## **AKC ALL BREED CAT**

Open to all AKC Registered and Mixed Breeds (via AKC Canine Partners).

Each dog must be individually registered with the AKC.

This includes all AKC registered purebreds, Foundation Stock Service (FSS), Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL), and AKC Canine Partners Spayed or Neutered dogs, or dogs with breed disqualifications may be entered. If **not AKC registered**, you can register your Canine Partner with AKC at the event, and your dog can participate in the tests that very same day.

## **EVENT DAY PROCEDURES**

Each dog will be inspected by the Inspection Committee for lameness, fitness to compete, and females in season. All dogs to be inspected must be presented without tape, bandages, or wrapping/coverings of any kind (coats, blankets, etc.). If, in the opinion of the inspection committee, a dog is found to be lame, unfit to compete, or in season, the dog will not be allowed to test, and the applicable entry fees will be refunded.

All entrants will assemble in a designated location. At this time, test procedures will be explained, and any questions answered.

Dogs will be brought to the start line on leash and released only upon a verbal signal ("Tally-Ho!") from the Huntmaster. Dogs may be released by hand, folded leash, or using a traditional lure coursing slip lead.

Dogs may run with or without a collar for safety reasons. Unacceptable collars are choker collar, prong collar, Martingale collar, or electronic collar. Tags, bandanas, or other similar items are not allowed for safety reasons. Owners may use clips or rubber bands to hold the dog's hair. The owner assumes responsibility for the safety of the dog regarding the dog's collar and paraphernalia on the dog. Electronic training collars or pinch/prong collars are NOT allowed on AKC test grounds

## **CAT/CABT**

**COURSE DESIGN.** The course shall be designed with safety for non-sighthound breeds as a primary consideration. There shall be no turns more acute than 90 degrees. The total length of the course shall be no less than 600 yards and should be as close to 600 yards as is possible. The lure will consist of plastic strips. Depending on the size and type of dog, the dog will run either the full course or a 300-yard course. The 300-yard distance shall be clearly marked. Safety is of utmost importance.

The judge is responsible for walking the course prior to the start of the event to look for hazards.

**DISTANCE AND MAXIMUM TIME.** Dogs run singularly in Coursing Ability Test events. Veteran dogs may run two-thirds of the normal distance at the owner's discretion. Veteran dogs are defined for this test as dogs older than 7 years of age. A veteran dog's owner must declare prior to the start which distance the dog will run.

**300 Yard Course** This distance is for dogs shorter than 12 inches at the withers and/or brachycephalic ("flat-faced") dogs. A veteran dog may run 200 yards at the owner's discretion. A dog must complete this course in less than 1 1/2 minutes.

**600 Yard Course** This distance is used for all dogs that do not run the 300-yard Course. A veteran dog may run 400 yards at the owner's discretion. A dog must complete this course in less than 2 minutes. If there is a question whether a dog should run the 300 or 600-yard course, the judge will decide.

**PASSING PERFORMANCE.** The Coursing Ability Test is a pass-fail event. To pass, the dog must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption within the maximum amount of time for the course length. A dog is considered to have failed the test if it relieves while on course. The time ends when the dog completes the required course. The judge keeps the official time and decides the merits of the dog's performance.

**TITLING:** Coursing Ability (CA) – Awarded to a dog that passes the Coursing Ability Test three times under at least two different judges.  
Coursing Ability Advanced (CAA) – Dog passes the Coursing Ability Test a total of ten times. (CA+7 additional passes)  
Coursing Ability Excellent (CAX) – Dog passes the Coursing Ability Test a total of 25 times.  
Coursing Ability Excellent 2 (CAX2) – Dog passes the Coursing Ability Test a total of 50 times.

- Open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered/listed with the AKC. This includes dogs recorded in the FSS program, dogs with PAL numbers or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. (An event number defines an event.)
- **Safety:** Safety is of utmost importance. It is the responsibility of the event committee to ensure the safety of the course, the equipment, and the conduct of those involved with the event.
- **Lure Equipment:** Battery-powered, continuous loop equipment will be used. Lures consist of white plastic bags
- For the safety of the dog and as a courtesy to other entrants, a testing dog should have a reliable recall. A penalty of \$10.00 may be assessed for any dog causing an excessive delay of the event because it cannot be recalled or retrieved from the field. Dogs that delay the event because their owners cannot recall them may be refused entry at future events.
- These events will be run concurrently. Dogs that have not yet run will have priority over dogs that will be running for the second test.
- BKC will break periodically to accommodate workers and allow for lunch.
- Event is held in rain-or-shine outdoor event. Please plan accordingly.
- Dogs should be walked prior to running to warm them up and again after their run to cool them down.
- Dogs must be on lead or crated unless running.
- Handlers should wear comfortable shoes and be physically able to hold and release their dogs, as well as catch them.

- Lure coursing is a physically demanding sport so please make sure your dog is in good shape. Dogs that are overweight and/or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. The Inspection Committee has the authority to disallow a dog's entry into a test, and in such instances, applicable entry fees will be refunded.
- Any person, upon reasonable complaint, may be asked to leave the grounds of the test by the Field Committee and may be disciplined by the AKC. Children must always be under control of their parents or guardian(s).
- Late, incomplete, unsigned, unpaid, or conditional entries, or entries not containing the "Agreement" found on the Official AKC Entry Form will not be accepted.
- Mixed breeds must be spayed or neutered to be eligible to run. AKC registered dogs with breed disqualifications may be entered.
- Run area is partially fenced.
- No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or its members and representatives.
- No refunds for pre-entry fees unless the entered dog upon inspection is lame, unfit to compete, or in season.
- A return check fee of \$40.00 will be assessed for any check(s) returned for insufficient funds.
