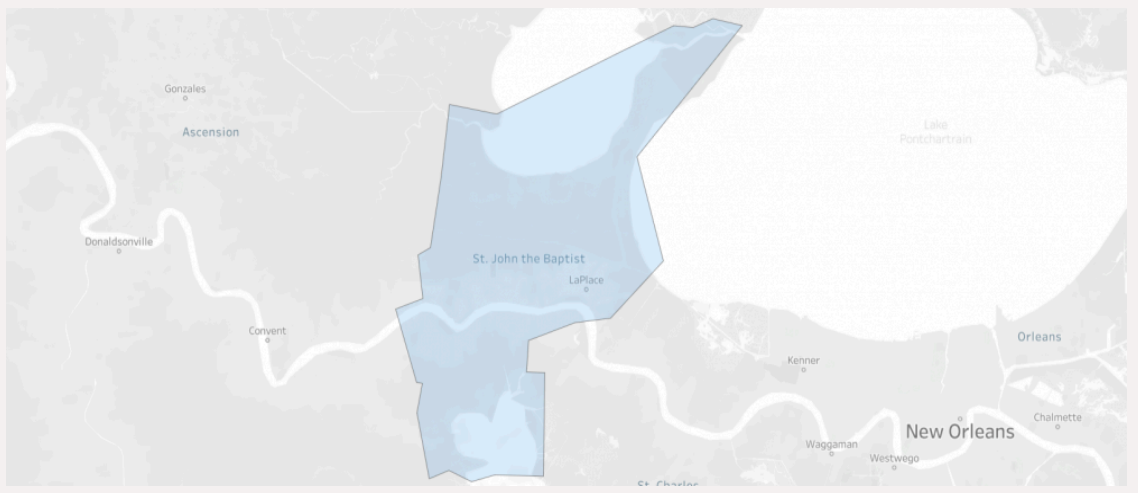

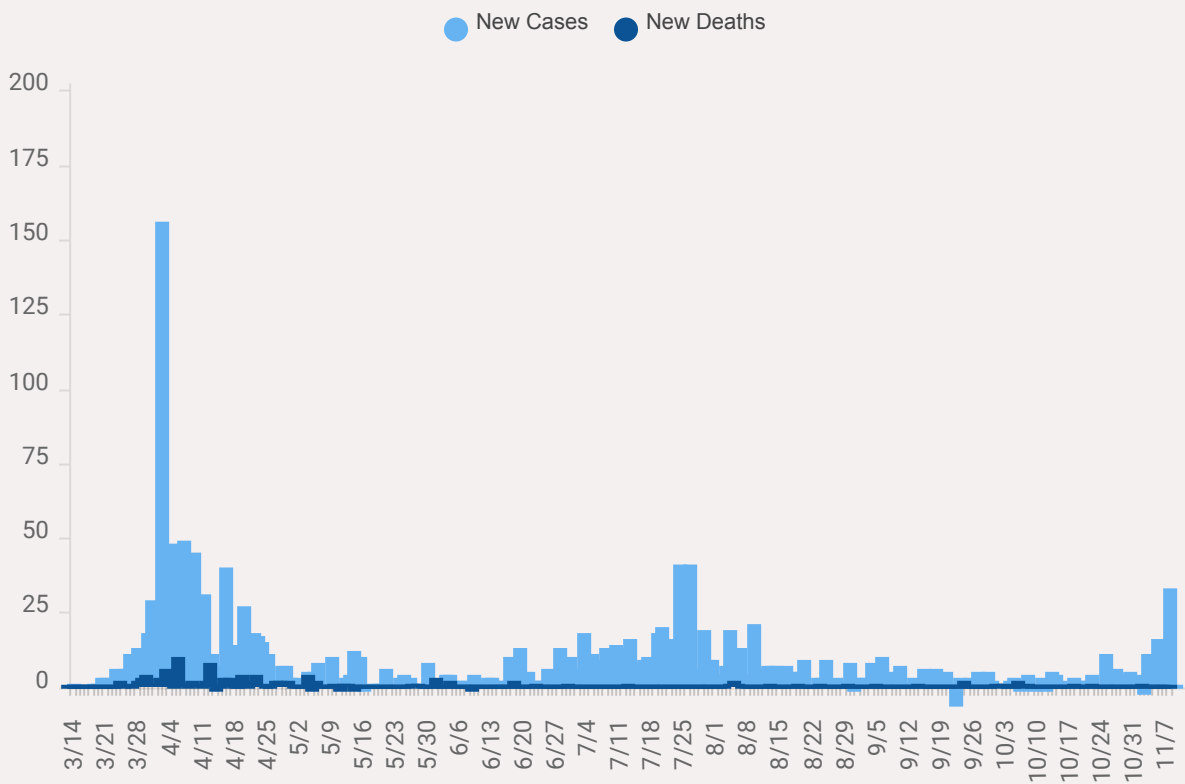

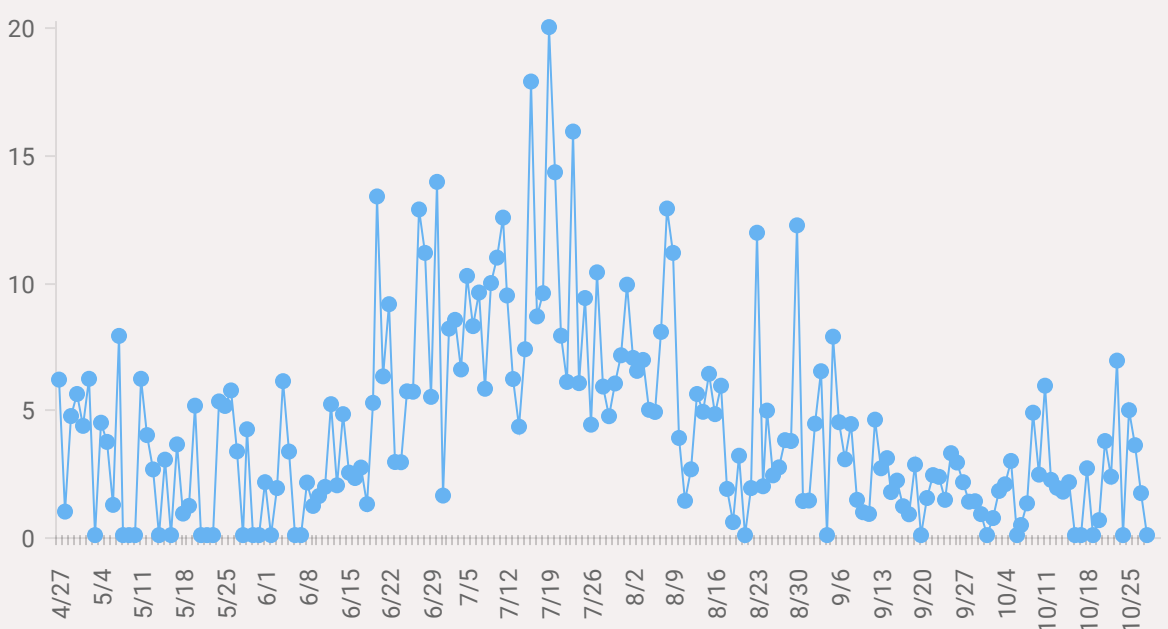
St. John the Baptist Parish ranks #16 in deaths and #25 in cases statewide

