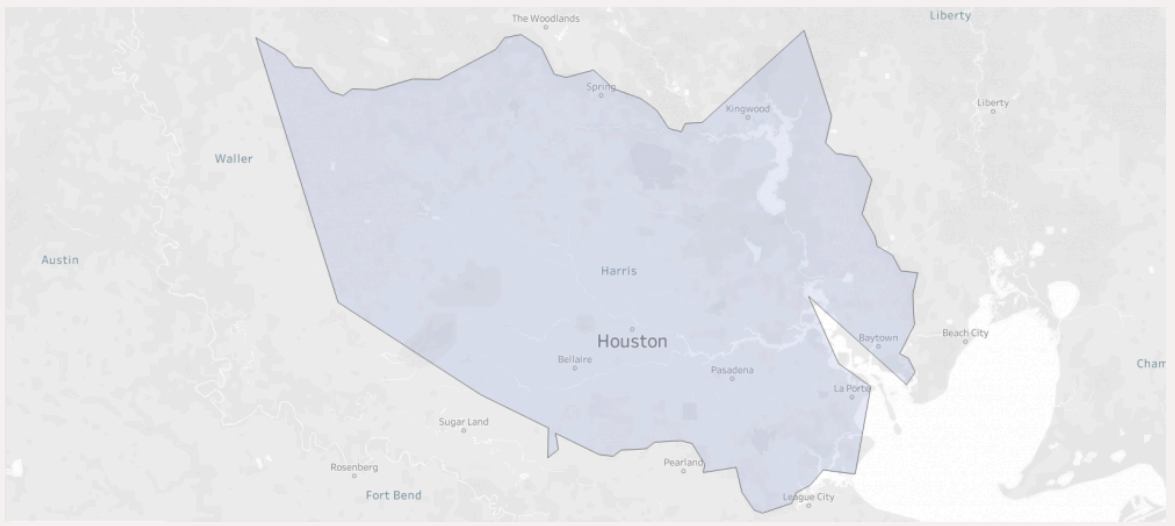

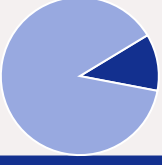

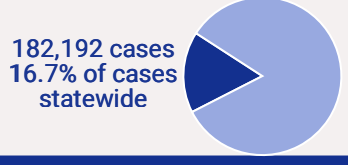

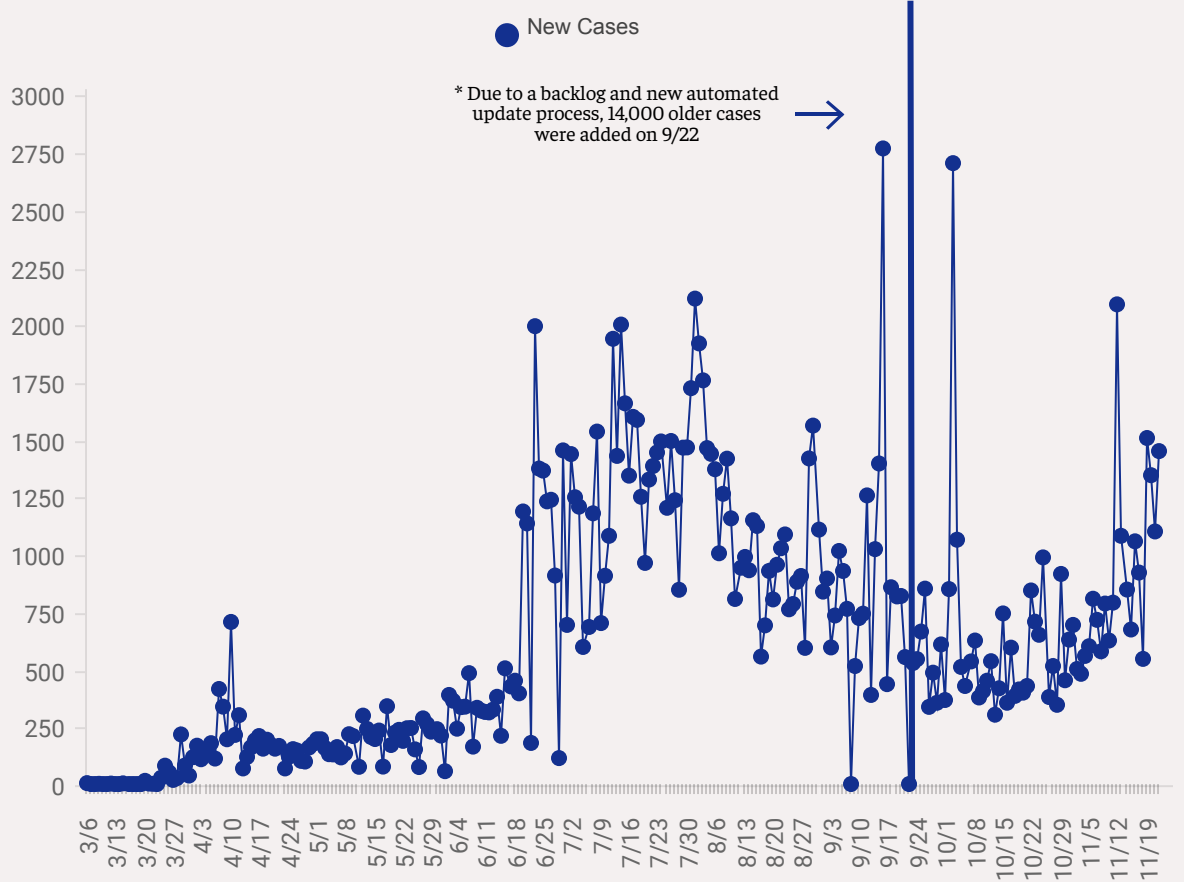

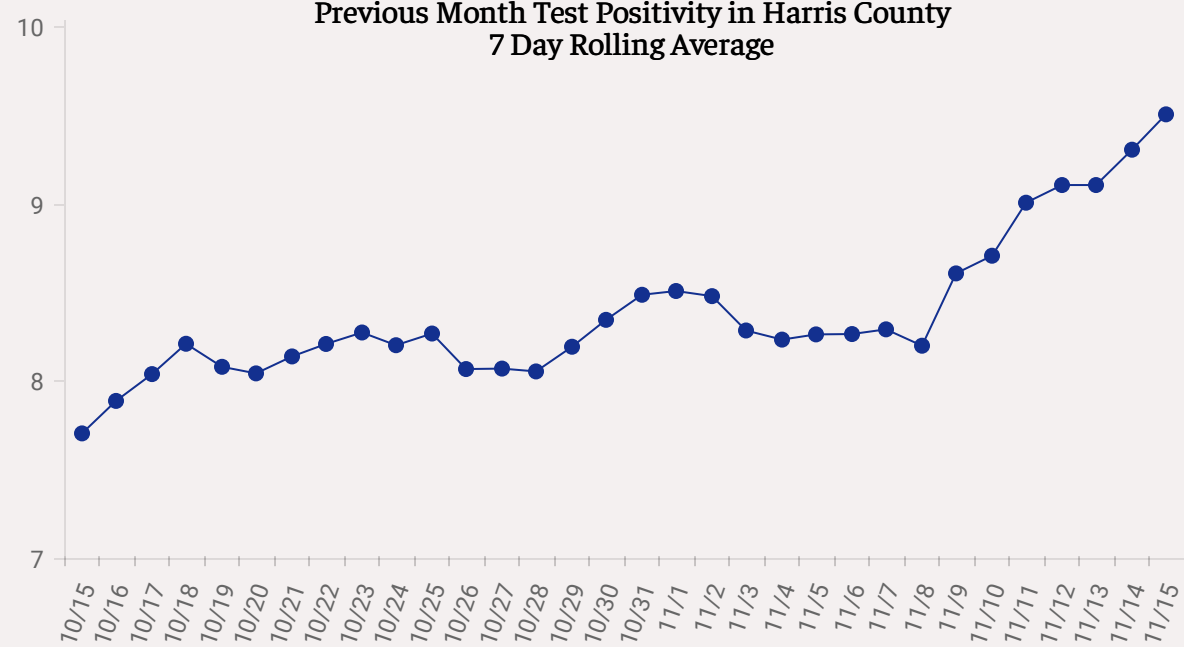

7 Day Rolling Average

