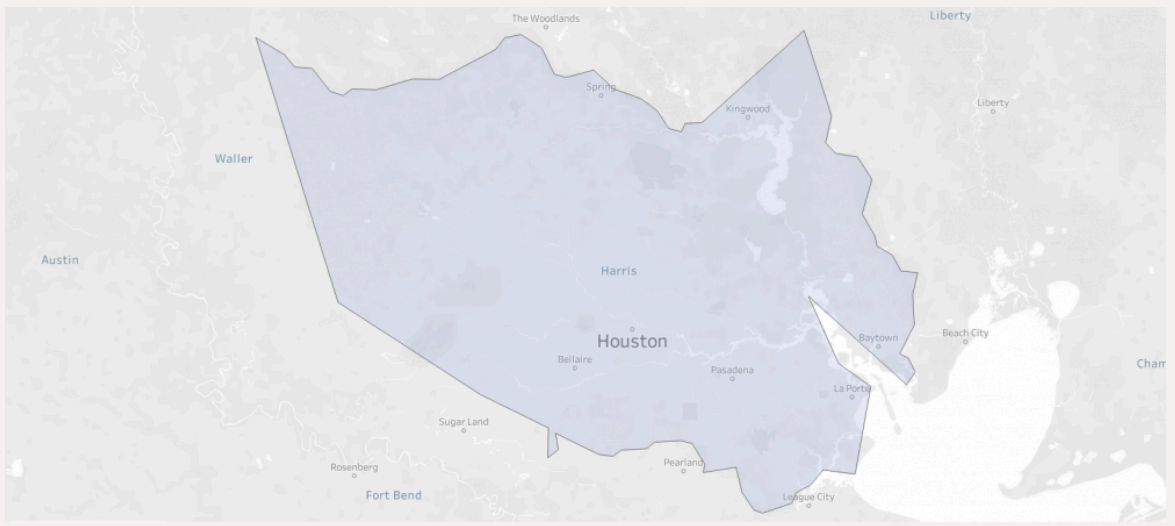

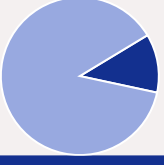

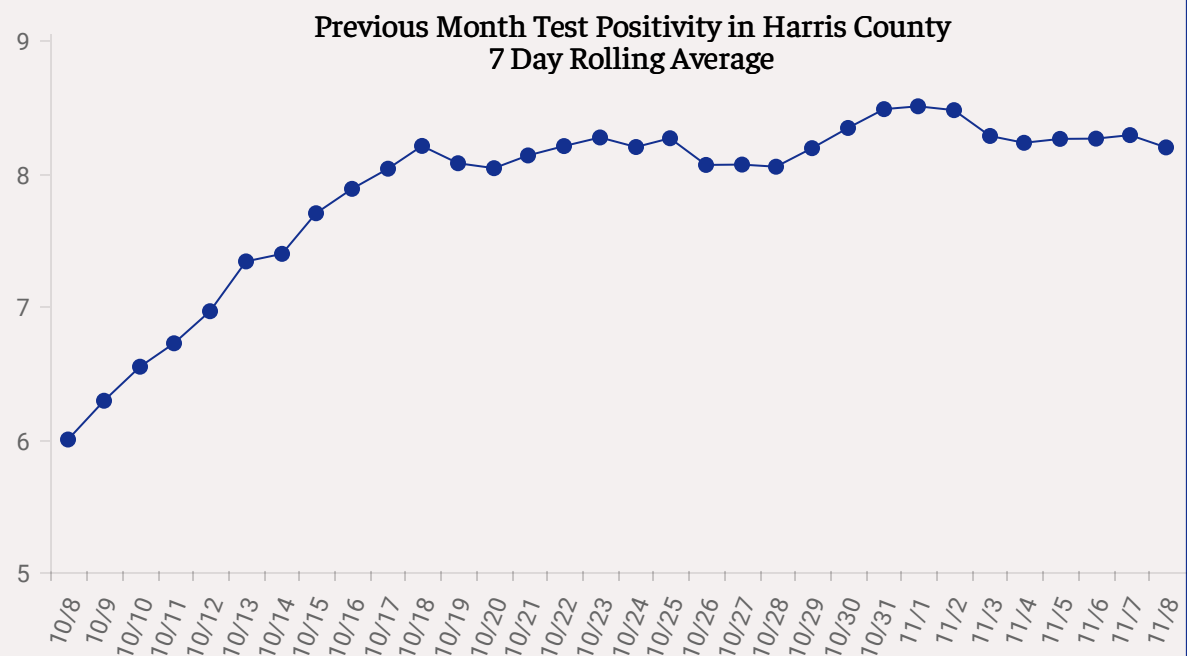
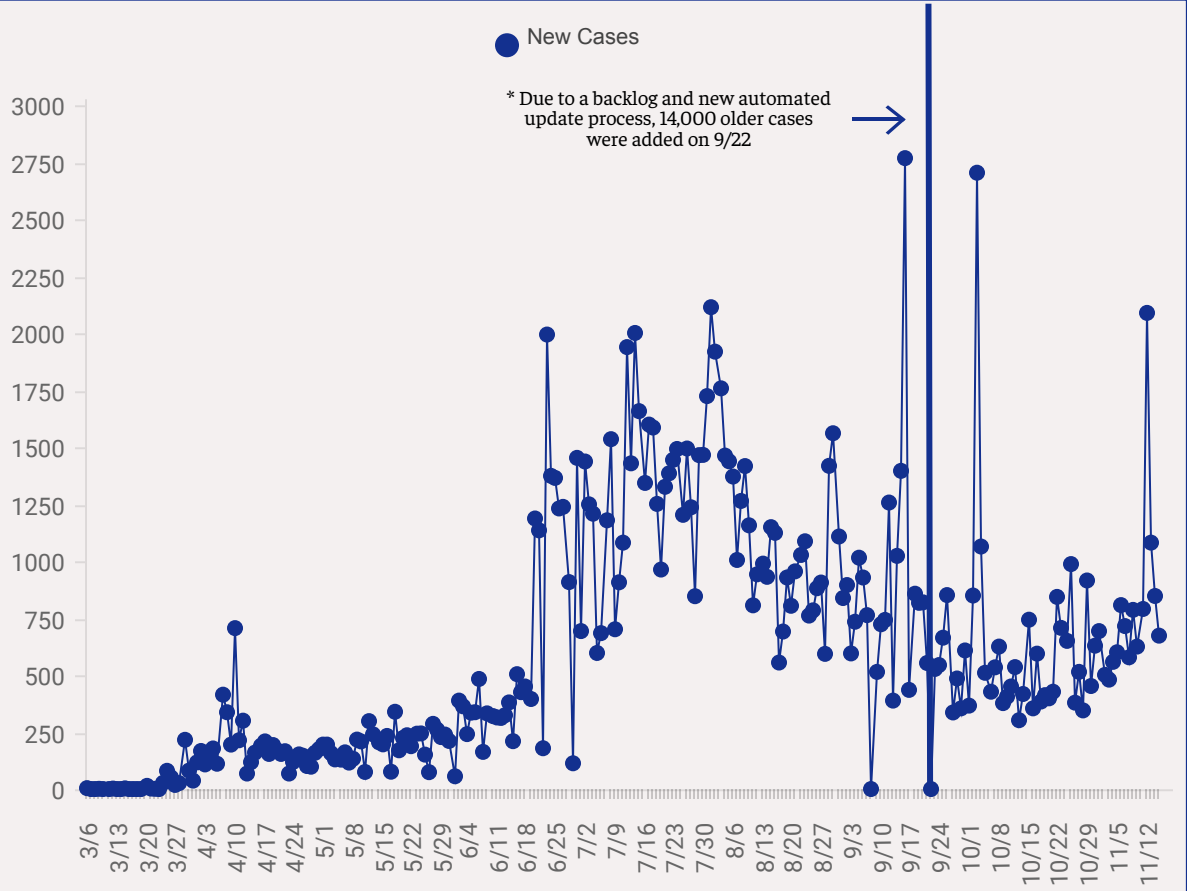
Harris County ranks #1 in deaths and #1 in cases statewide

