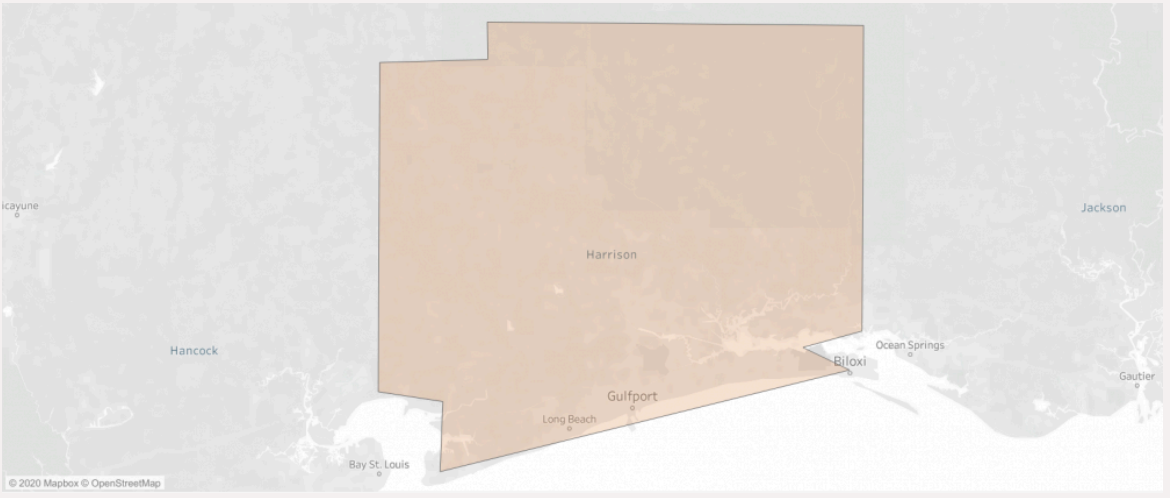

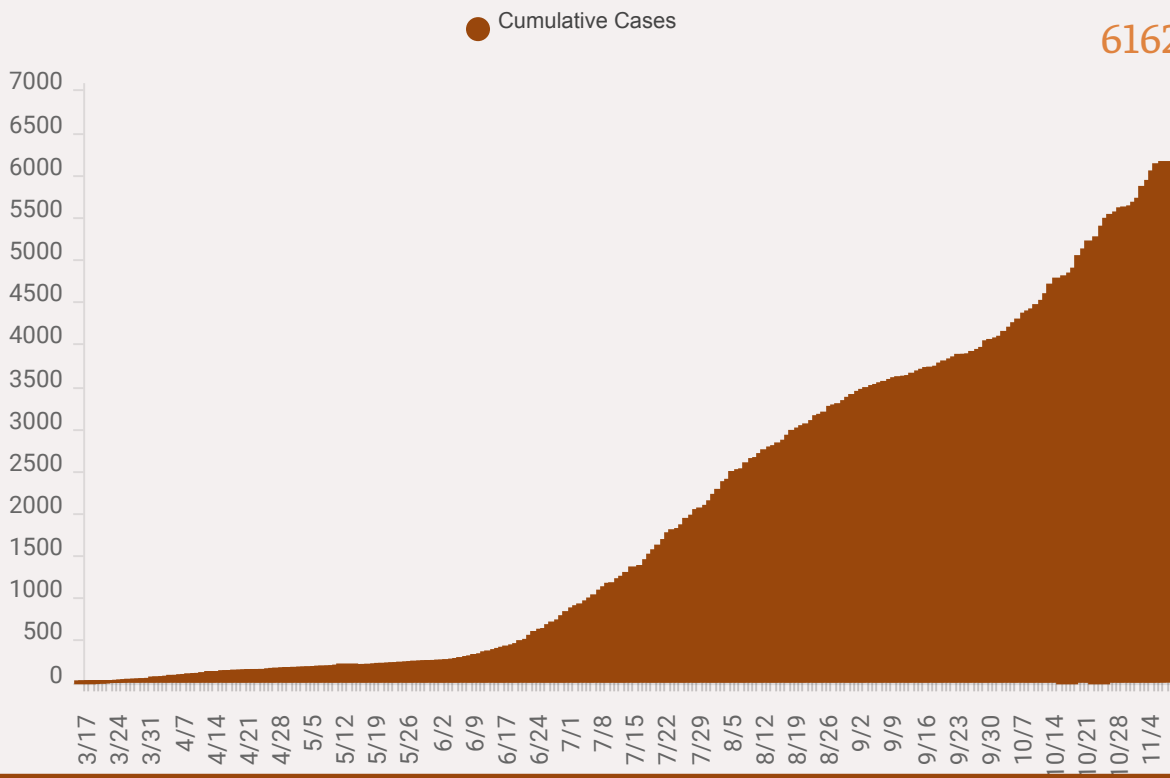
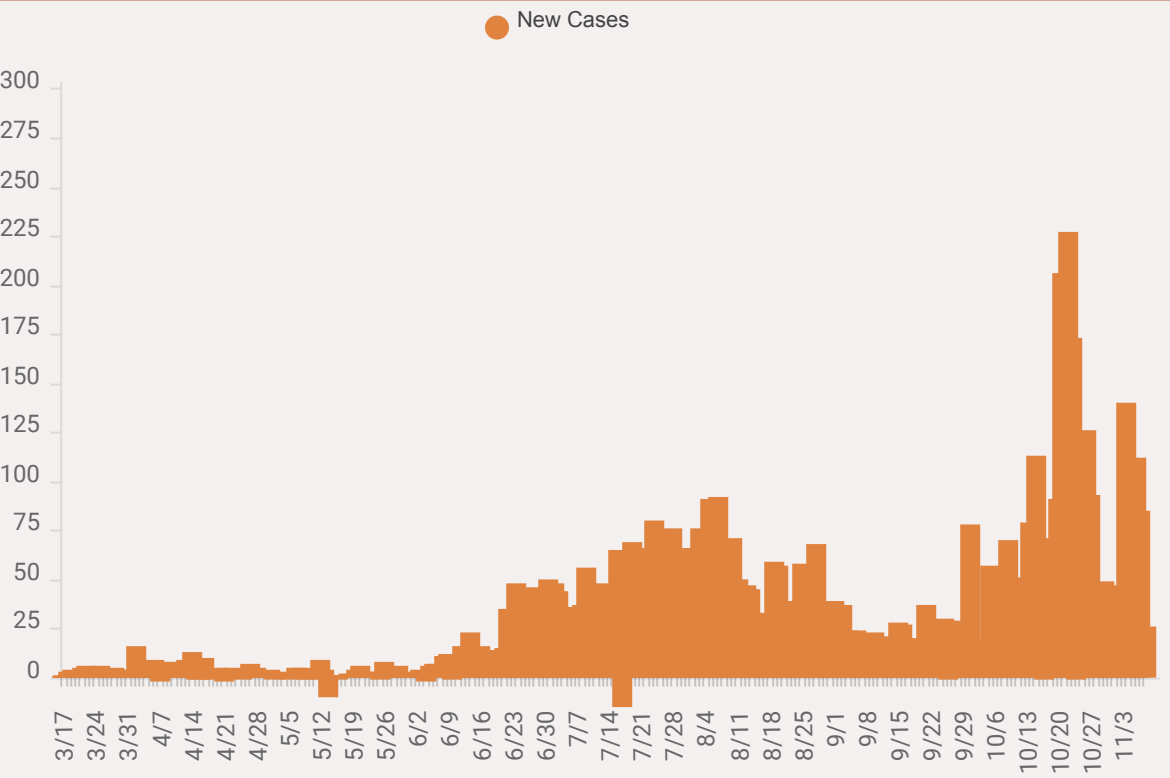

