## STRONG START IN HIGH SCHOOL...



English I credit can be earned during eighth grade year. After successfully scoring a basic or above on both Eng. I LEAP 2025 and 8th grade LEAP 2025, students will begin high school with taking English II! This course will allow students an opportunity to take advanced electives or college courses during their Junior and Senior year as well as the possibility of getting out of school early and or graduating early.

## ENGLISH STANDARDS SPIRAL EACH YEAR...

Students will master much of the same general skill work as presented in 8th grade. The difference lies in the depth in which those skills are applied as well as the complexity in the text. Because of this, English I teachers will continually remediate throughout the year as we tackle English I texts. This will be done using strategic supports throughout our lessons.
