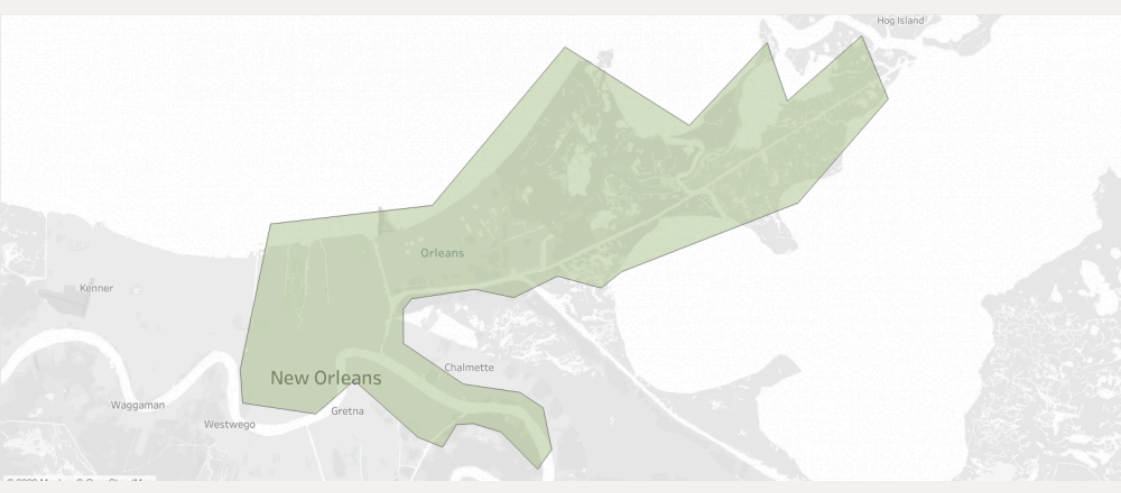


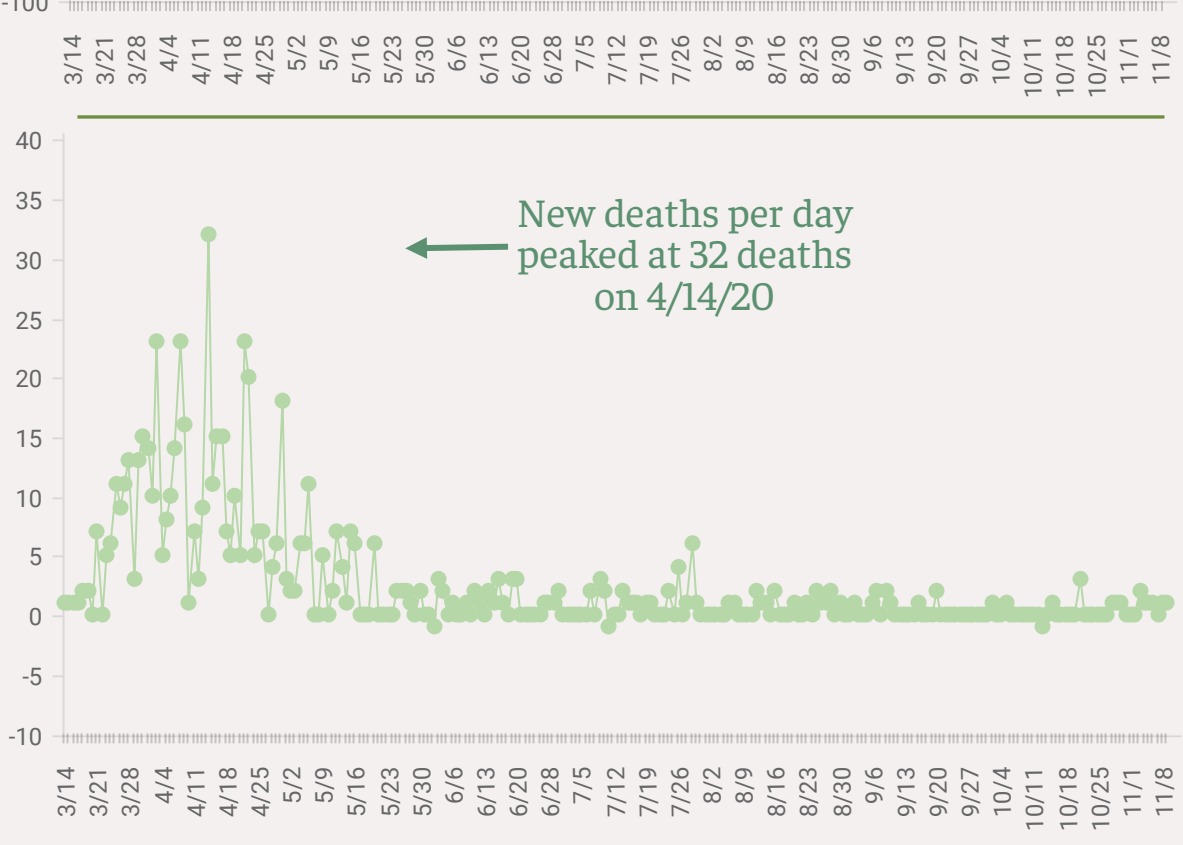

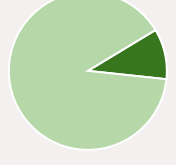

Orleans Parish ranks # 1 in deaths and #3 in cases statewide

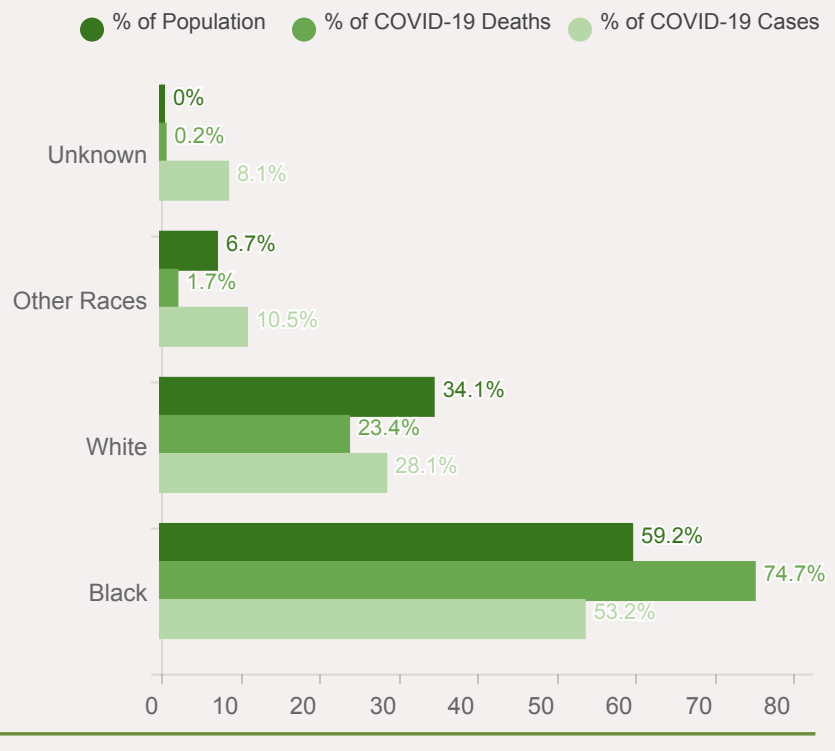


## COVID-19 risk is not equal for all people in New Orleans

19 neighborhood areas (census tracts) have more than 150 cases  
 9 are in New Orleans East



A Black person in New Orleans is  
**1.1 TIMES**  
 more likely to test positive for COVID-19 than a White person and  
**1.8 TIMES**  
 more likely to die from COVID-19 than a White person



The New Orleans Metropolitan Area is home to

**79** industrial facilities that release

**45.3** million pounds of toxic pollution each year

Exposure to air pollution is linked to increased risk of death from COVID-19
