Dear Valued Resident,

New Orleans East Hospital, in accordance with other healthcare providers, has received a limited quantity of COVID-19 vaccines to provide to eligible community members.

New Orleans East Hospital and its staff are committed to providing aid in an equitable and transparent distribution process. While we recognize that many of our residents would like to receive the vaccine, we must and will adhere to all federal, state, and local protocols and guidelines.

As instructed by the State of Louisiana, we will begin administering the vaccine to eligible community members: Phase 1A and Phase 1B, Tier 1.

This includes our elderly residents, age 70 and older, who have been classified by the Louisiana Department of Health as a priority group. All vaccines will be administered by *appointment only*.

We will begin administering the vaccine to eligible persons on **Wednesday, January 6, 2021**.

If you are an eligible community member and need to schedule your appointment, please contact NOEH beginning **Monday, January 4, 2021**, between 9am and 4pm, at 504.592.6628.


