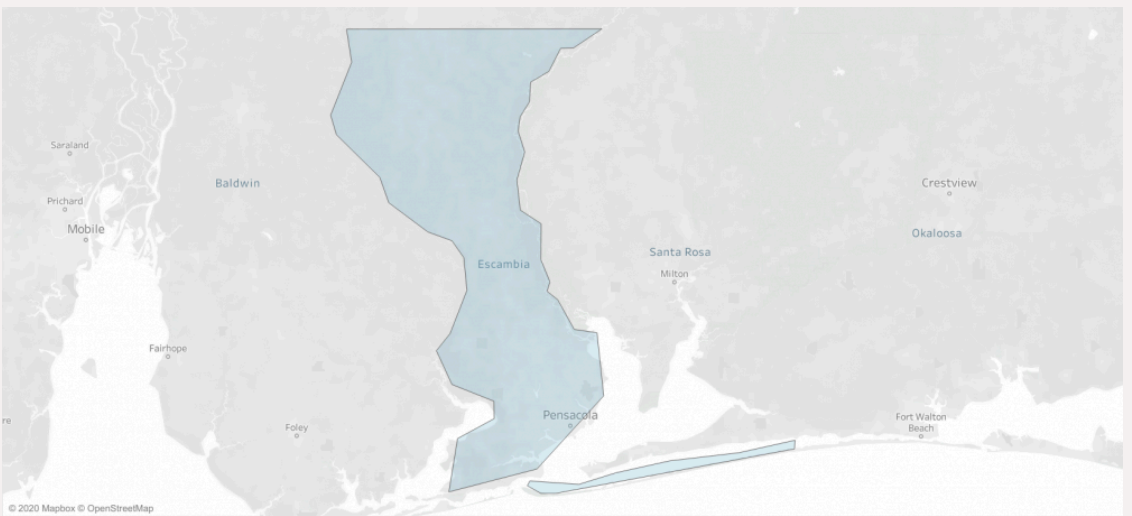

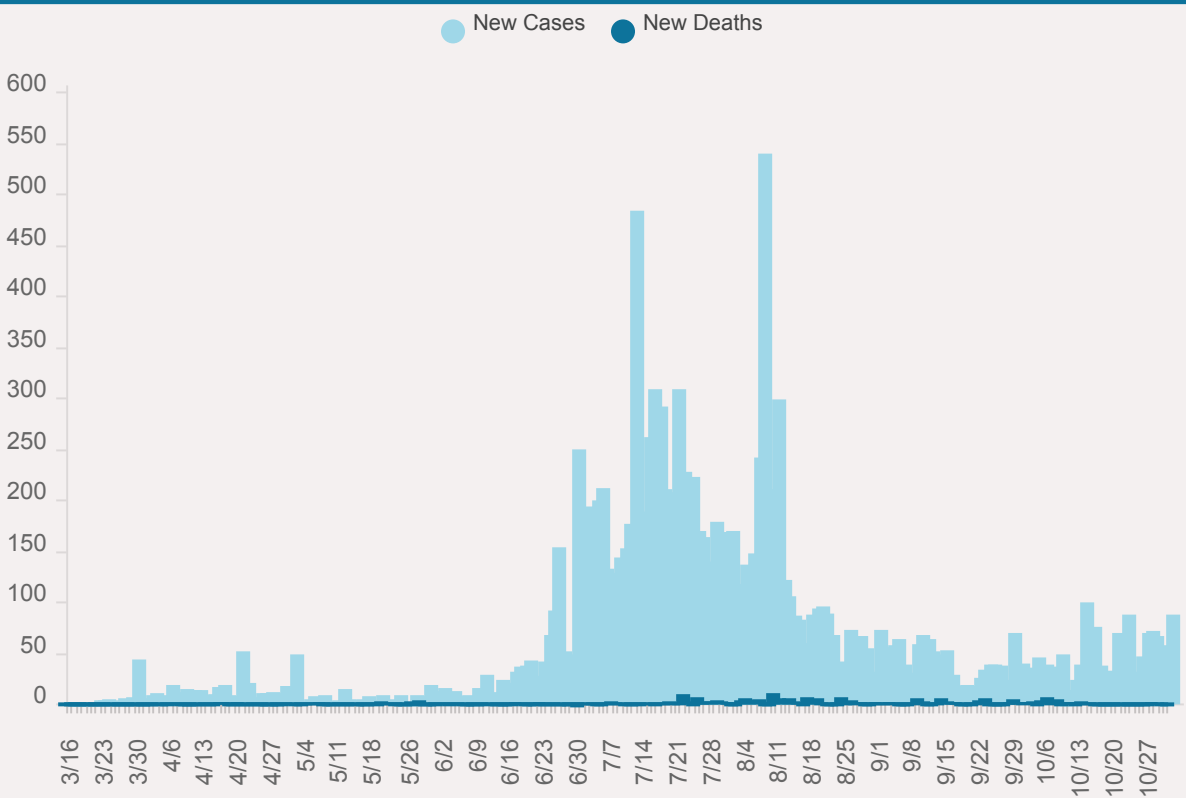

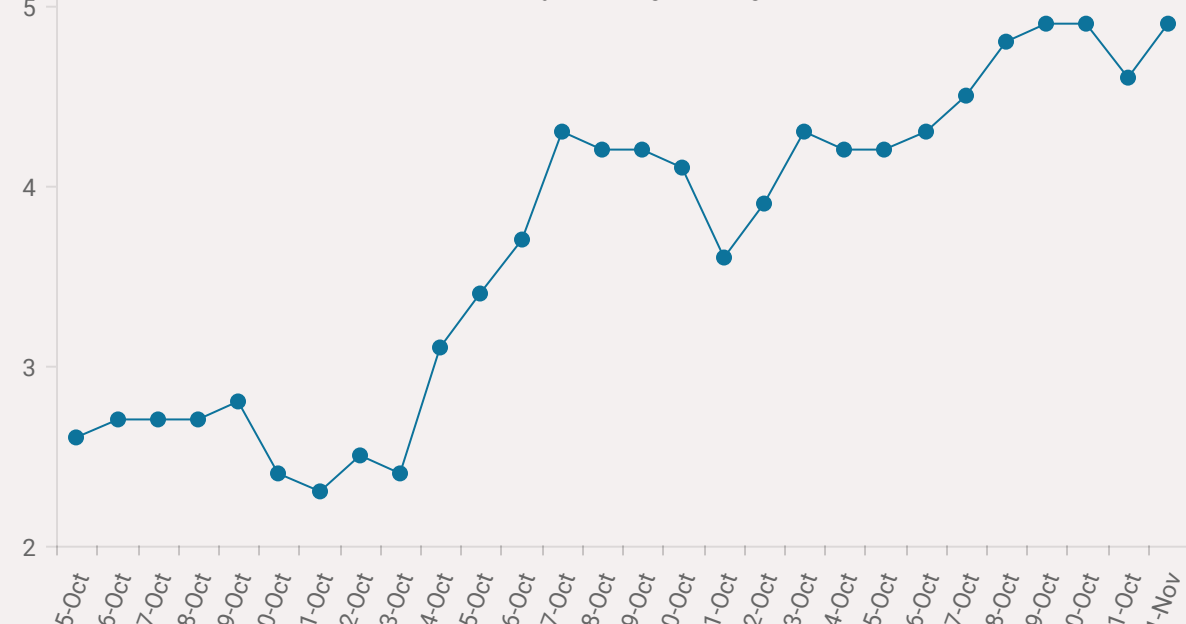