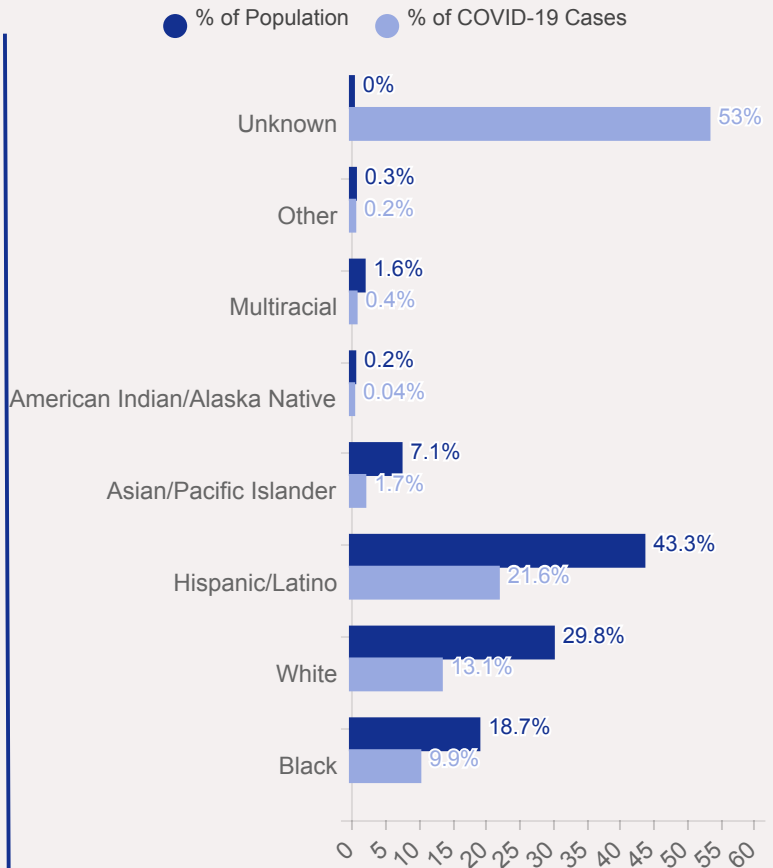


## COVID-19 risk is not equal for all people in Harris County

A non-Hispanic Black person in Harris County is

**1.2 TIMES**

more likely to test positive for COVID-19 than a non-Hispanic White person
