DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

ELIGIBILITY: This event is open to all dogs <u>fifteen (15) months</u> of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have Limited Registration, Indefinite Listing Privileges (ILP) PAL Number, Mixed Breeds that have a Canine Partner Listing number (CPL) or Approved FSS Breeds, with the exception of bitches in season, aggressive dogs, dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dogs' physical or mental performance. For a complete description of other physical disqualifications please refer to Chapter 1, Sec 3. For the listing of registerable breeds that may participate refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules.

MOVE UPS

Move-ups to a higher class for Friday, July 26, 2024, will be accepted until 6:00 p.m., Monday, July 22, 2024 via mail to Trial Secretary, or e-mail to nedrahg@cox.net. Move-ups to a higher class for Saturday, July 27 and Sunday, July 28, 2024, will be accepted at the trial site no later than 30 minutes after the completion of the Trial on forms provided. Such dogs will be entered at the end of the running order for their respective height.

A dog which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or the handler may be moved to the Novice "B" class under the following conditions: The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. The request must state the reason and justification for the move from a Novice "A" class to a Novice "B" class.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Judging Schedule and detailed confirmation will be sent to the email address on the entry form, if listed, or to the street address if no email address is noted. If the Judging Schedule has not been received by three days prior to the trial, please contact the Trial Secretary.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

• For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is now allowed in all classes effective 7/01/2024. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

• FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.

• Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.

• Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.

• The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).

Entering Fix and Go On (FNG)

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note.

Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS (continued)

Simplified Jump Height Card Process – When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs to be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

JUMP HEIGHT DIVISIONS

• Information on Entry Forms For Mixed Breed Dogs - Enter All-American Dog only - do not list dog as a cross of any type. Please be sure to include your entire Canine Partner Listing Number and to check the AKC No. box. If your dog has not been measured by an AKC Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) please be sure to indicate that the dog needs to be measured at the trial.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS (continued)

• Pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited in the trial area. Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group, if they wish.

• The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all the obstacles safely.

• All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

• Crates, etc. may be left overnight in the area of the arena designated for crating. LCCOC and the Carencro Sports Complex assume no responsibility for anything lost or stolen.

• Dogs must be ready for judging. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

• Obstacles will conform to current requirements of the Agility Regulations.

• Checks will not be deposited before the closing date of the trial.

• Owners or handlers entering dogs in a match or trial do so at their own risk and agree to assume responsibility for any damage caused by them, or by their dogs. They also agree to abide by the Rules of the American Kennel Club and these Regulations.

• PLEASE use the designated exercise area and clean up after your dog. Pooper Scooper and trash cans will be furnished. Please respect the grounds and clean up after yourself and your dogs at the show site AND at your hotel!

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS (continued)

• It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made.

• Entry fees will be refunded in full for bitches that come in season after the closing date if application is made no later than ¹/₂ hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial and accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate. Bitches in season are not allowed in the Trial or on the show site.

• Entry fees will be refunded for dogs or handlers injured after the closing date of the Trial less \$14.75 maximum for each day entered (\$3.50 for AKC recording fee for 1st entry, \$3 for AKC recording fee for each additional entry; \$1.75 per class for judge's fee, \$1 processing fee). These forms must be postmarked prior to the opening of the Trial or given to the Trial Secretary before the start of the event.

• Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the Trial Committee or if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete: however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