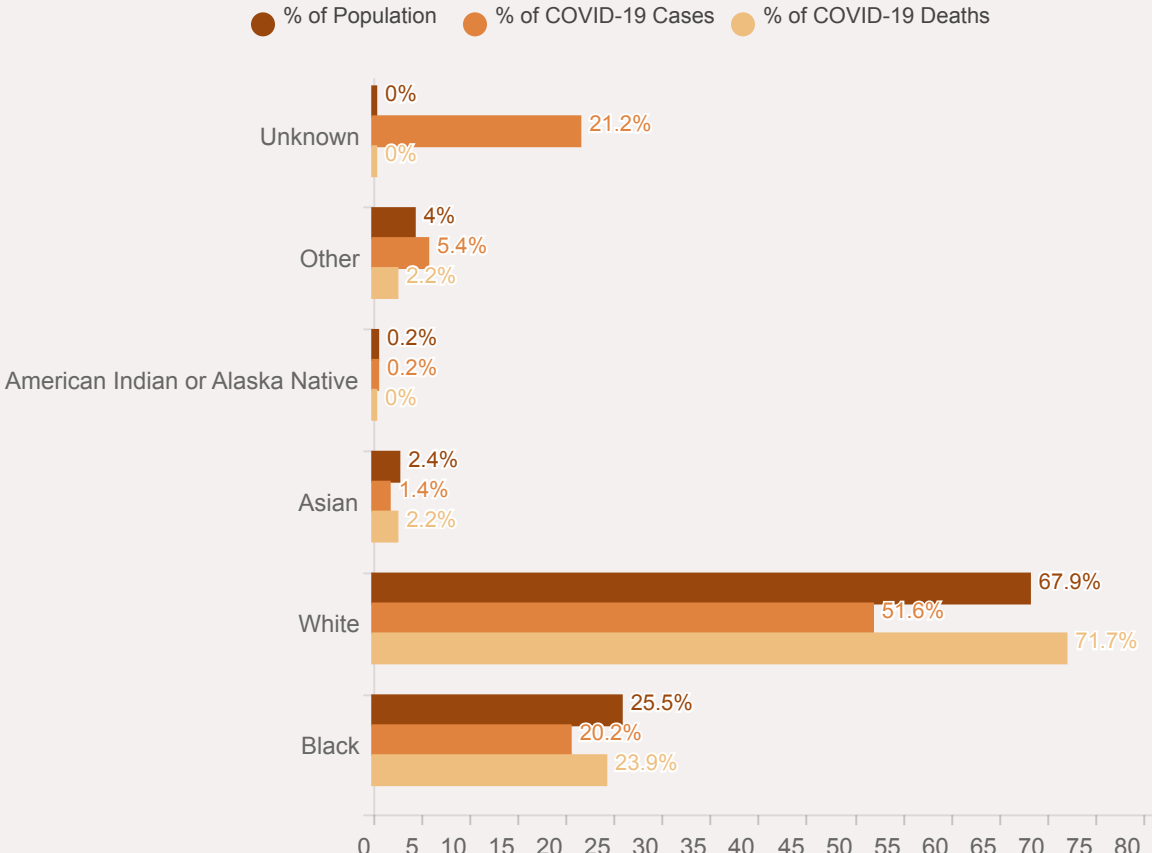
Harrison County ranks #7 in deaths and #3 in cases statewide
