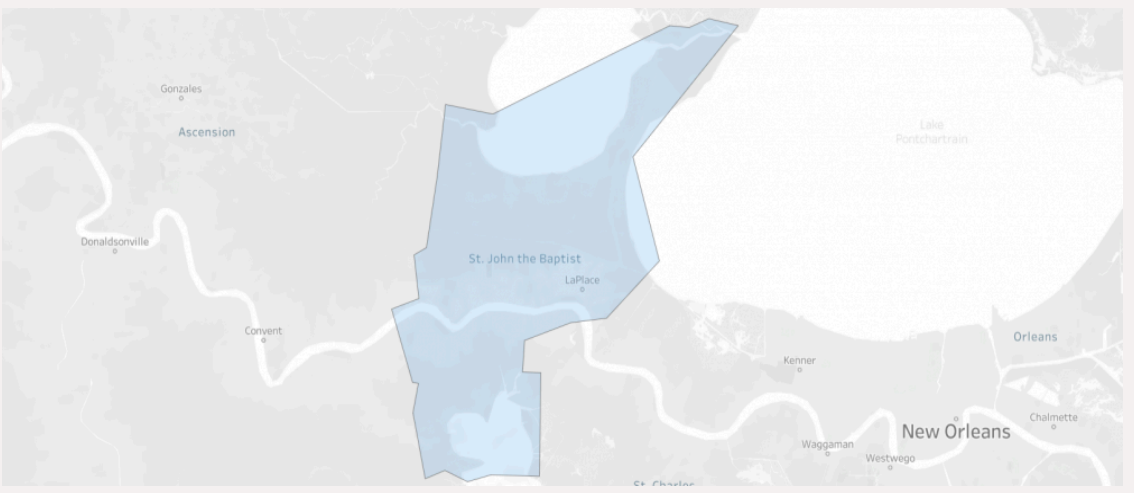

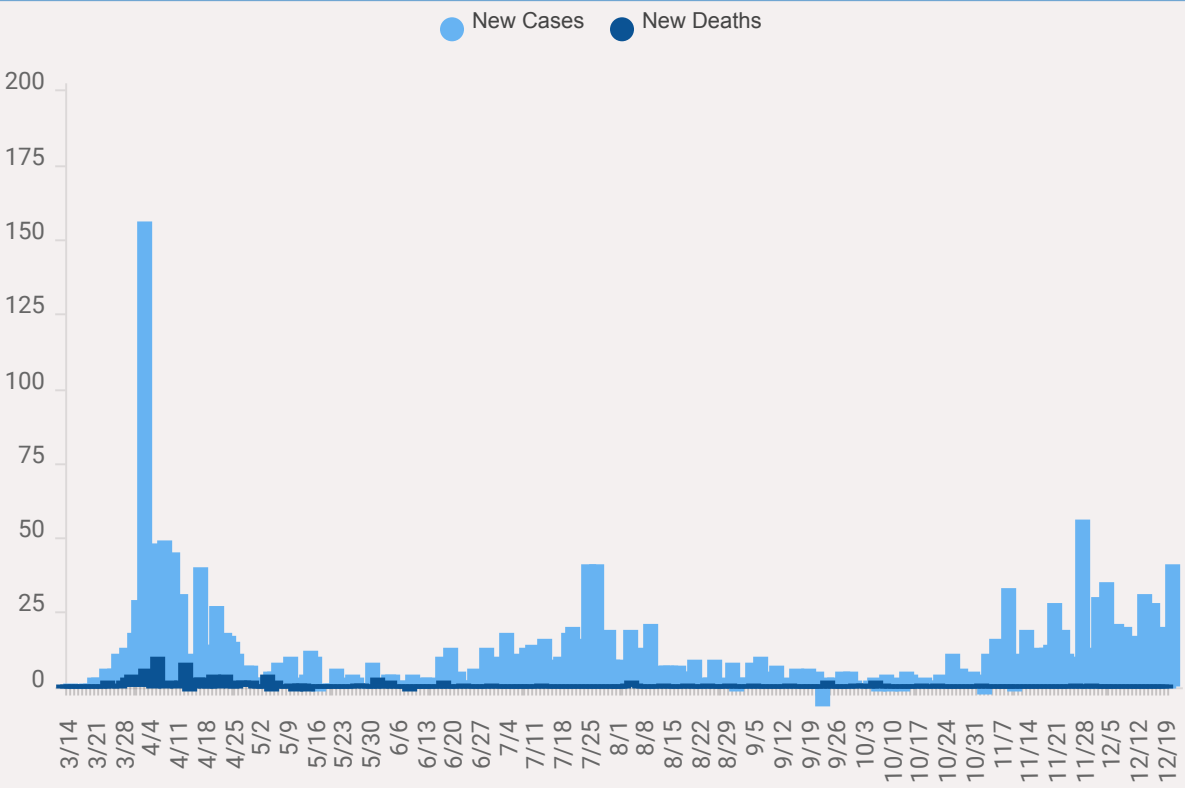

St. John the Baptist Parish ranks #17 in deaths and #25 in cases statewide

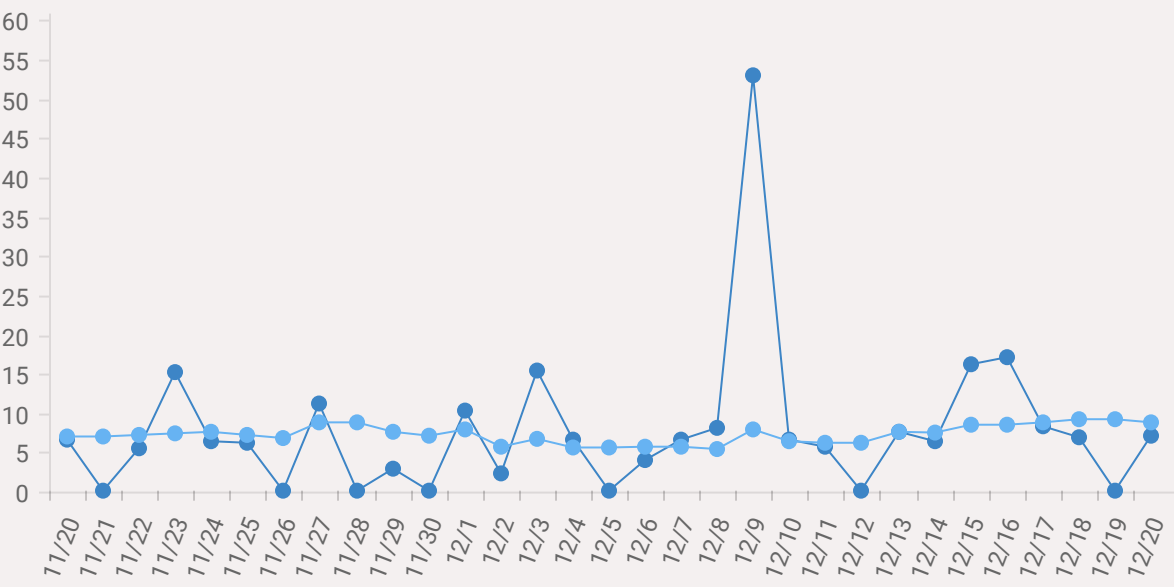