Escambia County ranks #16 in deaths and #12 in cases statewide

COVID-19 risk is not equal for all people in Escambia County

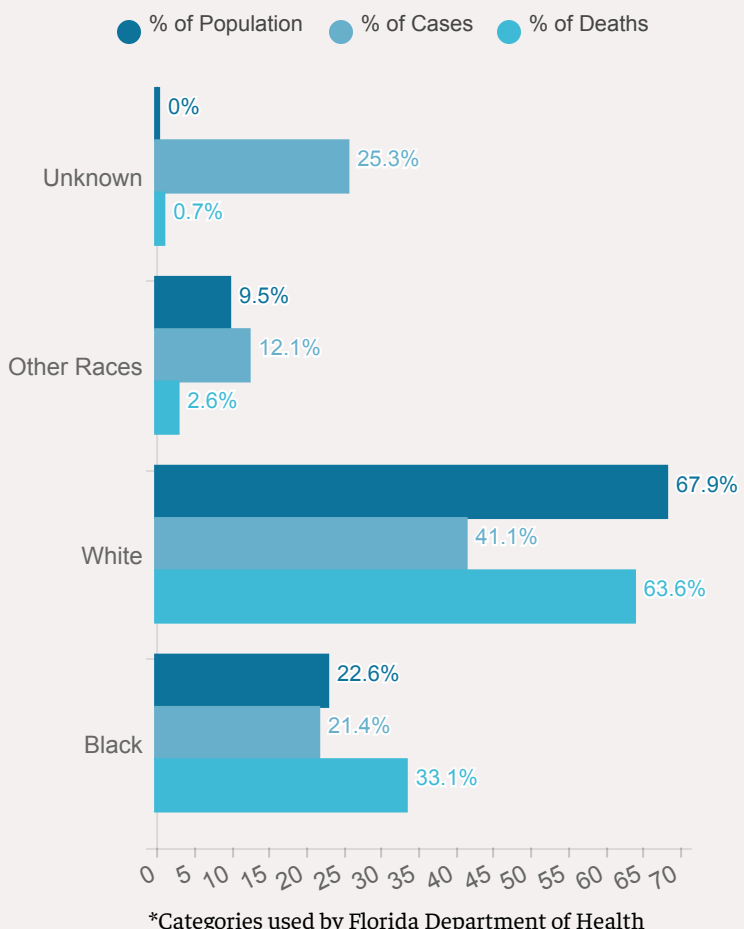