This graph depicts the percentage of positive tests returned each day

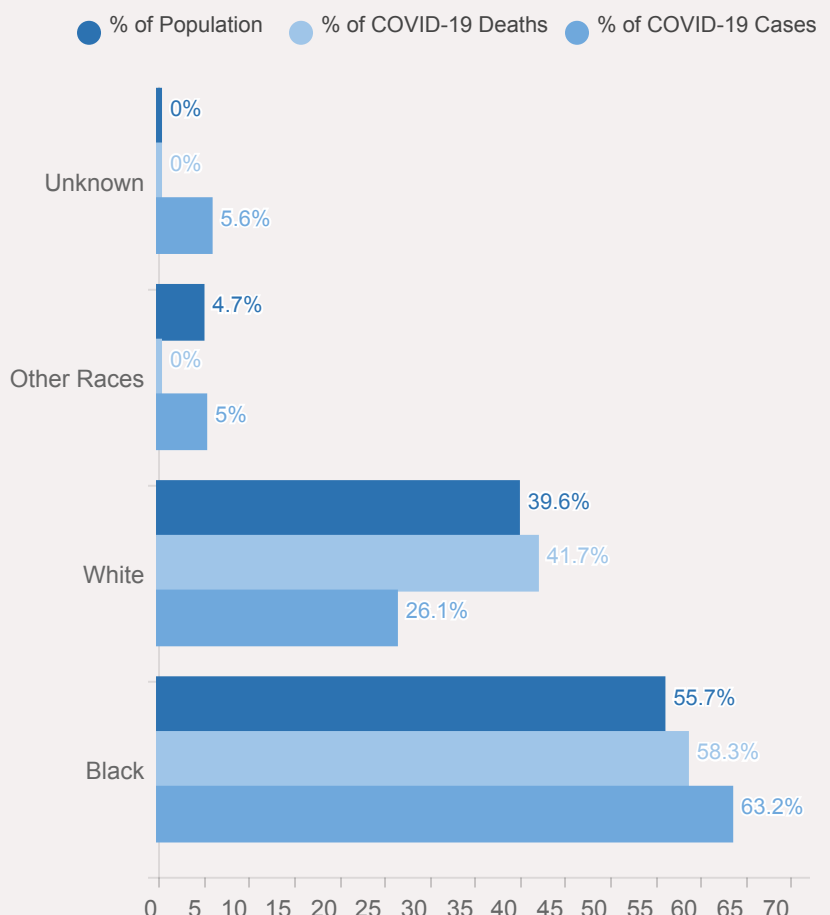


COVID-19 risk is not equal for all people in St. John the Baptist Parish
