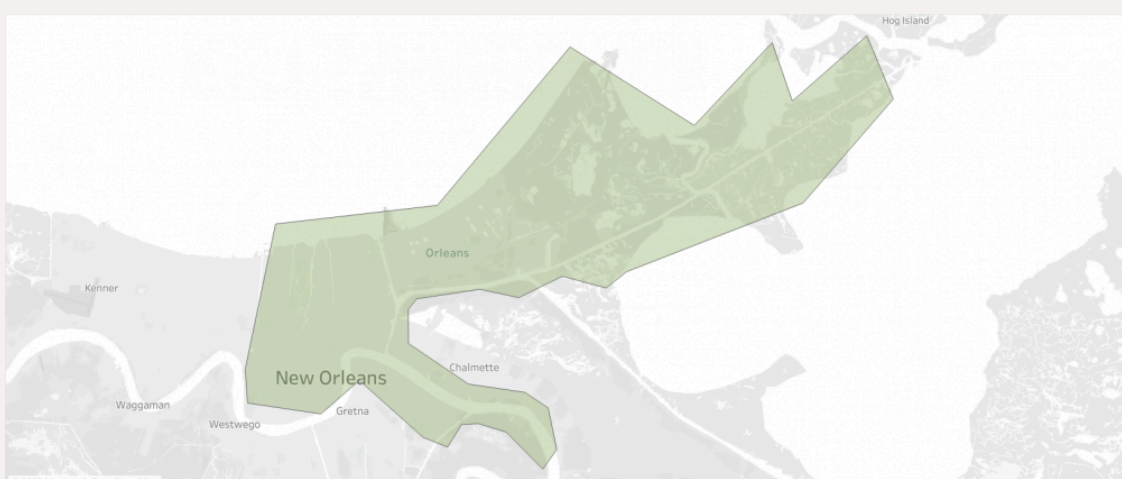

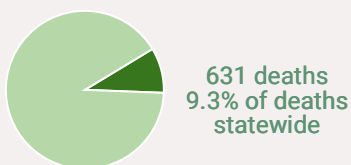

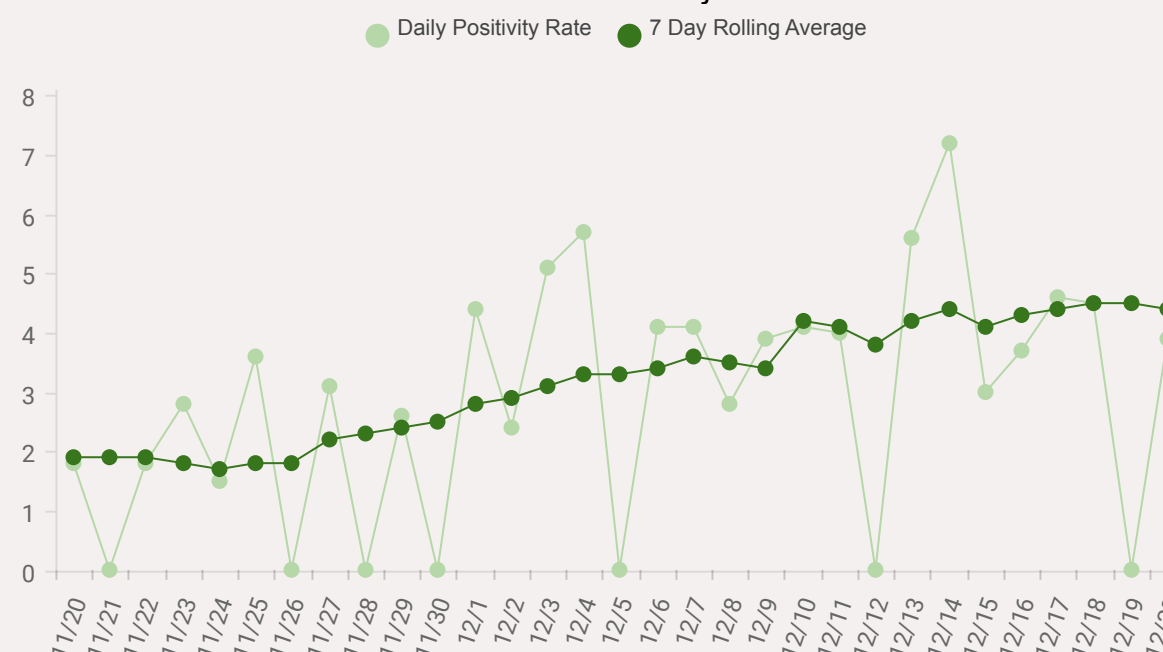

COVID-19 risk is not equal for all people in New Orleans

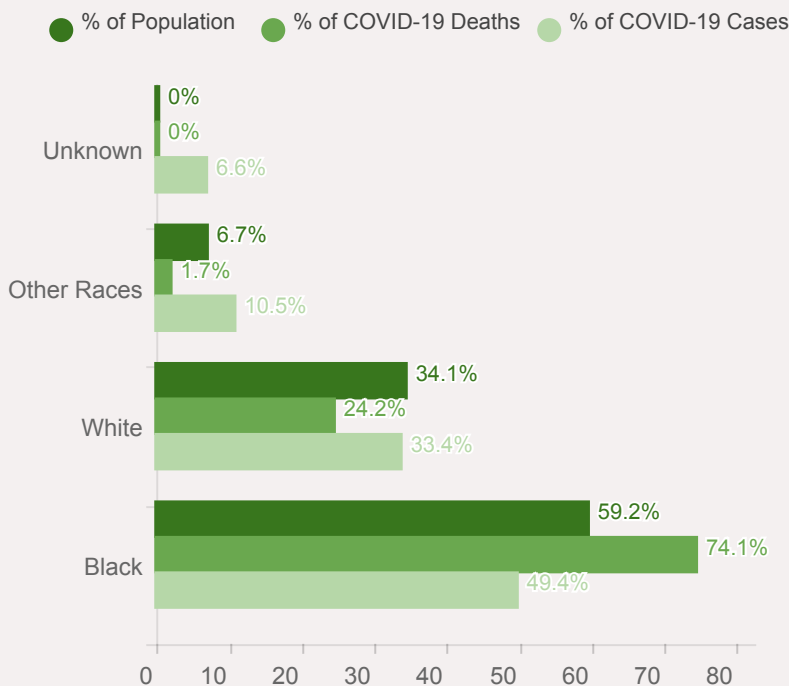
8 neighborhood areas (census tracts) have more than 300 cases