● Daily Positivity Rate ● 7 Day Rolling Average

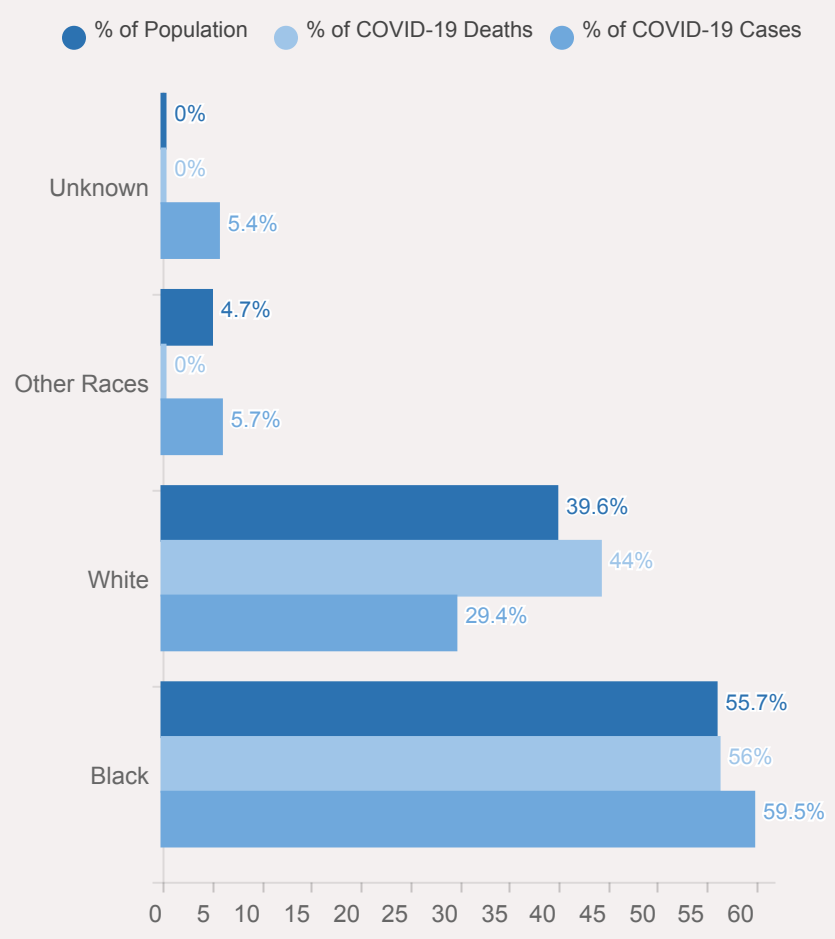


COVID-19 risk is not equal for all people in St. John the Baptist Parish
