NetLink User Authentication Elements

NetLink was designed to provide strong controls including 3 key pieces of information

- ◆ User Name
- ◆ User Password
- ◆ 10 digit Passcode (consisting of user's 4 digit personal PIN followed by the 6 digit RSA code)

What is Next Token Code??

If you have to be unlocked by an admin you may trigger "Next Token Code" mode. You will be required to put in your User ID, Password, 10 digit Passcode. When prompted to enter "Next Token Code", user must wait for the token number to refresh to a new set of numbers, then enter those new 6 digits WITHOUT your PIN.

Creating Strong Passwords

We spoke to Jason Hebert, our Chief Information Officer, to share his #1 tip for creating strong passwords.

"Password length is more important than complexity because a longer password is harder to decrypt if stolen. Also, a longer passphrase or sentence easily remembered by you makes it less likely that it will be written down. Multi-factor authentication should be used in conjunction with passwords as much as possible."

Reminders

- ◆ NetLink is accessible from anywhere with a valid internet connection. Bring RSA token home with you in DR situations
- ◆ Dashes to the left on the RSA token represent 10 second increments
- ◆ Passwords expire after 60 days and user account will be inactive after 90 days of not logging in