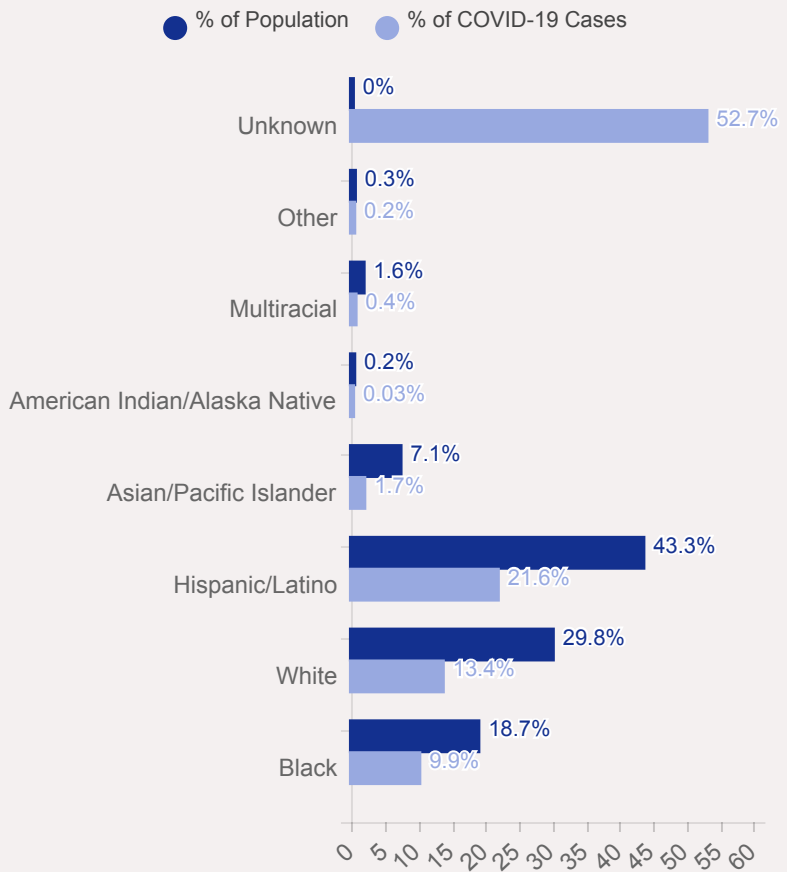


COVID-19 risk is not equal for all people in Harris County

A non-Hispanic Black person in Harris County is

1.1 TIMES

more likely to test positive for COVID-19 than a non-Hispanic White person
