Orleans Parish ranks # 1 in deaths and #3 in cases statewide

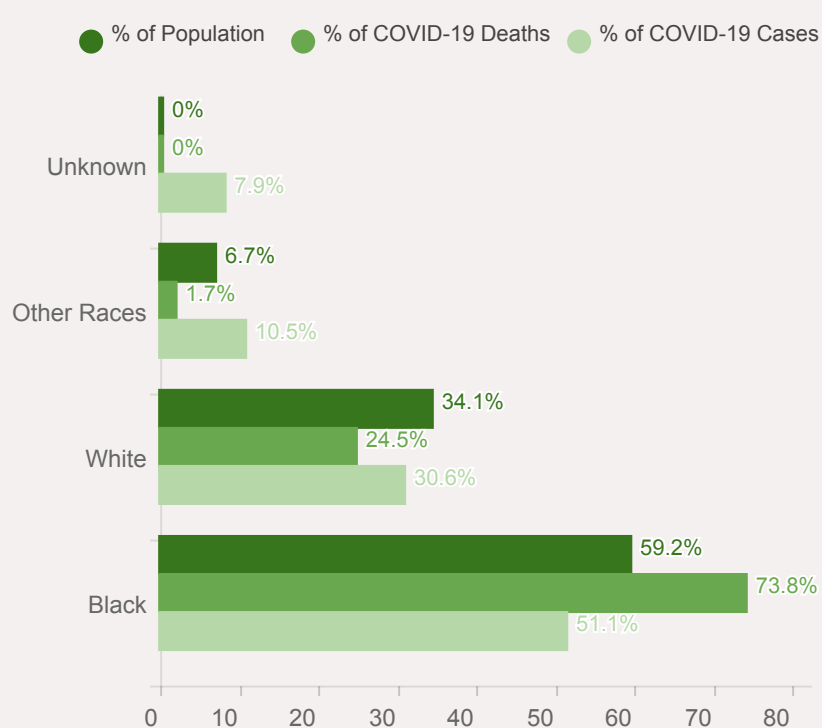


## COVID-19 risk is not equal for all people in New Orleans

13 neighborhood areas (census tracts) have more than 200 cases  
 7 are in New Orleans East



A Black person in New Orleans is  
**1.7 TIMES**  
 more likely to die from COVID-19 than a White person



The New Orleans Metropolitan Area is home to

79 industrial facilities that release
