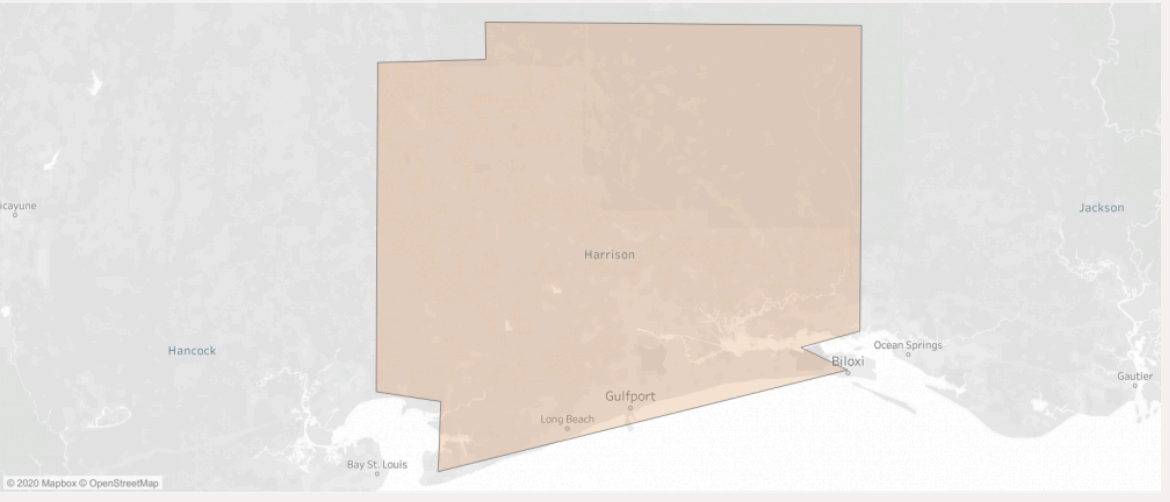

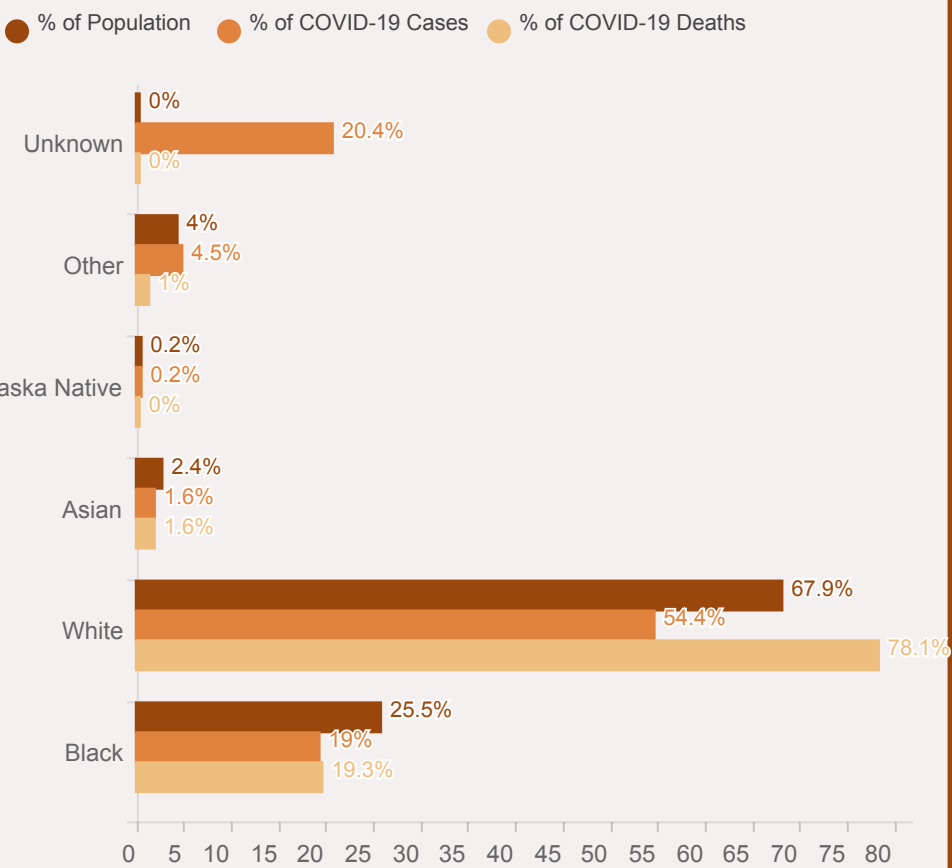
Harrison County ranks #3 in deaths and #3 in cases statewide
