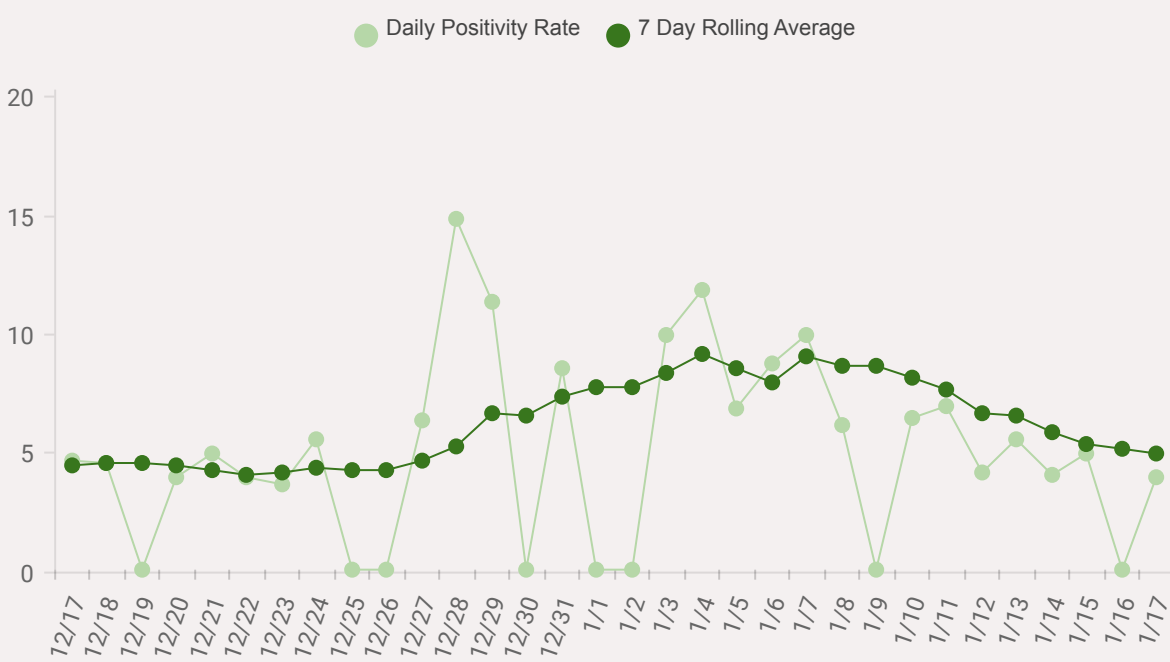

Previous Month Test Positivity in Orleans Parish

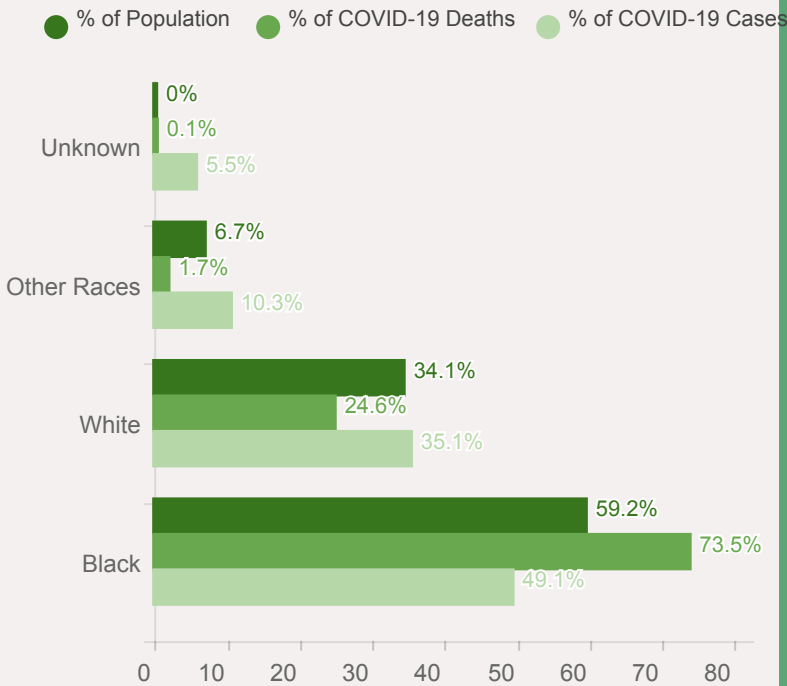


## COVID-19 risk is not equal for all people in New Orleans
