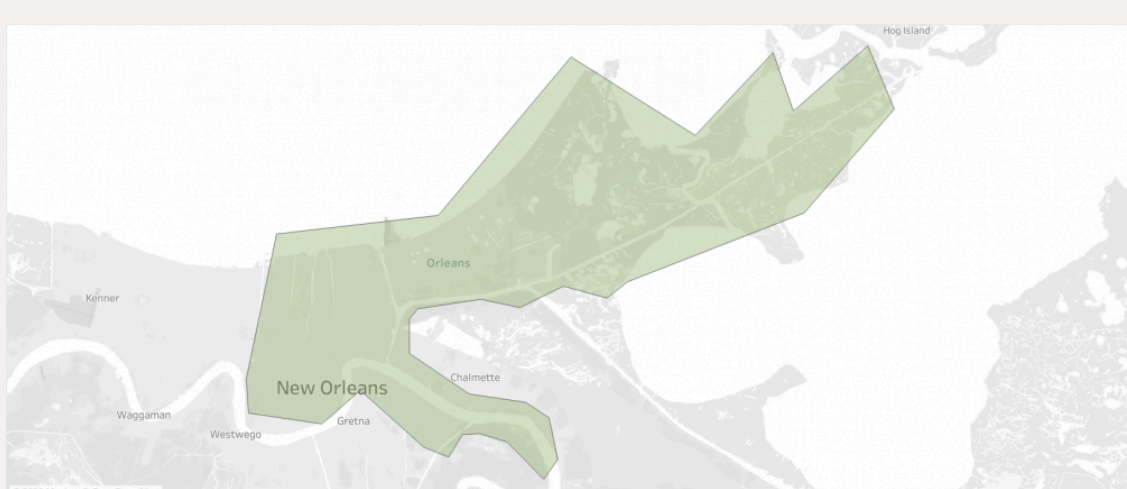

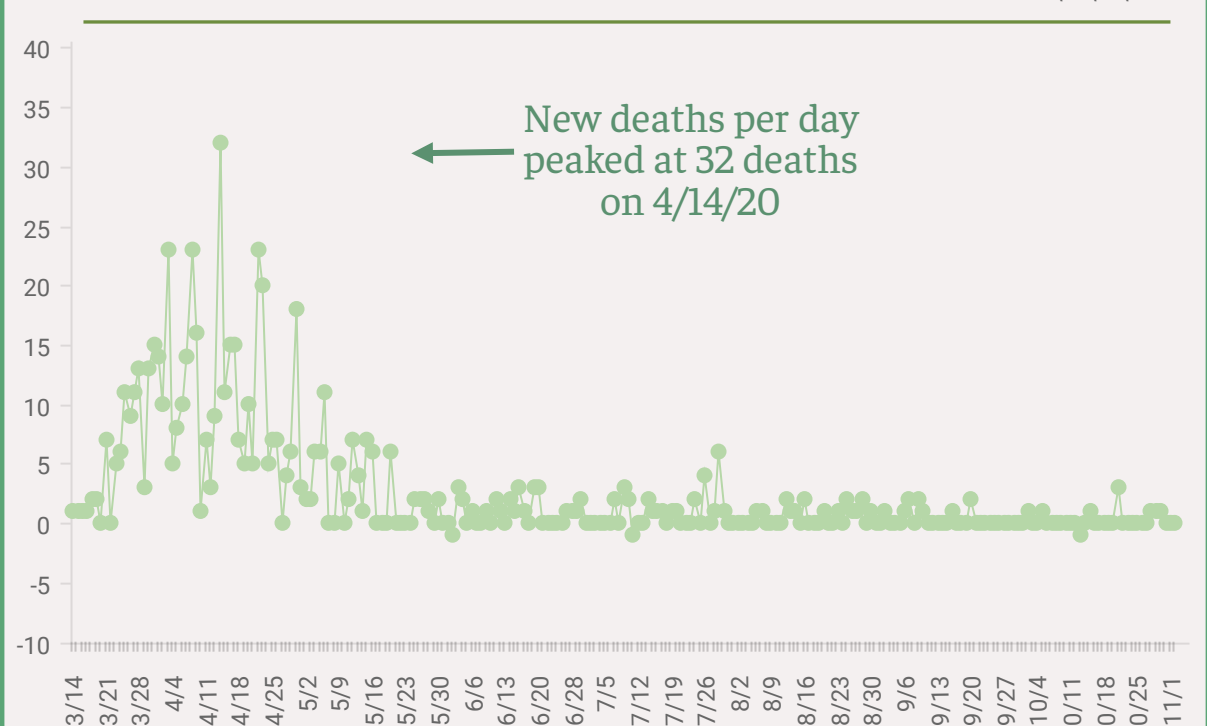

Orleans Parish ranks # 1 in deaths and #3 in cases statewide

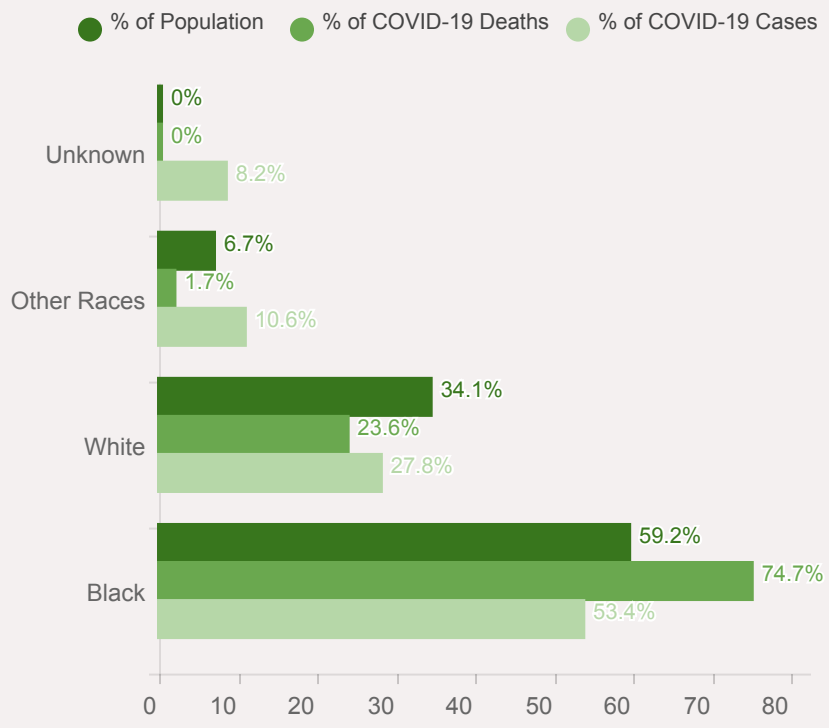


COVID-19 risk is not equal for all people in New Orleans

18 neighborhood areas (census tracts) have more than 150 cases
 8 are in New Orleans East



A Black person in New Orleans is
1.1 TIMES
 more likely to test positive for COVID-19 than a White person and
1.8 TIMES
 more likely to die from COVID-19 than a White person



The New Orleans Metropolitan Area is home to

79 industrial facilities that release

45.3 million pounds of toxic pollution each year
