ATTENTION EXHIBITORS!

Entry forms must be signed. Double check all information prior to signing the entry form. **If entering Rally Advanced and Rally Excellent, include your**

jump height in the appropriate box on the entry form. Catalog order in these classes will be based on jump height.

The building will be available for Exhibitors at least one hour prior to judging on Saturday, May 25, 2019 and must be vacated immediately following the awarding of High in Trial on Sunday, May 26, 2019.

Move-Ups are allowed in accordance with AKC regulations. Move-Ups will be accepted until 30 minutes prior to the start of judging for the first class each Trial. However, we would be grateful if you could submit Move-Ups before the trial by **4:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 23, 2019.** Please submit Move-Ups during the weekend in writing to prankstr2@bellsouth.net on forms provided by the Trial Secretary by Noon the day before the PM trial or 5:00 p.m. the day before, if possible. We thank you for your cooperation.

Checks that have been returned due to insufficient funds do not constitute a valid entry. Entry fees will not be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Entry fees for bitches coming in season after entries close will be refunded with written certification from a veterinarian presented to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of judging the first class.

No conditional entry shall be accepted. Entries will not be accepted without fees (check or money order) or signatures. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by e-mail **prior to the close of entries.** **Telephone changes will not be accepted.**

DO NOT LEAVE ANY DOGS IN CLOSED VEHICLES, May afternoons sometimes are hot. If any dog seems to be suffering from extreme temperatures or is confined without supervision, the authorities will be notified to handle the situation. Violators may be reported to the Trial Committee and/or the AKC for disciplinary action. All persons attending this show hereby waive any claim against the Louisiana Capital City Obedience Club and its members, in the event a motor vehicle is entered to rescue a dog from over-heating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

REMINDERS:

All dogs must be on leash when not in the ring. Dogs are not allowed in restrooms.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither LCCOC nor any ring steward will be responsible for calling or notifying exhibitors that they are due in the ring.

Exhibitors must clean up after their dogs, both at the Trial site and at the motels. There will be a designated exercise area at the Trial site.

Neither the Louisiana Capital City Obedience Club nor any Trial official will assume responsibility for any loss, theft, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or any of their dogs, children, or property.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and children. Any exhibitor whose dogs or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Food concession will not be available, but there are several local restaurants and fast food chains very close by. Tanger Outlet Mall is near the trial site. Lunches will be provided to workers.

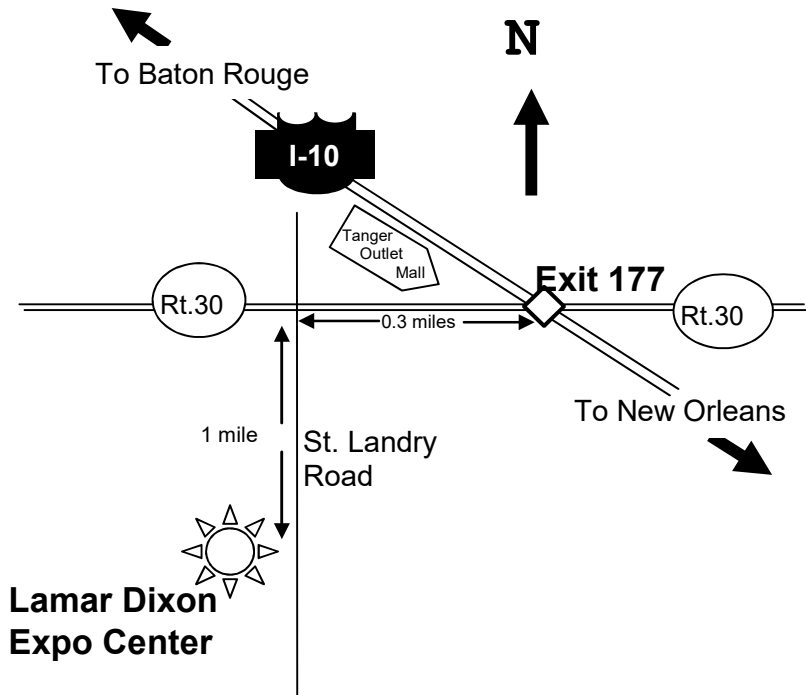

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
