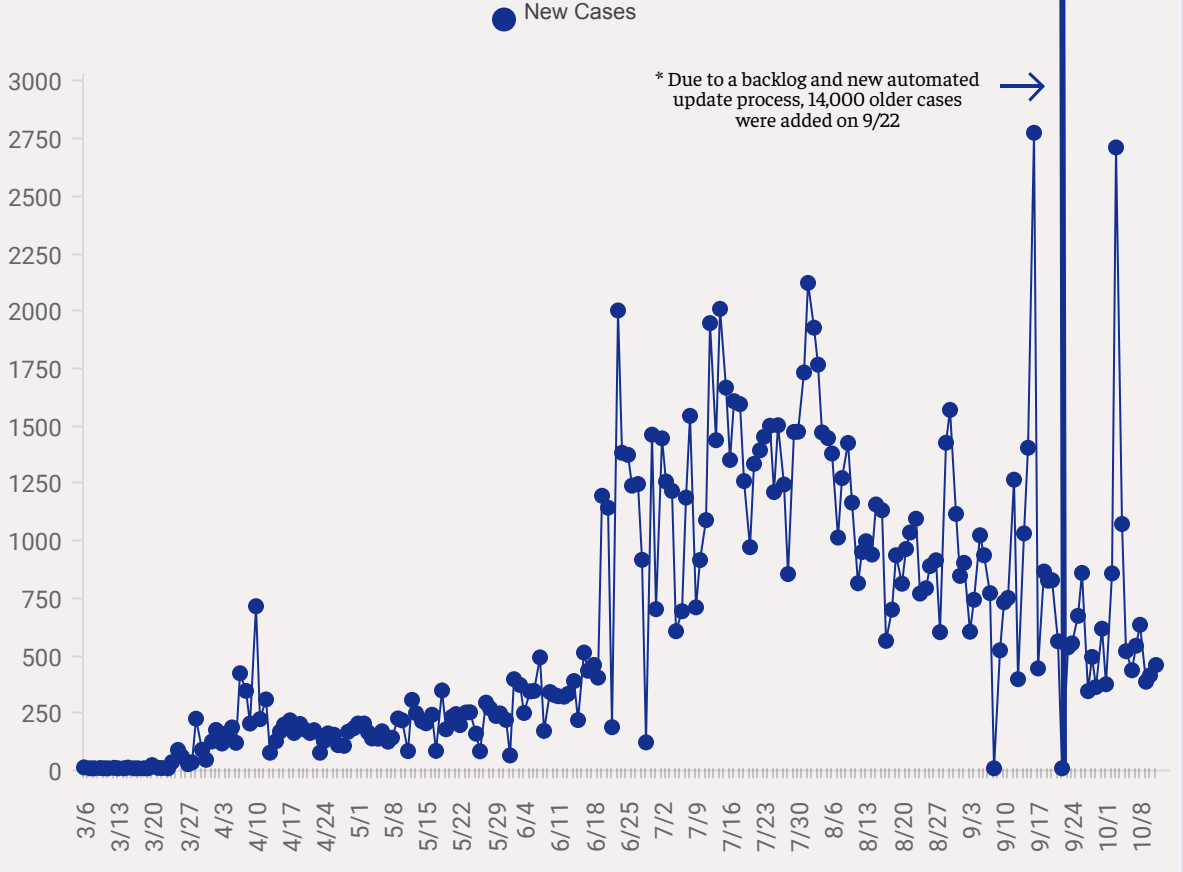
Harris County ranks #1 in deaths and #1 in cases statewide

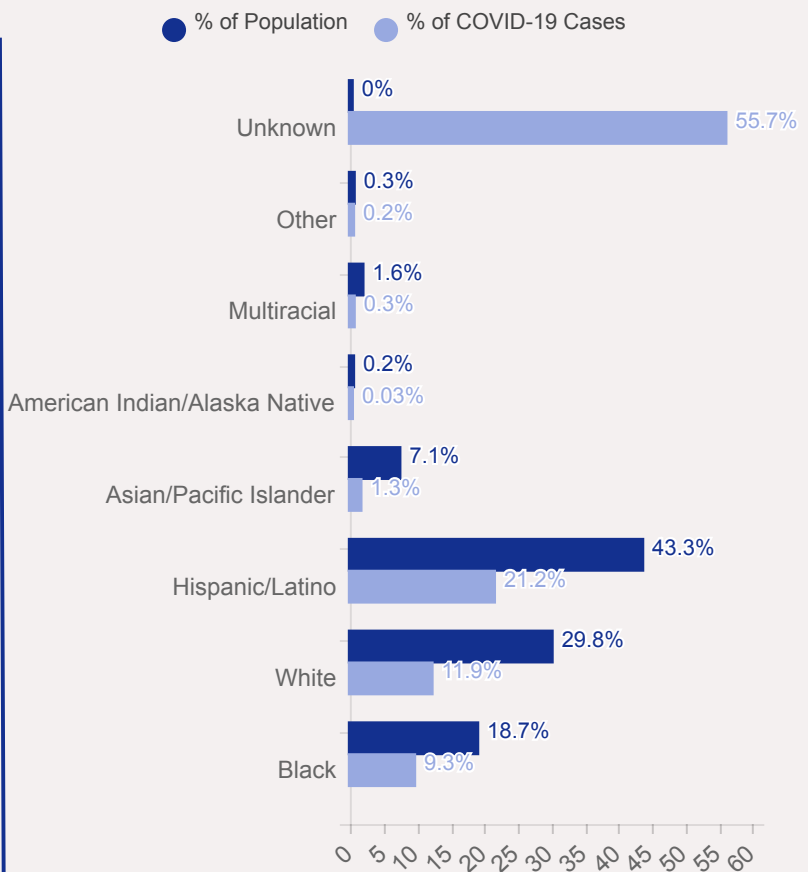


COVID-19 risk is not equal for all people in Harris County
