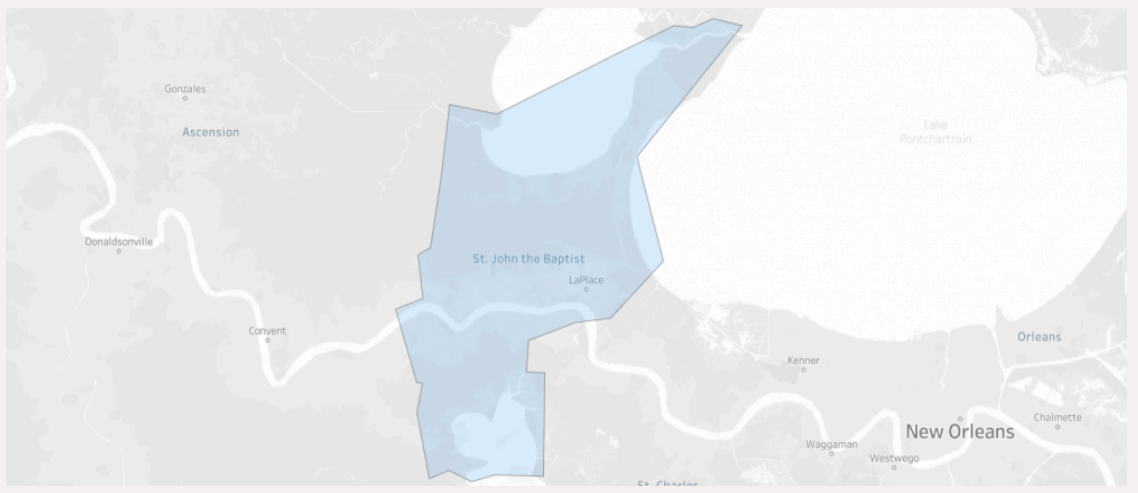

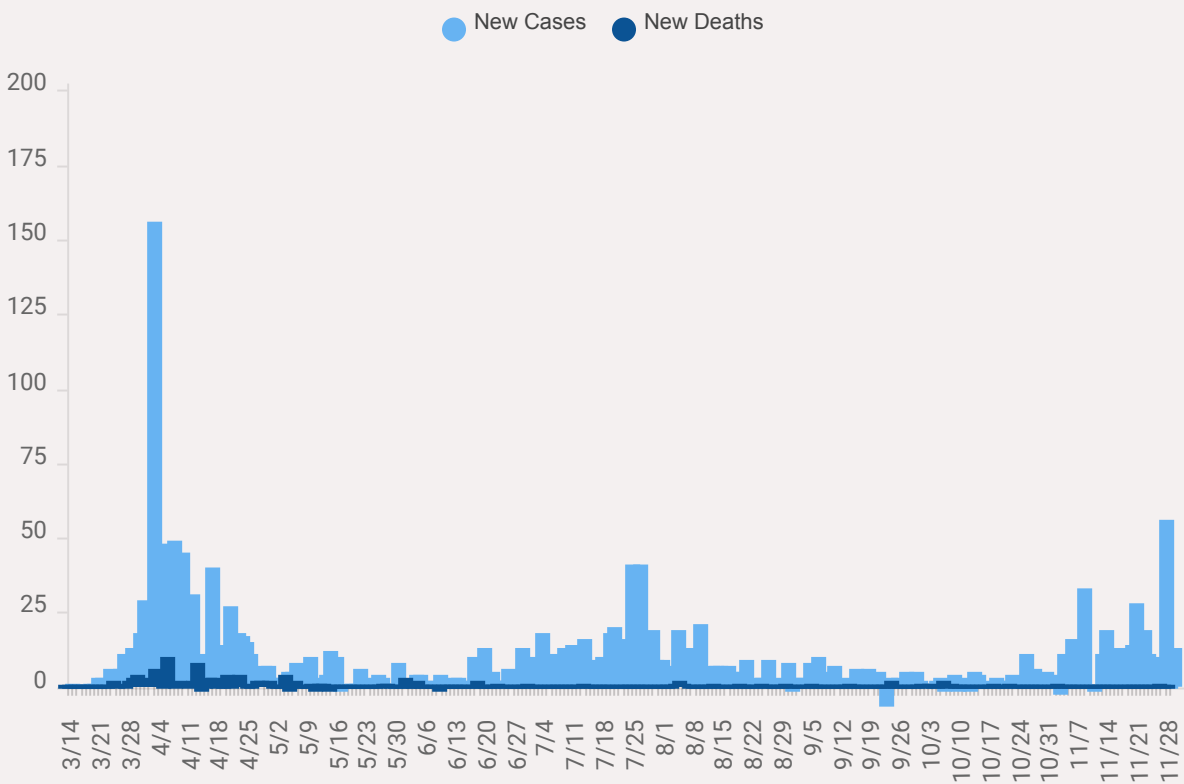

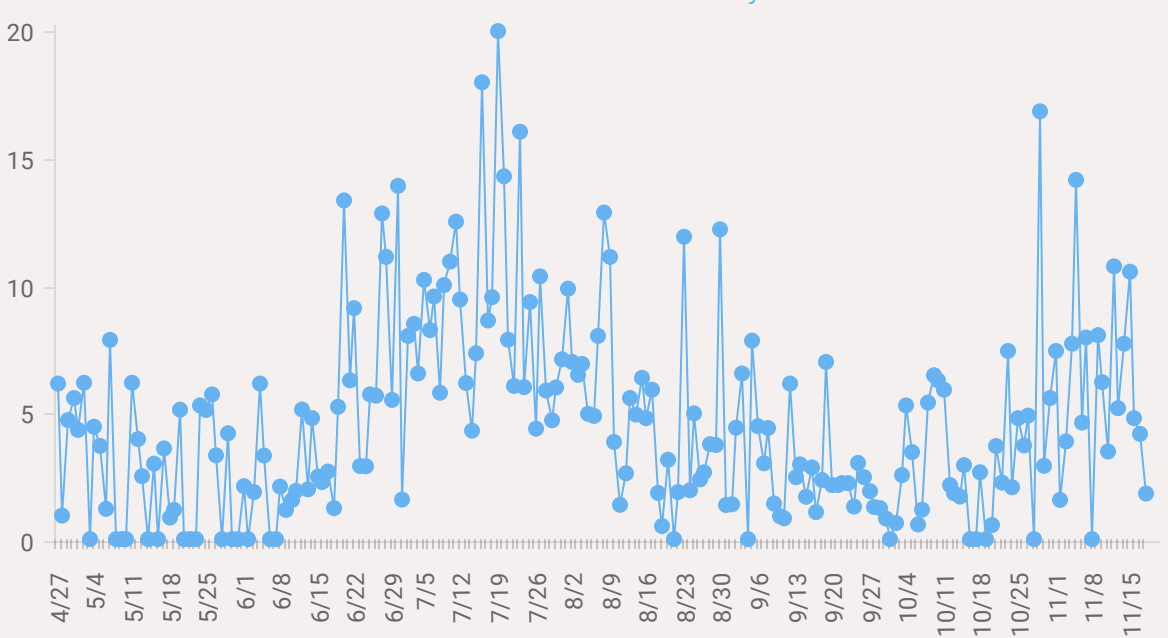
St. John the Baptist Parish ranks #16 in deaths and #28 in cases statewide

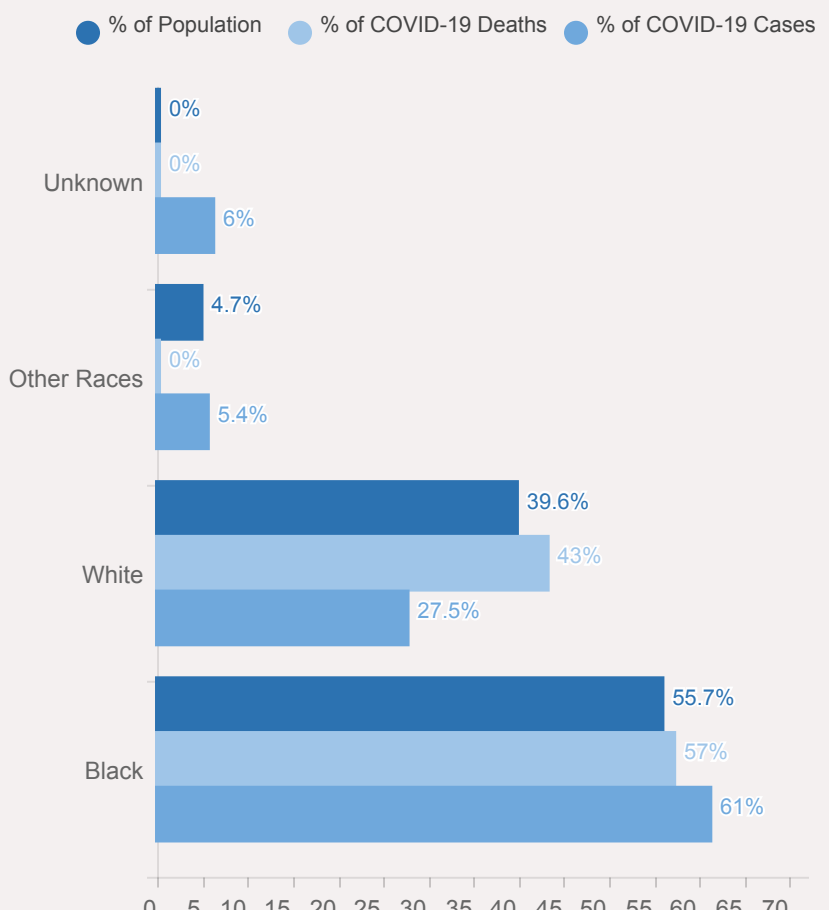


This graph depicts the percentage of positive tests returned each day
