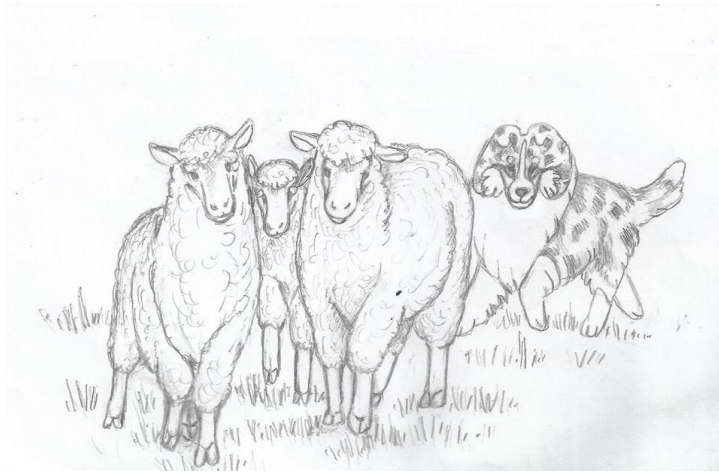

LIMITATIONS OF ENTRIES

These test/trials are limited to 40 sheep runs per day and 20 duck runs per day.

Entries close Wednesday, May 1, 2019 at 5:00 p.m. or when numerical limits have been reached. Entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, or submitted after the closing date and time.

ALTERNATE ENTRIES

In the event that the entry limit is reached prior to the closing date, a list of alternates may be established. Alternates for each class will be listed in the order of receipt of the entries. Alternates will be notified of their positions on the alternate's list at the time that judging programs are sent to each entrant. Those alternates that do not run or do not have the opportunity to run shall have their entry fees refunded. Alternates must run in their respective classes if present and if provided with the opportunity to run. A maximum of five (5) alternates may be accepted.

In the event an accepted entry is absent on the day of the test, it shall be the responsibility of the Secretary to determine if alternates are present and to determine, by their position on the alternates list, which of the alternates shall participate.

Entrants on the alternates' list must check in with the Trial Secretary no less than 30 minutes before the commencement of their class.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

TRIAL SITE will be open at 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM or conclusion of events each day. Dogs may not be left overnight. There is little protection from weather at the site. Please bring shade cloth, tents, and chairs with you.

DOGS ON GROUNDS: You are responsible for picking up after your dogs and disposing of waste in proper receptacles. **ALL DOGS PRESENT MUST BE HELD ON LEASH or otherwise restricted except when being judged.** Under no circumstances will dogs be allowed to disturb the resting stock or interfere outside the arena with another dog's performance in the arena. Unentered dogs not allowed in the trial areas. Official trial area is 100 feet from the trial and/or test field.

THIS IS A PRIVATE FARM. Park in designated areas only. DO NOT park by buildings/covers or block driveway. No one is allowed in areas marked DO NOT ENTER or any gate that is not part of the trial field. Livestock guardian dog is on the premises. DO NOT walk your dog in driveway while trial is in progress. NO LOOSE DOGS EXCEPT WHILE BEING JUDGED.

PLEASE NOTE: Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The Trial Secretary is not responsible for emails not received. If you have not received a response to an email after 24 hours, please call the Trial Secretary by telephone.

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the veterinarian, judge, or Trial Committee. A refund will be given, less a \$5 fee, if the Secretary is notified prior to the trial start and an alternate takes that run. No alternate, no refund.

Entry fees will not be refunded if the trials cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, and act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Entries must be made on Official AKC Entry Forms or copies and must include the signed Agreement and Rules. Please include only AKC titles on your entries.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures.

Post Dates and Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a \$25 returned check fee.

Bitches in season will be permitted to run, but will be placed at the end of the running order in Tests and in catalog order for Trial classes.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs at show site and all hotel, motel, and campgrounds where they are staying while competing in these trials.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the gate when it is their turn to run. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. CSSCLA has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the arena when required.

All dogs must be on lead or crated at all times except when in the arena. See Chapter 1, Section 20 of the AKC Herding Regulations. Dogs must wear a simple well-fitting buckle, snap lock, or slip collar (no tags) or may work without a collar at Trial levels. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may have made such errors. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Errors in entries made by the exhibitor cannot be corrected after the closing date other than move ups. No refund for duplicate entries.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

CSSCLA, their Officers, Members, and Promise Pastures and its employees or stock handlers will not be liable for any loss or injury which may be sustained through disappearance, loss, theft, communicable disease, parasites, injury and/or death of dogs and/or handlers entered in this event.

CSSCLA does not agree to arbitrate claims set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.
