Jump Height Cards

Jump height cards must no longer be submitted with the entry form, which has been changed to indicate whether the dog has been measured. If the dog needs to be measured, the owner or handler must ensure that the box on the entry form is checked and that the judge of record, VMO, or AKC rep, if present, measures it before running.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older registered with the American Kennel Club or registered breeds that have obtained an AKC, ILP, or PAL number. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate. **Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate, provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form.**

Obstacles and Ring Conditions

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place outdoors under cover on a dirt surface. The ring will be 100' x 100', with a **rubberized surface** for contact obstacles and a tabletop.

Entry Fees Per Day

First entry of each dog \$ 25
(includes a \$3.50 AKC recording fee)

Additional entries of the same dog/same day \$ 15
(includes a \$3.00 AKC recording fee)

Emailed entry changes are not official until the exhibitor receives email confirmation from the Trial Secretary.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry, and the Trial Secretary will add a \$36.00 collection fee to each returned check.

Course Walk-Throughs and Warm Up Information

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course without a dog during a walk-through period before the class starts. However, the walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. If a conflict is imminent, handlers with multiple dogs at events with numerous rings may request to walk with a height group other than their dog.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving the dog.

Dark Green A New Title rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title. A MACH/ PACH/PAX rosette and jump bar will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their MACH/PACH/PAX. All dogs qualifying in both Master Standard and Master JWWs on the same day will be awarded a "Double Q" ribbon. One dog-related item, valued at three to five dollars, will be given to **each dog entered (one item per dog for the weekend)**.

Notice to Exhibitors

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

Our primary concern is the dog's safety. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked to leave the show site at the discretion of the trial committee. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. BARK and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers or to any of their dogs or property. It will also take no responsibility for injury to

children. **BARK** reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against **BARK** or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash on trial grounds except in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, a public emergency, the act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. As such, the club will refund the full amount of the entry fee paid for bitches unable to compete for this reason upon presentation of a veterinarian certificate. This certificate must be presented to the Trial Secretary before judging on the first day the dog is entered. Refunds will be issued no later than one week after the trials.

RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time before judging; however, if they do not have a valid jump height card, they must be available for measuring before the start of their class. **Judges are not required** to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club is not responsible for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners to call or locate dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

VENDORS

Dillion Soderstrom Photography will be taking pictures of all three trials.

Kaci Thornhill (Canine Massage Therapist) will be available to see humans and canines on Saturday and Sunday.

Third Coast Collars will have a tent for purchasing collars, leashes, and harnesses.

Food: Food options will be provided with the final entry confirmation. Some potluck or catered lunch will be offered each day. There is no vending or concession stand on site. However, Brookhaven has several options about 15 to 20 minutes from the venue. Coolers and packed food are allowed.

Additional Site Information

Crating space will be available. Crates may be left overnight; however, **BARK** and the Lincoln County Civic Center are not responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). If the Trial Committee deems an exhibitor violating this requirement, the exhibitor may be excused without a refund. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various showground locations.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular tiling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete, however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners Program SM may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
